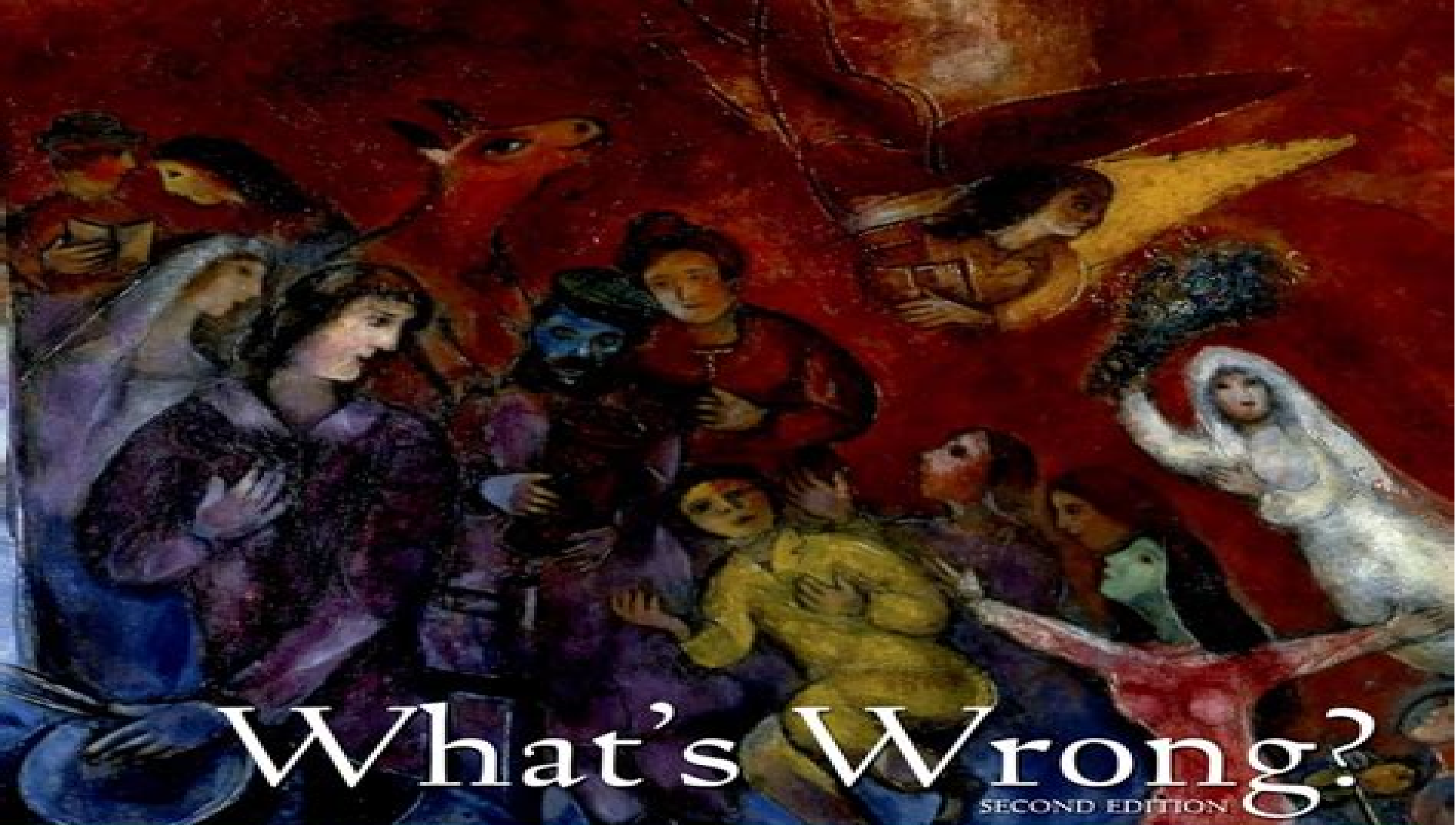




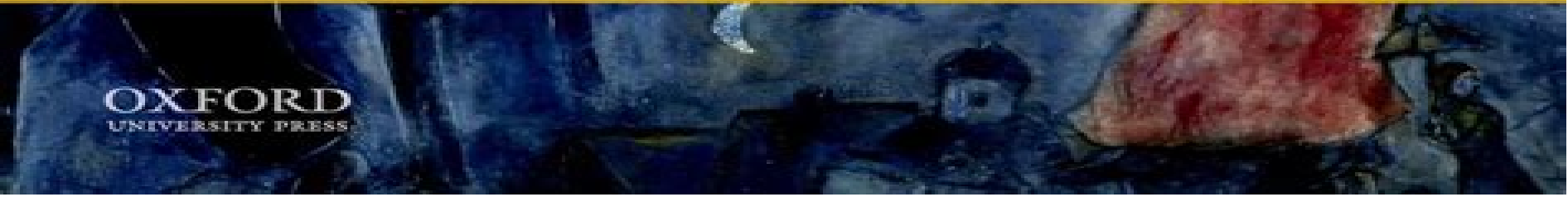

David Boonin, Graham Oddie, 2010 What's Wrong Applied Ethicists and Their Critics is a thorough and engaging introduction to applied ethics that covers virtually all of the issues in the field. Featuring more than ninety-five articles, it addresses standard topics such as abortion, euthanasia, capital punishment, world hunger, and animal rights, and also delves into cutting-edge areas like cloning, racial profiling, same-sex marriage, prostitution, and slave reparations. The volume includes seminal essays by prominent philosophers Robert Nozick, James Rachels, Peter Singer, and Judith Jarvis Thomson alongside work by newer voices in the field. Employing a unique approach to teaching argumentation, editors David Boonin and Graham Oddie unify the wealth of material presented in this collection. Each chapter opens with a featured article that takes a strong stand on a particular issue; the essays that immediately follow offer objections and critical responses to the arguments put forth in the featured selection. This format helps students learn how to better engage in debates because it illustrates how philosophers argue with each other. In addition, a general introduction describes strategies for understanding and evaluating the different types of arguments contained in the readings, while detailed chapter introductions enable students to see precisely how the arguments presented in the various writings are related to one another. Discussion questions and suggestions for further reading are included for each chapter. Ideal for courses in introduction to ethics and applied ethics, contemporary moral problems, What's Wrong can also be used in critical thinking courses that emphasize philosophical argumentation.

The Non-Identity Problem and the Ethics of Future People David Boonin, 2014-10-16 David Boonin presents a new account of the non-identity problem, a puzzle about our obligations to people who do not yet exist. Our actions sometimes have an effect not only on the quality of life that people will enjoy in the future but on which particular people