He later wrote that the novel arose from a single image that of the character Caddy climbing a tree as a small child and that the entirety of the story is present in the first narrative with the following three having been written to clarify it In 1945 Faulkner wrote an appendix that both explained and extended the novel describing the fates of some of the characters while quickly seen to introduce plot
