Martin, 2017-03-30 Birds are renowned for their exceptional vision and the way that this enables them to survive and navigate the world in such a unique way However it is now recognised that avian behaviour is guided by information drawn from many different senses which are then used in integrated and complementary ways to answer the many different sensory challenges posed by specific environments and particular tasks Understanding how sensory information is used by birds has important applications in conservation such as providing vital insights into why birds are prone to collisions with structures like power lines and wind turbines and why so many diving birds become entrapped in nets A sensory ecology approach suggests how these problems can be mitigated The Sensory Ecology of Birds ranges widely across species environments and behaviours to present a synthesis that challenges previous assumptions about the information that controls the behaviour of birds A bird may use a wide range and combination of sensory information that comes from sight hearing smell mechanoreception taste and magnetoreception It may also include specific refinements of senses such as echolocation and remote touch from the bill The book recognises that there are many complex and subtle trade offs and complementarities of information between different types of sensory information This accessible text will be of interest to a wide ornithological readership from undergraduates to researchers as well as a broader audience of behavioural ecologists and evolutionary biologists *Ethology and Behavioral Ecology of Odontocetes* Bernd Würsig, 2019-08-02 This book concentrates on the marine mammalian group of Odontocetes the toothed whales dolphins and porpoises In 23 chapters a total of 40 authors describe general patterns of ethological concepts of odontocetes in their natural environments with a strong bent towards behavioral ecology Examples are given of particularly well studied species and species groups for which enough data exist especially from the past 15 years The aim is to give a modern flavor of present knowledge of ethology and behavior of generally large brained behaviorally flexible mammals that have evolved quite separately from social mammals on land As well the plight of populations and species due to humans is described in multiple chapters with the goal that an understanding of behavior can help to solve or alleviate at least some human made problems **North American Watersnakes** J. Swadling,Elanor Bell,2025-08-19 Antarctic krill *Euphausia superba* is the target of the largest commercial fishery in the Southern Ocean Its abundance varies regionally and exhibits great interannual variability This natural variability combined with climate change effects could have substantial consequent impacts on krill predators and the magnitude of ecologically sustainable fishery catch limits Recent increase in the krill catch is due to technological developments in both harvesting and catch processing methods as well as interest in new products derived from krill e g dietary supplements and pet food The krill fishery is managed by the Commission for the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living Resources CCAMLR The krill fishery first commenced in 1970 s off East Antarctica but the main fishing ground shifted to the South Atlantic sector from the 1990 s Interest to fish off East Antarctica has been expressed by CCAMLR Member nations in recent years and the krill fishery recommenced in Indian Ocean sector of East Antarctic sector in the 2016 17 fishing season Given the increase in recent commercial interest the trigger level total allowed catch in one of the management areas CCAMLR Subarea 48 1 has been reached seven times in the Southwest Atlantic the East Antarctic fishery is likely to expand in coming years CCAMLR employs an ecosystem based management approach This requires a wide range of data and information from across regional ecosystem components In the southwest Atlantic sector krill management is based on large scale krill biomass surveys

undertaken in 2000 and 2019 together with various national Antarctic programs conducting annual regional scale monitoring this provides assessments of year to year variation of krill ecosystem parameters for CCAMLR to ensure harvesting is carried out in a sustainable manner Contrary to the relatively data rich Southwest Atlantic sector current precautionary catch limits for the krill fishery off East Antarctica are solely based on information collected through the two large scale multidisciplinary surveys conducted by Australia in Divisions 58 4 1 in 1996 and 58 4 2 in 2006 This Research Topic gathers up to date scientific analysis on the East Antarctic ecosystem arising from recent marine science voyages such as ENRICH Euphausiids and Nutrient Recycling In Cetacean Hotspots in 2019 and TEMPO Trends in Euphausiids off Mawson Predators and Oceanography in 2021 Our topic provides an opportunity to explore ecosystem wide scientific studies including non exclusively krill biomass ecosystem structure and interactions between krill krill predators oceanography and primary production to inform sustainable krill fishery management in the region

Gürkan YÜKSEK•,Serkan AKKOYUN,2025-03-23 **The Aquatic World of Penguins** David G Ainley,Rory P Wilson,2023-11-10 Centuries ago when penguins were first encountered by European explorers they were not thought to be birds but rather a fish like relative Subsequent accumulation of knowledge has shown penguins to be an avian species with unrivaled aquatic attributes owing to a number of evolutionary adaptations shape change low drag ability to regulate buoyancy and extraordinary surface compliancy from their featheration They are indeed the most extremely specialized diving bird having given up flight which otherwise is hugely advantageous to the benefit of underwater prowess such as speed maneuverability and an ability to exploit an extraordinary range of depths This flightlessness however also comes with costs that are substantial for a seabird such as the inability to cover large distances quickly in reaction to ephemeral prey

and the energy needed to cope with moving through an aqueous environment which is more resistant than air. For penguins the high energetic costs in exploiting the ocean environment thus makes them especially sensitive to changes in food availability or their access to their prey. While a number of penguin books cover the natural history mainly of breeding aspects few address in much detail the incredible aquatic nature of these creatures. A huge amount of information has been amassed over recent past decades thanks to dramatic advances in microelectronics bio logging and maturation of some long term studies of penguin life history. This work represents an integration of all these data with charts maps and graphs along with richly illustrated photos by experts in the field.
