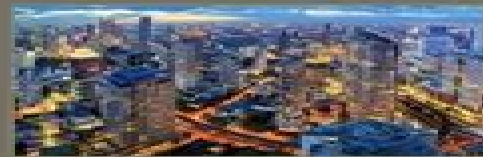
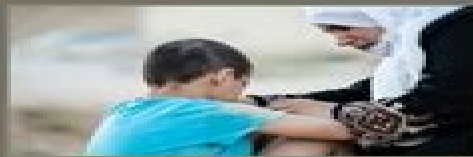

difficult Inefficient water use practices by households and industries fragmented management of water between sectors and institutions climate induced water shortages environmental degradation of water sources and inadequate use of alternate sources are also issues of major concern Despite recent advances in the literature there exists a considerable gap in attempting an integrated water resource management approach Covering all aspects of urban drought and water insecurity this book is a valuable resource for students researchers academics policy makers and development practitioners