will exist in the future to enjoy it. In cases where this is so, the combination of certain assumptions that most people seem to accept can yield conclusions that most people seem to reject. The non-identity problem has important implications both for ethical theory and for a number of topics in applied ethics, including controversial issues in bioethics, environmental ethics, and disability ethics. It has been the subject of a great deal of

discussion for nearly four decades but this is the first book length study devoted exclusively to its examination Boonin begins by explaining what the problem is why the problem matters and what criteria a solution to the problem must satisfy in order to count as a successful one He then provides a critical survey of the solutions to the problem that have thus far been proposed in the sizeable literature that the problem has generated and concludes by developing and defending an unorthodox alternative solution one that differs fundamentally from virtually every other available approach

A Moral Defense of Recreational Drug Use Rob Lovering, 2015-08-12 Why does American law allow the recreational use of some drugs such as alcohol tobacco and caffeine but not others such as marijuana cocaine and heroin The answer lies not simply in the harm the use of these drugs might cause but in the perceived morality or lack thereof of their recreational use Despite strong rhetoric from moral critics of recreational drug use however it is surprisingly difficult to discern the reasons they have for deeming the recreational use of some drugs morally wrong In this book Rob Lovering lays out and dissects various arguments for the immorality of using marijuana cocaine heroin and other drugs recreationally He contends that by and large these arguments do not succeed Lovering's book represents one of the first works to systematically present analyze and critique arguments for the moral wrongness of recreational drug use Given this as well as the popularity of the morality based defense of the United States drug laws this book is an important and timely contribution to the debate on the recreational use of drugs
