Witness to an Extreme Century Robert Jay Lifton, 2011-06-14 On a fateful day in the spring of 1954 Robert Jay Lifton a young American psychiatrist just discharged from service in the Korean War decided to stay in Hong Kong rather than return home changing his life plans entirely so that he could continue work that had enthralled him interviewing people subjected to Chinese thought reform He had plunged into uncharted territory in probing the far reaches of the human psyche as he would repeatedly in the years ahead and his Hong Kong research provided the first understanding of the insidious process that came to be known as brainwashing From that day in Hong Kong forward Lifton has probed into some of the darkest episodes of human history bearing his unique form of psychological witness to the sources and consequences of collective violence and trauma as well as to our astonishing capacity for resilience In this long awaited memoir Lifton charts the adventurous and constantly surprising course of his fascinating life journey a journey that took him from what a friend of his called a Jewish Huck Finn childhood in Brooklyn to friendships with many of the most influential intellectuals writers and artists of our time from Erik Erikson David Riesman and Margaret Mead to Howard Zinn and Kurt Vonnegut Stanley Kunitz Kenzaburo Oe and Norman Mailer In his remarkable study of Hiroshima survivors he explored the human consequences of nuclear weapons and then went on to uncover dangerous forms of attraction to their power in the spiritual disease he calls nuclearism During riveting face to face interviews with Nazi doctors he illuminated the reversal of healing and killing in ordinary physicians who had been socialized to Nazi evil With Vietnam veterans he helped create unprecedented rap groups in which much was revealed about what we now call post traumatic stress disorder helping veterans draw upon their experience for valuable even prophetic insights about atrocity and war As a pioneer in psychohistory Lifton's encounters with the consequences of cruelty and destructiveness led him to become a passionate social activist lending a powerful voice of conscience to the suppressed truths of the Vietnam War and the dangers of nuclear weapons Written with the warmth of spirit along with the humor and sense of absurdity that have made Lifton a beloved friend and teacher to so many *Witness to an Extreme Century* is a moving and deeply thought provoking story of one man's extraordinary commitment to looking into the abyss of evil in order to help us move beyond it

Migrant Representations Peter Leese, 2022-01-15 Migrant Representations pairs twenty four carefully selected histories in order to compare how migrants themselves Irish labourer Lithuanian refugee or Indian doctor and their social investigators capture in words and images defining private and historical moments These comparative case studies from the 1780s to the 2000s explore how migrants constructed their own narratives of mobility and settlement through procedures of reflecting remembering and recording Moreover these studies examine how speech writing and picture were used for instance by a missionary social scientist or activist to make outside representations of the migrant Such life stories social surveys and pictures emerge as alternative archives Leese's transnational cultural history considers life story forms and their uses the tension between external surveillance and self observation the power of narratives to afford legibility and acknowledgement Leese argues that historically and in the present first person migrant stories and outsider investigations create a continuous charged exchange of views where both migrant and observer negotiate position authority authenticity and potential advantage Within the history of migrant representations this exchange generates a persistent subversive strain of opposition and critique Such self observations observations of others and images never settle

Anti-Semitism and Psychiatry H. Steven Moffic, John R. Peteet, Ahmed Hankir, Mary V. Seeman, 2020-02-25 Following World War II and the exposure of the concentration camps psychiatry turned its attention to a vast range of cultural concerns with results that seemed to indicate a decline of stigma over time However it is now clear that whatever drives prejudices especially in the case of anti-Semitism was just dormant and perhaps not fully understood Hate crimes and anti-Semitism broad recently re-emerged in Europe and the United States followed shortly thereafter The US Federal Bureau of investigation reports that New York City which is still considered the

most Jewish friendly region in the US experienced a 22% spike in anti Semitic hate crimes in 2018 alone with more extremes in other regions of the country Neo Nazi groups have grown stronger in the United States and abroad often resulting in organized acts of violence The recent Tree of Life synagogue shooting in Pittsburgh PA demonstrated that these acts are not limited to one on one interactions but sometimes as prolific large scale act The medical community is not immune from biases either The Cleveland Clinic recently fired a young doctor after she publicly declared her wishes to inject Jewish patients with lethal substances which is only one of many hateful comments she made on social media over the course of several years Psychiatrists in particular grapple with this as they try to serve patients of both Jewish and non Jewish descent who struggle to process these acts of hate Despite all of this there is no training and no resource to guide medical professionals through these challenges The editors of the recent Springer book Islamophobia and Psychiatry recognize this gap in the literature and seek to develop another high quality text to meet this need Written by expert clinicians in global regions where these incidents are most prevalent the book seeks to be neither political nor opinion based instead the text takes an innovative cross cultural psychiatric interaction similar to what was done with Springer s new Islamophobia book Coverage will range from foci on the social psychiatric aspects of anti Semitism to how it may in turn infuse clinical encounters between patients and clinicians Written by experts in this area the insight and expertise of psychiatrists from a variety of cultural and religious backgrounds will focus on what psychiatrists need to know to combat the negative mental health impact that increasingly rise out of this particular phenomenon Such a multi cultural psychiatric approach has never been taken before for this topic This discourse is the foundation for the primary goal of this book to develop the tools needed to improve clinical outcomes for patients Hence this book aims to present an updated comprehensive bio psychosocial perspective on anti Semitism at the interface of clinical psychiatry

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
