Mongol Way of Life: nomadism- groups of people who constantly migrate to find pastures and water

Important Mongol: Genghis Khan- "universal leader"; birth name was Temujin; founder of the Mongol Empire

- I. Mongol Social Structure
 - a. Hierarchical system & roles
 - i. Khan: leader/ head of the group
 - ii. Powerful families: ratified decisions made by the Khan
 - iii. Lesser families: paid tribute to the powerful with goods and slaves
 - b. Elite women: played major role
 - i. Used for marriage alliances with other Mongol groups
 - ii. Wives/ Mothers of rulers
 1. Managed state affairs between the death of a ruler
 2. Selected a successor
- II. Factors to Mongol Conquests
 - a. Superior horsemanship
 - b. Advanced bow and arrow
 - c. Better technique: following a volley of arrows with a deadly cavalry charge
 - d. Military advances:
 - i. Ability to quickly pick up new military techniques
 - ii. Adapt new military technologies
 - iii. Incorporate non-Mongol soldiers into armies
 - iv. Create a intimidating reputation
 - v. Ability to take advantage of rivalries among enemies
- III. Effects of Mongols in Muslim lands
 - a. Destruction of last Abbasid caliphate
 - i. Because Islam contradicted Mongol religious belief
 - b. Tax farming system:
 - i. Delivered large amounts of grain, cash, silk
 - ii. Over taxation -> 1295 severe economic crisis
 - c. Il-khan empire & Golden Horde - declined (14th century)
 - d. Timur -> created Jagadai Khanate: central/ western Eurasia
 - i. Timurids- ruled Middle East for several generations
- IV. Trade, Science, Technology under the Mongols
 - a. Supported historians -> recorded history of the Mongols
 - b. Muslim Sciences:
 - i. Astronomy
 - ii. Calendar making
 - iii. Prediction of eclipses
 - c. Muslim Innovations:
 - i. Use of epicycles- theory of moon/ earth movement
 - ii. Invention of more precise astronomical instruments
 - iii. Recorded astronomical data with better accuracy

Student Study Guide to The Asian World, 600-1500 Roger Des Forges, John Major, 2005-10 The Christian doctrine of heaven has been a moral source of enormous power in western culture It has provided a striking account of the ultimate good in life and has for two millennia animated the hope that our lives can be fully meaningful Recently however the doctrine of heaven has lost much of its grip on the western imagination and has become a vague and largely ignored part of the Christian creed Not only have our hopes been redefined as a result but our very identity as human beings has been altered In this book Jerry L Walls argues that the doctrine of heaven is ripe for serious reconsideration He contends not only that the orthodox view of heaven can be defended from objections commonly raised against it but also that heaven is a powerful resource for addressing persistent philosophical problems not the least of which concern the ground of morality and the meaning of life Walls shows how heaven is integrally related to central Christian doctrines particularly those concerning salvation and tackles the difficult problem of why faith in Christ is necessary to save us from our sins In addition heaven is shown to illumine thorny problems of personal identity and to be an essential component of a satisfactory theodicy Walls goes on to examine data from near death experiences from the standpoint of some important recent work in epistemology and argues that they offer positive evidence for heaven He concludes that we profoundly need to recover the hope of heaven in order to recover our very humanity

From Yuan to Modern China and Mongolia Morris Rossabi,2015-01-27 This wide ranging work consisting of selected essays of Morris Rossabi reflects the diverse interests of a leading scholar of China and Inner Asia It encompasses the eras from the thirteenth century to the present territories stretching from China to Mongolia to Central Asia and to the Middle East and religions from Islam to Nestorian Christianity to Judaism and Confucianism in East Central and West Asia Rossabi first challenged the conventional wisdom concerning traditional Chinese foreign relations by showing the pragmatism of Chinese officials who were not bound by Confucian strictures and stereotypes about foreigners and were actually knowledgeable about neighboring regions His studies of the territories surrounding China led to the discovery of a major omission in historical writing the lack of a biography of Khubilai Khan one of the most renowned rulers in Eurasian history His biography of Khubilai resulted in further studies of the Mongolian legacy on global history and of the significant role of women in the Mongolian empire His repeated travels in Mongolia in turn stimulated an interest in modern Mongolia especially the turbulence following the turbulence after the collapse of socialism in 1990 a subject he writes about in this book The need for greater public knowledge and awareness of China Mongolia Central Asia the Silk Roads and Islam in Asia prompted Rossabi to write general occasionally pedagogical articles about these topics for a wider audience

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
