Francis, 2017-05-15 Plagued by bloody wars and armed conflicts political instability communal violence and displaced persons and at the mercy of natural catastrophes such as drought and famine it is not surprising that the Western press has long dismissed Africa as the hopeless continent In the face of these challenges Africa today is faced with a stark choice either unite or perish The debate on why and how the continent should unite in terms of co operative peace security and development is more urgent than at any other time in Africa s post colonial history Moving forward from the failure of the earlier typically idealistic Africa unity project David Francis demonstrates how peace and security challenges have created the imperative for change He argues that a series of regional peace and security systems are emerging and that states that have participated in practical experiments in regional peacekeeping peace support operations conflict stabilization management and preventive diplomacy are building de facto systems of peace and security that could be institutionalized and extended

Cooperative Peacekeeping in Africa Malte Brosig, 2015-10-05 This book examines peacekeeping in Africa exploring how the various actors are forming an African security regime complex The changing dynamics of peacekeeping in today s world have encouraged a more cooperative approach between international and regional actors At the centre of this book is the analysis of how an African security regime complex could emerge in the area of cooperative peacekeeping The African regime complex on peacekeeping includes a number of organizations at the regional and sub regional African level as well as global institutions such as the UN interregional partners like the EU and individual lead nations This book is the first in providing a systematic overview of peacekeeping doctrines capacities and deployments of these key actors and single lead states Theoretically the book links up with regime complexity scholarship but connects it with dependency theory Here inter institutional relations are conceptualised as acts of resource exchange The book explores how primarily international organizations are partnering by exchanging resources Empirically the study analyses the phenomenon of regime complexity in three prominent African crises covering Eastern Africa Somalia Central African Central African Republic and Western Africa Mali This book will be of much interest to students of peacekeeping international organisations African politics security studies and IR in general

Peacekeeping in Africa Marco Jowell, 2018-02-21 In recent decades African states have developed an impressive infrastructure for training their peacekeepers. In addition, peacekeeping, peacebuilding and associated areas of conflict resolution have become significant areas of employment. Marco Jowell has spent a decade working in peacekeeping training in East Africa, initially as one of the foreign Technical Advisers at the Peace Support Operations (PSO) training centre in Kenya, the International Peace Support Training Centre (IPSTC), and subsequently as a strategic adviser to the Rwanda Peace Academy. Jowell shows that part of the aim of peacekeeping training centres is to foster a Pan-African outward-looking ideology or disposition, as well as improving technical ability. Intervention and Sovereignty in Africa Irit Back, 2015-10-19 In response to the civil war in Darfur, the African Mission in Sudan (AMIS) force was established in May 2004, and by June its first contingents were on the ground.
