over several years including the Centennial Park bombing at the 1996 Olympics Ted Kaczynski was revealed to be the Unabomber that same year And these are only the most notable examples As George Michael demonstrates in *Lone Wolf Terror and the Rise of Leaderless Resistance* they are not isolated cases Rather they represent the new way warfare will be conducted in the twenty first century Lone Wolf Terror investigates the motivations of numerous political and ideological elements such as right wing individuals ecoextremists foreign jihadists and even quasi governmental entities In all these cases those carrying out destructive acts operate as lone wolves and small cells with little or no connection to formal organizations Ultimately Michael suggests that leaderless resistance has become the most common tactical approach of political terrorists in the West and elsewhere
