Writing Without Words Elizabeth Hill Boone, Walter Mignolo, 1994 The history of writing or so the standard story goes is an ascending process evolving toward the alphabet and finally culminating in the full writing of recorded speech Writing without Words challenges this orthodoxy and with it widespread notions of literacy and dominant views of art and literature history and geography Asking how knowledge was encoded and preserved in Pre Columbian and early colonial Mesoamerican cultures the authors focus on systems of writing that did not strive to represent speech Their work reveals the complicity of ideology in the history of literacy and offers new insight into the history of writing The contributors who include art historians anthropologists and literary theorists examine the ways in which ancient Mesoamerican and Andean peoples conveyed meaning through hieroglyphic pictorial and coded systems systems inseparable from the ideologies they were developed to serve We see then how these systems changed with the European invasion and how uniquely colonial writing systems came to embody the post conquest American ideologies The authors also explore the role of these early systems in religious discourse and their relation to later colonial writing Bringing the insights from Mesoamerica and the Andes to bear on a fundamental exchange among art history literary theory semiotics and anthropology the volume reveals the power contained in the medium of writing Contributors Elizabeth Hill Boone Tom Cummins Stephen Houston Mark B King Dana Leibsohn Walter D Mignolo John Monaghan John M D Pohl Joanne Rappaport Peter van der Loo

la materialidad del manuscrito El proceso de conservación y reencuadernamiento del Mendocino registrado por Barker Benfield ha disipado especulaciones en cuanto al modo de construcción del manuscrito y sus posibles encuadernaciones previas permitiendo que conexiones antes aceptadas como la autoría de Francisco Gualpuyogualcal sean reexaminadas Asimismo el análisis llevado a cabo por el equipo de MOLAB liderado por Davide Domenici ha sacado del ámbito de la especulación la naturaleza de los pigmentos del manuscrito así como ha permitido que hipótesis interpretativas previamente articuladas al respecto del significado de pigmentos específicos y lo estricto de su aplicación en el tlacuillo sean refinadas y contenidas Si bien el color tiene significado para el tlacuillo este no es directa y necesariamente ligado a su materialidad A partir de estas observaciones se puede desarrollar una nueva generación de estudios interpretativos cuyas propuestas se basen en datos cada vez más ciertos acerca de la naturaleza material del Mendocino Los estudios interpretativos del manuscrito que ocupan el presente volumen representan una línea de investigación que al considerar al manuscrito desde la perspectiva compleja de la obra de arte bibliográfica y literaria complementa las lecturas antropológicas e históricas que se han hecho del Mendocino en estudios anteriores Así los ensayos de Diana Magaloni Daniela Bleichmar y Jorge Gómez Tejada editor del libro reconsideran el número y estilo de los artistas que crearon el manuscrito para entender tanto el proceso de creación del mismo como el lugar que este ocupa en el contexto artístico del virreinato temprano Las decisiones que estos artistas e intelectuales toman en el Mendocino lejos de insertarse en una relación binaria dominante dominado se presentan como una manifestación de los modos de pensar y ver el espacio y el tiempo en el mundo mesoamericano Las pinturas del Mendocino ejecutadas a manera de taller en donde uno dos o más individuos intervienen en una misma página para crear de manera sincronizada una sola composición tal como demuestra quien escribe toman visos de ritualidad y funcionan como instrumento para re-crear reactualizar y hacer coherente el devenir histórico ligado al territorio y los patrones cíclicos ver Capítulo 4 Esta última observación complementa y refuerza la lectura de la tercera sección del manuscrito propuesta por Joanne Harwood para quien independientemente de lo original de las soluciones visuales utilizadas para componer esta sección del manuscrito su modelo prehispánico se encuentra en un género de resonancia religiosa mesoamericana el teoamoxtili

Transcending Conquest Stephanie Wood, 2012-08-31 Columbus arrived on North American shores in 1492 and Cortés had replaced Moctezuma the Aztec Nahua emperor as the major figurehead in central Mexico by 1521 Five centuries later the convergence of old and new worlds and the consequences of colonization continue to fascinate and horrify us In *Transcending Conquest* Stephanie Wood uses Nahuatl writings and illustrations to reveal Nahua perspectives on Spanish colonial occupation of the Western Hemisphere Mesoamerican peoples have a strong tradition of pictorial record keeping and out of respect for this tradition Wood examines multiple examples of pictorial imagery to explore how Native manuscripts have depicted the European invader and colonizer She has combed national and provincial archives in Mexico and visited some of the Nahua communities of central Mexico to collect and translate Native texts Analyzing and interpreting

changes in indigenous views and attitudes throughout three hundred years of foreign rule Wood considers variations in perspectives between the indigenous elite and the laboring classes and between those who resisted and those who allied themselves with the European intruders *Transcending Conquest* goes beyond the familiar voices recorded by scribes in central colonial Mexico and the Spanish conquerors to include indigenous views from the outlying Mesoamerican provinces and to explore Native historical narratives from the sixteenth through the eighteenth century Wood explores how evolving sentiments in indigenous communities about increasing competition for resources ultimately resulted in an anti Spanish discourse a trend largely overlooked by scholars until now *Transcending Conquest* takes us beyond the romantic focus on the deeds of the Spanish conqueror to show how the so called conquest was limited by the ways that Native peoples and their descendants reshaped the historical narrative to better suit their memories identities and visions of the future

Michel de Guerrero, 2014 Paris Monographs in American Archaeology 38 This volume closely examines and catalogs a limited set of glyphic elements found at the archaeological site of Teotihuacan in Mexico This study serves as an initial investigation to verify whether these glyphs may be part of a writing system in use at the site The author looks at two specific sources of glyphs and glyph compounds at Teotihuacan that appear to be the largest sets of co occurring glyphs and contain the largest number of glyphs One set in particular has not yet been studied in detail and therefore will present new information within this area of research Furthermore there has not been a steady or significant amount of glyphic research carried out at Teotihuacan in recent years since Taube 2000 The investigation was structured to thoroughly analyze the data for similarities between the selected glyphic elements from Teotihuacan and the

requirements for writing systems For that reason basic linguistic tests were conducted on the data to determine whether the glyphic elements had similarities with those requirements for Mesoamerican writing systems This work is not a decipherment Instead its aim is to verify whether the glyphic elements at Teotihuacan could potentially be a writing system catalog them in an orderly fashion conduct a comparative analysis between them and others found within Teotihuacan and elsewhere in Mesoamerica and conclude whether further research in the way of a complete decipherment is a possibility if future data is uncovered at the site
