The Power of Music Roger Kennedy, 2020-07-31 Emotion is an integral aspect of musical experience; music has the power to take us on an emotional and intellectual journey, transforming the listener along the way. The aim of this book is to examine the nature of this journey using a variety of perspectives. No one discipline can do justice to music's complexity if one is to have a sense of the whole musical experience, even if one has to break up the whole experience into various elements for the purposes of clarification. The issues raised have some relationship to psychoanalytic understanding and listening, as after all, psychoanalysis is a listening discipline; its bedrock is listening to the patient's communications. And of course there is soul music whose basic rhythms reach deep into the body to create a powerful feeling of aliveness.
