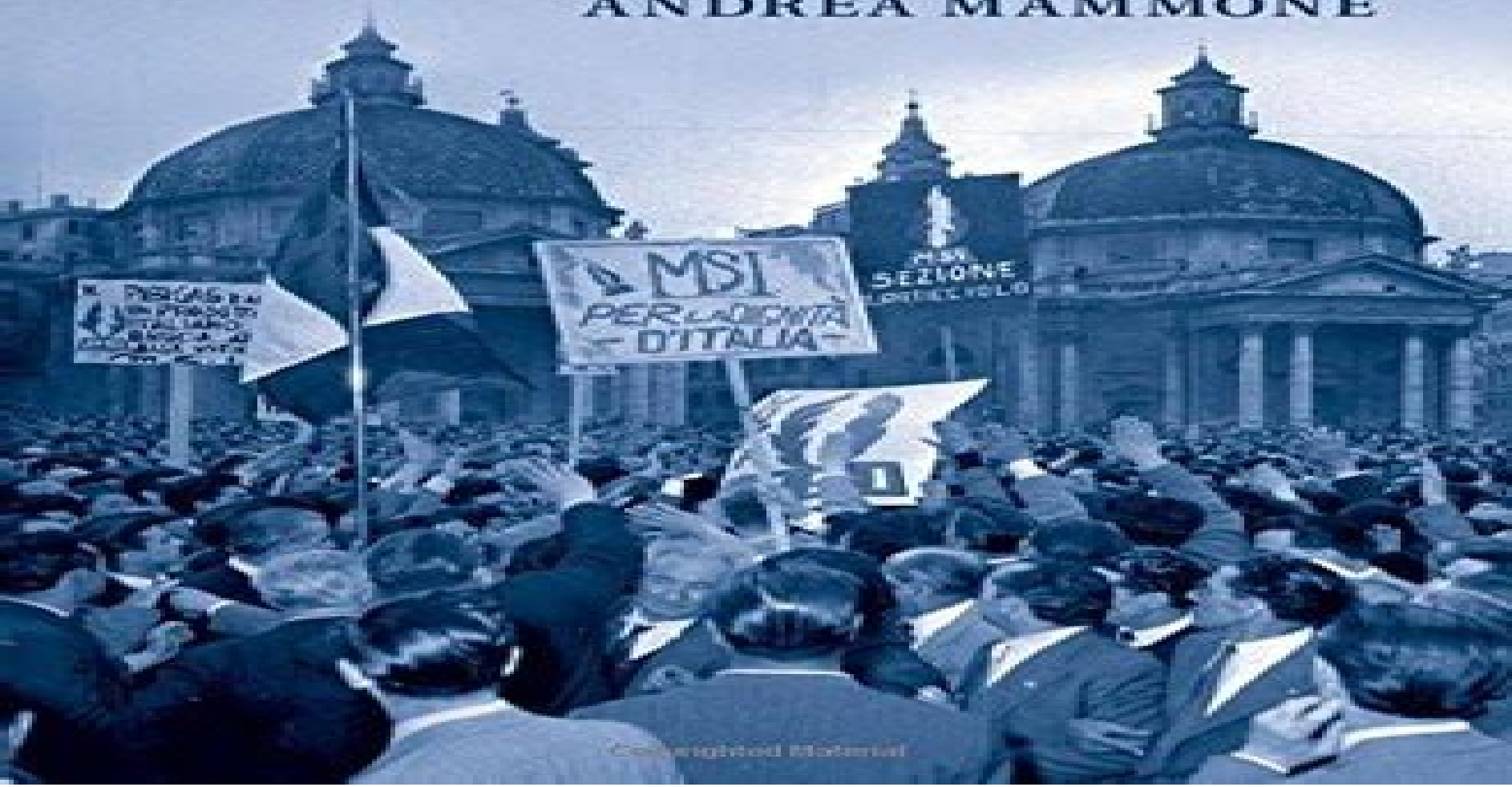

previously suspected His dissatisfaction with National Socialism it turns out was mainly that it did not go far enough The notebooks show that far from being separated from Nazism Heidegger s philosophy was suffused with it In this book Richard Wolin explores what the notebooks mean for our understanding of arguably the most important philosopher of the twentieth century and of his ideas and why his legacy remains radically compromised

Feshami, 2025-11-13 This book illustrates how white nationalism emerged and maintained itself as a global movement in the years after the Second World War contending that its international scope was made possible by a network of individuals and groups who depended on media to communicate with each other By establishing and maintaining mediated networks Feshami posits members of the movement were able to more persuasively communicate not only their ideas and worldview but also perhaps more compellingly the personal emotions narratives and experiences which have encouraged them to construct and understand their identities as part of a national community fighting for its survival To that end he analyzes a variety of archival white nationalist media artifacts as case studies to demonstrate how the movement has historically utilized media to construct and foster an identity grounded in ideas of racial unity geographical belonging and perceived existential threats As white nationalists attempt to draw larger audiences by shifting cultural attitudes toward their vision of a globally united white nation Feshami positions this network as a mediated space comprising a social architecture in which participants are encouraged to form core understandings of the self one's relationship to others and one's place in the larger world In doing so they seek to grow a movement that threatens the future of democratic and pluralist societies

Living Right Agnieszka Pasioka, 2024-11-12 Living Right offers an in depth examination of far right youth movements in Poland Italy and Hungary The protagonists include students and young entrepreneurs former skinheads construction workers bohemian musicians and rich kids from the upper class who have all found a nurturing community in far right groups While they focus on local action they are also part of a broader project with global ramifications Agnieszka Pasioka engages in intensive fieldwork in these communities particularly among members of the far right Polish movement National Radical Camp ONR the Italian neofascist movement Lealt Azione Loyalty Action or LA and the Federazione which comprises over a dozen movements across Italy along with additional fieldwork among young Hungarian fascists Pasioka makes some startling and counterintuitive discoveries She observes that these groups embrace forms of civic engagement we tend to associate with left wing organizations and movements such as volunteerism in soup kitchens animal shelters and orphanages environmental activism and humanitarian missions to such places as the Balkans and the Middle East Moreover she finds that such groups adopt language that overlaps in significant ways with left leaning progressivism notably a critique of

globalization consumerism capitalism mass culture and Americanization as well as a selective embrace of the welfare state so long as the benefits of public assistance are limited to white Christian compatriots Members of these youth groups are often enthusiastic but selective readers of modern social science and embrace notions of cultural autonomy cultural rights and diversity This language though buttresses an understanding of the world as made up of demarcated ethno cultural entities in which each entity should not mix with others Taken together her findings lead her to consider the far right s rejection of a hegemonic liberal order
