The Chameleon Poet Robert Fraser, 2002 The poet George Barker was convinced that his biography could never be written I've stirred the facts around too much he told Robert Fraser It simply can't be done Eliot wrote of his genius Yeats thought him the most interesting poet of his generation Dylan Thomas envied his power over women War trapped him in Japan In America he conducted one of the most celebrated love affairs of the century He fathered fifteen children in several countries three during one battle torn summer By the 1950s he was the toast of Soho Barker was Catholic and bohemian frank and elusive tender and boisterous In Eliot's phrase he was a most peculiar fellow Robert Fraser's biography offers both a portrait of a talented tormented and irresistibly entertaining man and a broad cultural landscape Around the central figure cluster painters like Francis Bacon Lucian Freud Johnny Minton and the Roberts Colquhoun and MacBryde writers such as Dylan Thomas Walter de la Mare and Elizabeth Smart whose By Grand Central Station I Sat Down and Wept hymns their liaison the lugubrious humorist Jeffrey Bernard After closing time at the Colony Room Minton declared they had to sweep up the jokes
