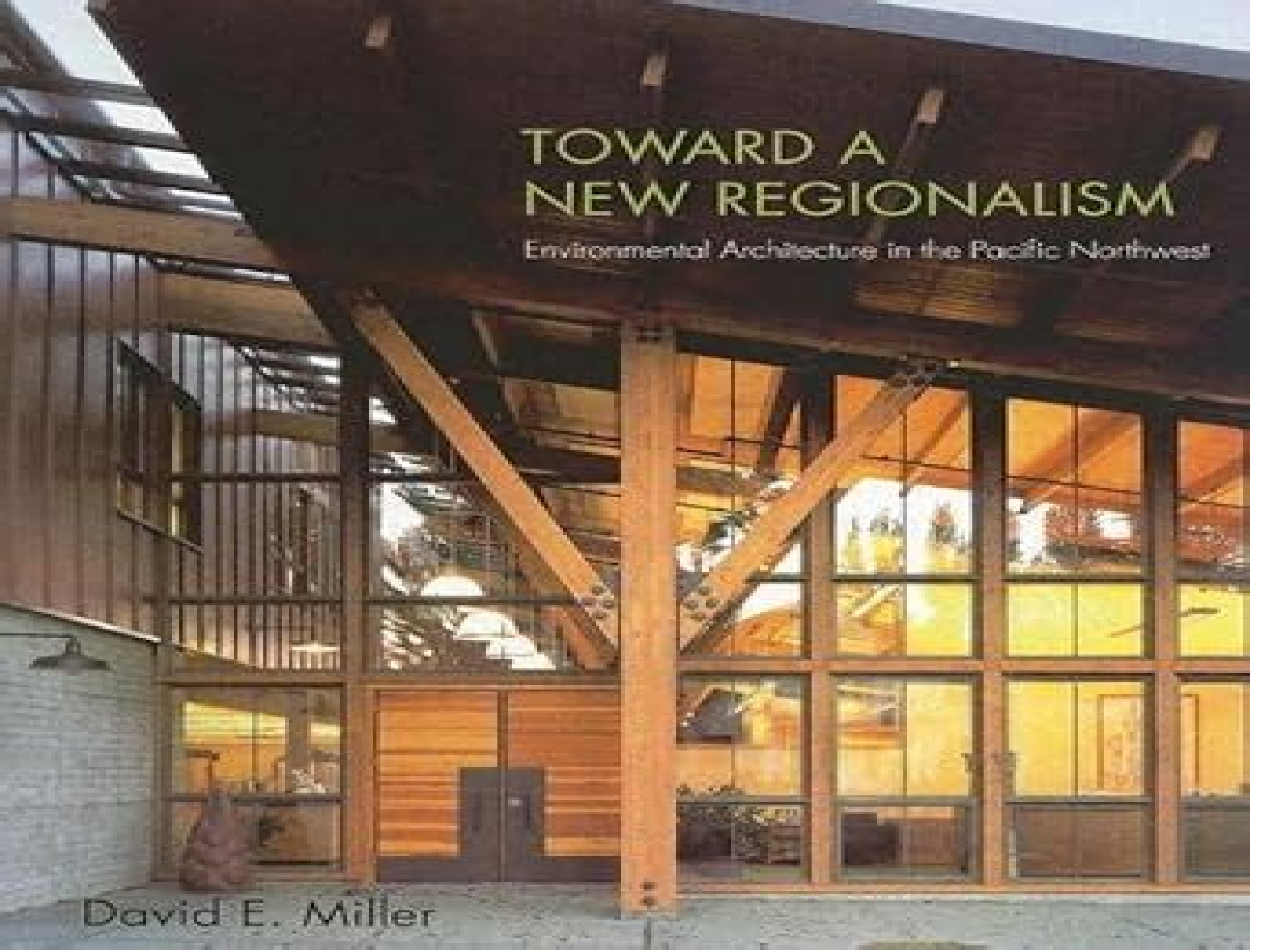

Miller, 2005 Green design is the major architectural movement of our time Throughout the world architects are producing sustainable buildings in an attempt to preserve the environment and our globe's natural resources However current strategies for forming sustainable solutions are typically too general and fail to take advantage of critical geographical environmental and cultural factors particular to a specific place By focusing on the Pacific Northwest this book provides essential lessons to architects and students on how sustainable architecture can and should be shaped by the unique conditions of a region Pacific Northwest regionalism has consistently supported an architecture aimed at environmental needs and priorities This book illuminates the history of a green trail in the work of key architects of the Northwest It discusses environmental strategies that work in the region organized according to nature's most basic elements earth air water and fire and their underlying principles and forces The book focuses on technologies materials and methods with a final section that examines thirteen exceptional Northwest buildings in detail and in light of their contributions to sustainable architecture Critical case studies by Northwest architects illustrate some of the best environmental design work in North America Notable architects from Seattle Portland and British Columbia are included These projects feature innovative design in water and site stewardship intelligent technologies passive energy strategies ecologically sound building materials and environmentally sensitive energy management systems

