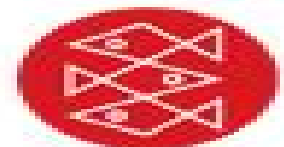


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UNICEF Annual Report 2015, 2016-07 **Global Nutrition Report 2015** International Food Policy Research Institute, 2015-09-15 As we move into the post 2015 era of the Sustainable Development Goals SDGs the world faces many seemingly intractable problems Malnutrition should not be one of them Countries that are determined to make rapid advances in malnutrition reduction can do so If governments want to achieve the SDG target of ending all forms of malnutrition by 2030 they have clear pathways to follow There are many levers to pull and this report provides many examples of countries that have done so Tackling malnutrition effectively is also key to meeting many other SDG targets Good nutrition signals the realization of people's rights to food and health It reflects a narrowing of the inequalities in our world Without good nutrition human beings cannot achieve their full potential When people's nutrition status improves it helps break the intergenerational cycle of poverty generates broad based economic growth and leads to a host of benefits for individuals families communities and countries Good nutrition provides both a foundation for human development and the scaffolding needed to ensure it reaches its full potential Good nutrition in short is an essential driver of sustainable development

The Struggle for Health David Sanders, 2023-02-27 The first edition of *The Struggle for Health* was published in 1985 and was widely acclaimed by those seeking a broader and deeper political understanding of ill health beyond the medical model of care It was a revolutionary book charting new ways of understanding and tackling the causes of ill health and suggesting strategies to enable health for all This second edition includes health problems that have emerged since the 1980s notably HIV AIDs COVID 19 and other epidemics and the increase in non communicable diseases such as cardiovascular disease and diabetes It examines some of the health impacts of globalization specifically on the food and pharmaceutical value chains and considers the consequences of climate change on the health of populations However this edition does not depart from the core message of the original book Health for All can only be achieved through a more equitable distribution of wealth resources and power *The Struggle for Health Second Edition* utilises the same approach as the first with a narrative that begins with diseases then describes historical trends and the limitation of the medical and commercial model of care At each juncture it asks the question WHY why do people especially children still die in large numbers throughout the world from wholly preventable diseases Why is it that appropriate provision for health care is not available to every individual in the world What changes can be made to improve this situation Most importantly this edition presents a strengthened call to action building upon the original work and advocating for systemic changes to ensure justice and equity in health for all

Humanitarian extractivism Kristin Bergtora Sandvik, 2023-10-17 This book investigates the digital transformation of aid as a form of humanitarian extractivism It focuses on how practices of data extraction shift power towards states the private sector and humanitarians Digital initiatives aimed towards fixing the humanitarian system making it better and more secure also create risk and harm for vulnerable individuals and communities Central to the digital
