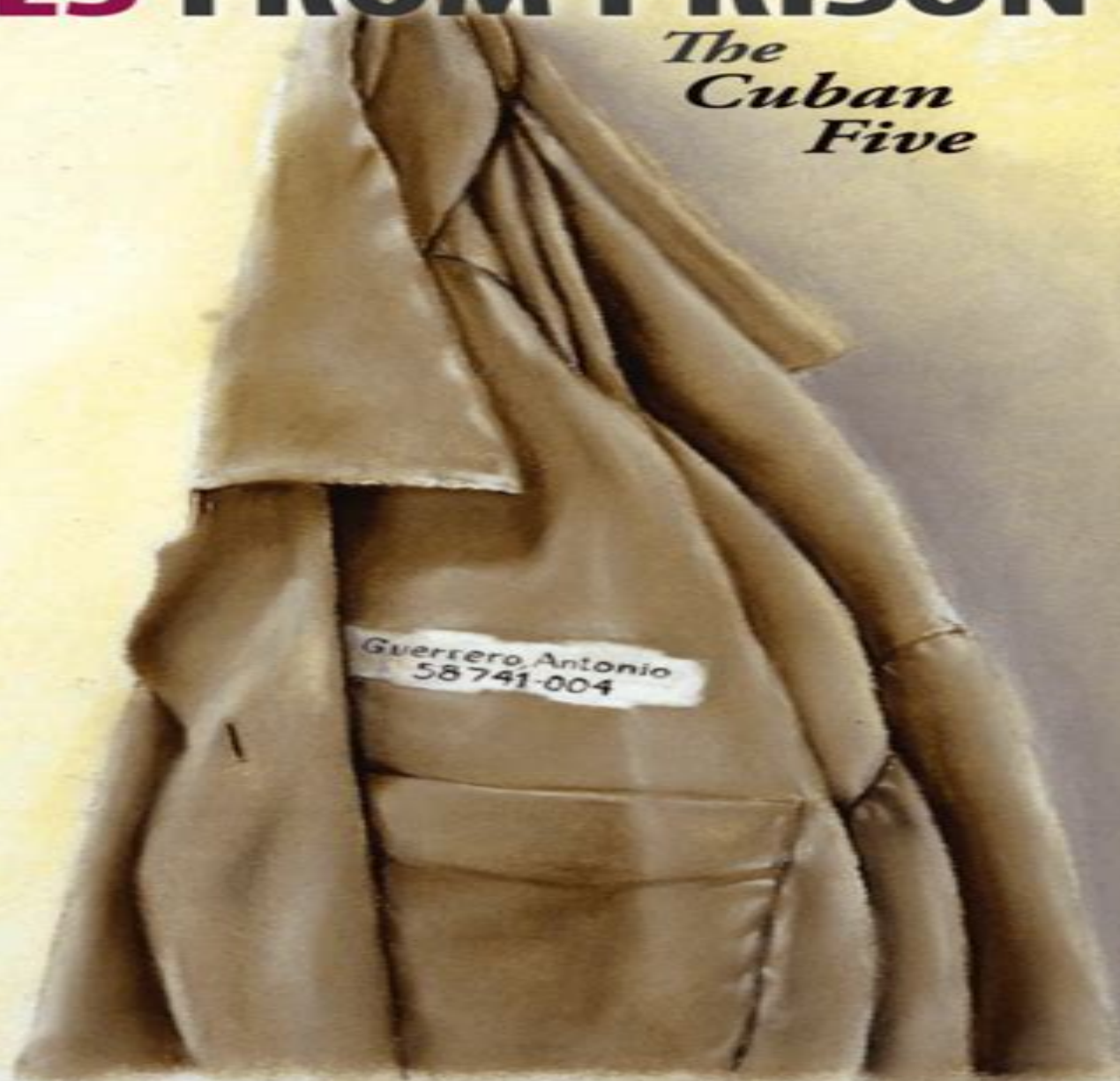

Miller shows how African migrants and their political fraternities played a formative role in the history of Cuba During the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries no large kingdoms controlled Nigeria and Cameroon's multilingual Cross River basin Instead each settlement had its own lodge of the initiation society called kp or leopard which was the highest indigenous authority kp lodges ruled local communities while also managing regional and long distance trade Cross River Africans enslaved and forcibly brought to colonial Cuba reorganized their kp clubs covertly in Havana and Matanzas into a mutual aid society called Abaku which became foundational to Cuba's urban life and music Miller's extensive fieldwork in Cuba and West Africa documents ritual languages and practices that survived the Middle Passage and evolved into a unifying charter for transplanted slaves and their successors To gain deeper

Lady Shirley Butler LaRocca,2008-12-01 When Jane McManus was a little girl her father told her she would make an outstanding lawyer if only she were a boy Jane decided then to learn everything a boy could only better The *Quixotic Lady* is the fictional story of the life of Jane McManus a rare female figure in the 1800s After her failed marriage to Allan Storm Jane became associated with some of the most powerful men of the time in the nineteenth century it was rare to find a woman who so influenced the politics of the day From her writings in the New York newspapers the politicians gauged public reaction Jane rallied from one cause to another such as the Texas annexation the Mexican War the political sentiment over whether Americans should help the Cubans obtain freedom from Spain and the annexation of the Dominican Republic However these daring undertakings met more failure than success Jane McManus Storm Cazneau a beautiful young woman whose spirit was not broken by failures never ceased to gamble along lines far removed from staid conformity in her quest for an elusive fortune Her story *That Quixotic Lady* is one of a remarkable woman whom history failed to remember

Forever Prisoners Elliott Young,2020-12-09 Stories of non US citizens caught in the jaws of the immigration bureaucracy and subject to indefinite detention are in the headlines daily These men women and children remain almost completely without rights unprotected by law and the Constitution and their status as outsiders even though many of have lived and worked in this country for years has left them vulnerable to the most extreme forms of state power Although the rhetoric surrounding these individuals is extreme the US government has been locking up immigrants since the late nineteenth century often for indefinite periods and with limited ability to challenge their confinement *Forever Prisoners* offers the first broad history of immigrant detention in the United States Elliott Young focuses on five stories including Chinese detained off

the coast of Washington in the late 1880s an insane Russian Brazilian Jew caught on a ship shuttling between New York and South America during World War I Japanese Peruvians kidnapped and locked up in a Texas jail during World War II a prison uprising by Mariel Cuban refugees in 1987 and a Salvadoran mother who grew up in the United States and has spent years incarcerated while fighting deportation Young shows how foreigners have been caged not just for immigration violations but also held in state and federal prisons for criminal offenses in insane asylums for mental illness as enemy aliens in INS facilities and in refugee camps Since the 1980s the conflation of criminality with undocumented migrants has given rise to the most extensive system of immigrant incarceration in the nation s history Today over half a million immigrants are caged each year some serving indefinite terms in what has become the world s most extensive immigrant detention system And yet Young finds the rate of all forms of incarceration for immigrants was as high in the early twentieth century as it is today demonstrating a return to past carceral practices Providing critical historical context for today s news cycle *Forever Prisoners* focuses on the sites of limbo where America s immigration population have been and continue to be held
