The RAF Air-Sea Rescue Service in the Second World War Norman Franks,2016-11-30 When the Second World War began in 1939 it was thought that it would be fought along the same lines as the First World War with the Allied air forces operating from both Britain and France With the fall of Britains Northern European Allies in May 1940 all that changed From then onwards RAF aircraft operating over enemy and enemy held territory necessitated flights across both the North Sea and the English Channel This meant that aircrew in difficulties would be forced to come down in both of these bodies of water Therefore it was essential that some form of rescue service be made available to fish these airman from the water But there were no aircraft in existence at that time that were designed for such a task initially all that could be done was to use land planes to help locate anyone in the water drop a dinghy to them and then guide a boat to their position Obviously a quicker and more reliable means of rescue was needed and this came in the shape of the Supermarine Walrus an amphibian airplane that could land on both sea and land Several Flights of these airplanes were set up around the coast of Britain concentrated mainly around the south and southeast of England The Air Sea Rescue airmen did a magnificent job from 1941 45 rescuing hundreds of downed RAF and USAAF aircrew It took a special type of airman to undertake these rescues and another kind of courage As the war in North Africa developed Walrus aircraft were needed in the Mediterranean and later on either side of the Italian coast Walrus squadrons operated just as successfully in this theater as around Britain Aircrew operating over any stretch of water could always count on the ASR boys

wastes of the Atlantic Due to Alderson s consummate airmanship and the bravery of heroine passenger Edna Watson ten of the thirteen souls on board survived Their miraculous rescue by the tanker Esso Baytown part of a huge international search and rescue effort after eleven gruelling hours in cold shark infested waters dominated the world s headlines Alderson returned to duty on the long distance flying boat routes to Singapore and Durban but following the German invasion of France in 1940 he was transferred to the treacherous West Africa run After a brush with a U boat off Sierra Leone he was tasked with ferrying General de Gaulle back to the UK from Nigeria After avoiding a suspected poisoning attempt at Freetown and Luftwaffe interception over the Bay of Biscay the General personally thanked Alderson for his safe return Later in 1940 the British Government bought three huge Boeing flying boats to maintain the wartime transatlantic link and Alderson was promoted to the roster for these The hours in these behemoths were prodigious routing via Portugal West Africa and Brazil with the fear of enemy attack a constant and very real threat Only V I P s and vital mail were carried although Alderson did once deliver President Roosevelt s personal gift to Winston Churchill a critical supply of Havana cigars Adventure abounds in this remarkable story of a flying boat pilot and captain in both war and peace racing Bentleys landing on beaches black tie dinner with the Luftwaffe landing on the Nile flying across India and espionage and intrigue in Lisbon

all were willing to pull together seeing the wartime conditions instead as an opportunity to make illegal profits