includes essays on the buildings of the Coast Salish people who inhabited Puget Sound prior to Euro American settlement the role that architects played in speculative housing developments before and after World War II and the vernacular architecture built by nonprofessionals that makes up a portion of the fabric of the city *Shaping Seattle Architecture* concludes with a substantial reference section updated to reflect the last twenty years of research and publications A locations appendix offers a geographic guide to surviving works The research section directs interested readers to further resources and the appendix *Additional Significant Seattle Architects* provides thumbnail sketches of nearly 250 important figures not included in the main text

Precedented Environmental Futures Colin Porteous, 2019-04-17 This book addresses the built environment through the lens of environmental architecture and in a holistic manner It moves gradually from psychophysiology and thinking doing feeling modalities through environmental criteria to environmental modulation concluding with a debate around mitigation and adaptation Much use is made of re interpreting past quotations seen as relevant for environmental architecture No definitive conclusions are reached but rather broad discursive messages are offered The text will have lasting luminance for new generations involved with the built environment

Narratives of Architectural Education James Thompson, 2019-01-14 *Narratives of Architectural Education* provides an overview of life as an architecture student detailing how a layperson may develop an architectural identity This book proposes becoming an architect as a personal narrative of professional development structured around various stages and challenges associated with identity transformation Using a case study of aspiring architects along multiple time points of their professional education Thompson investigates the occupational identity of architects how individuals construct a sense of themselves as future architects and position themselves within the architectural community This book provides previously unexamined insights into not just the academic development of an architect but also the holistic and experiential aspects of architectural education It would be ideal for those in the educational field of architecture to include students educators interns and mentors

Sprawling Places David Kolb, 2010-01-25 People often bemoan the spread of malls suburban strips subdivisions and other sprawling places in contemporary America But are these places as bad as critics claim In *Sprawling Places* David Kolb questions widely held assumptions about our built environments Kolb agrees there is a lot not to like about many contemporary places but to write them off simply as commodified nonplaces does not treat them critically Too often Kolb says aesthetic character and urban authenticity are the focus of critics when it is more important to understand a place s complexity and connectedness Kolb acknowledges that the places around us increasingly have banal exteriors yet they can be complex and can encourage their inhabitants to use them in multiple nonlinear ways Ultimately Kolb believes human activity within a place is what defines it Even our most idealized classical places he shows change over the course of history when subjected to new linkages and different flows of activity Engaging with the work of such writers and critics as Henri Lefebvre Manuel Castells Karsten Harries and Christian Norberg Schulz Kolb seeks to move discussions about sprawl away from the

idea that we must choose between being rooted in the local Black Forest soil or wandering in directionless space By increasing our awareness of complexity and other issues Kolb hopes to broaden and deepen people's thinking about the contemporary built environment and to encourage better designs in the future **Building Reuse** Kathryn Rogers Merlino, 2018-06-01 How to reimagine existing buildings to create a more sustainable future The construction and operation of buildings is responsible for 41 percent of all primary energy use and 48 percent of all carbon emissions and the impact of the demolition and removal of an older building can greatly diminish the advantages of adding green technologies to new construction In *Building Reuse* Kathryn Rogers Merlino makes an impassioned case that truly sustainable design requires reusing and reimagining existing buildings Additionally Merlino calls for a more expansive view of preservation that goes beyond keeping only the most distinctive structures based on their historical and cultural significance to embrace the creative reuse of even unremarkable buildings for their environmental value *Building Reuse* includes a compelling range of case studies from a private home to an eighteen story office building all located in the Pacific Northwest a region with a long history of sustainable design and urban growth policies that have made reuse projects feasible Reusing existing buildings can be challenging to accomplish but changing the way we think about environmentally conscious architecture has the potential to significantly reduce energy consumption carbon emissions and waste Architectural Record ,2006 *Mobilizing Regions, Mobilizing Europe* Sebastian M.
