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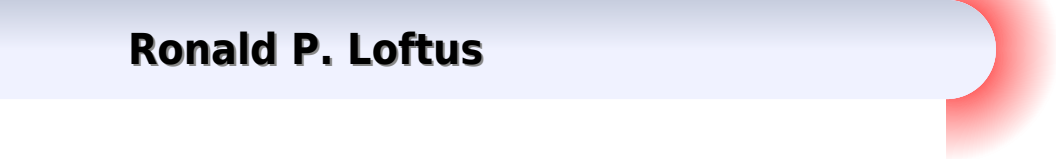

Reader's Guide to Lesbian and Gay Studies Timothy Murphy, 2013-10-18 The Reader's Guide to Lesbian and Gay Studies surveys the field in some 470 entries on individuals Adrienne Rich arts and cultural studies Dance ethics religion and philosophical issues Monastic Traditions historical figures periods and ideas Germany between the World Wars language literature and communication British Drama law and politics Child Custody medicine and biological sciences Health and Illness and psychology social sciences and education Kinsey Report *Touching the World* Paul John Eakin, 1992-04-15 Paul John Eakin's earlier work *Fictions in Autobiography* is a key text in autobiography studies In it he proposed that the self that finds expression in autobiography is in fundamental ways a kind of fictive construct a fiction articulated in a fiction In this new book Eakin turns his attention to what he sees as the defining assumption of autobiography that the story of the self does refer to a world of biographical and historical fact Here he shows that people write autobiography not in some private realm of the autonomous self but rather in strenuous engagement with the pressures that life in culture entails In so demonstrating he offers fresh readings of autobiographies by Roland Barthes Nathalie Sarraute William Maxwell Henry James Ronald Fraser Richard Rodriguez Henry Adams Patricia Hampl John Updike James McConkey and Lillian Hellman In the introduction Eakin makes a case for reopening the file on reference in autobiography and in the first chapter he establishes the complexity of the referential aesthetic of the genre the intricate interplay of fact and fiction in such texts In subsequent chapters he explores some of the major contexts of reference in autobiography the biographical the social and cultural the historical and finally underlying all the rest the somatic and temporal dimensions of the lived experience of identity In his discussion of contemporary theories of the self Eakin draws especially on cultural anthropology and developmental psychology Handbook of Autobiography / Autofiction Martina Wagner-Egelhaaf, 2019-01-29 Autobiographical writings have been a major cultural genre from antiquity to the present time General questions of the literary as e.g. the relation between literature and reality truth and fiction the dependency of author narrator and figure or issues of individual and cultural styles etc can be studied preeminently in the autobiographical genre Yet the tradition of life writing has in the course of literary history developed manifold types and forms Especially in the globalized age where the media and other technological cultural factors contribute to a rapid transformation of lifestyles autobiographical writing has maintained even enhanced its popularity and importance By conceiving autobiography in a wide sense that includes memoirs diaries self portraits and autofiction as well as media transformations of the genre this three volume handbook offers a comprehensive survey of theoretical approaches systematic aspects and historical developments in an international and interdisciplinary perspective While autobiography is usually considered to be a European tradition special emphasis is placed on the modes of self representation in non Western cultures and on inter and transcultural perspectives of the genre The individual contributions are closely interconnected by a system of cross references The handbook addresses scholars of
