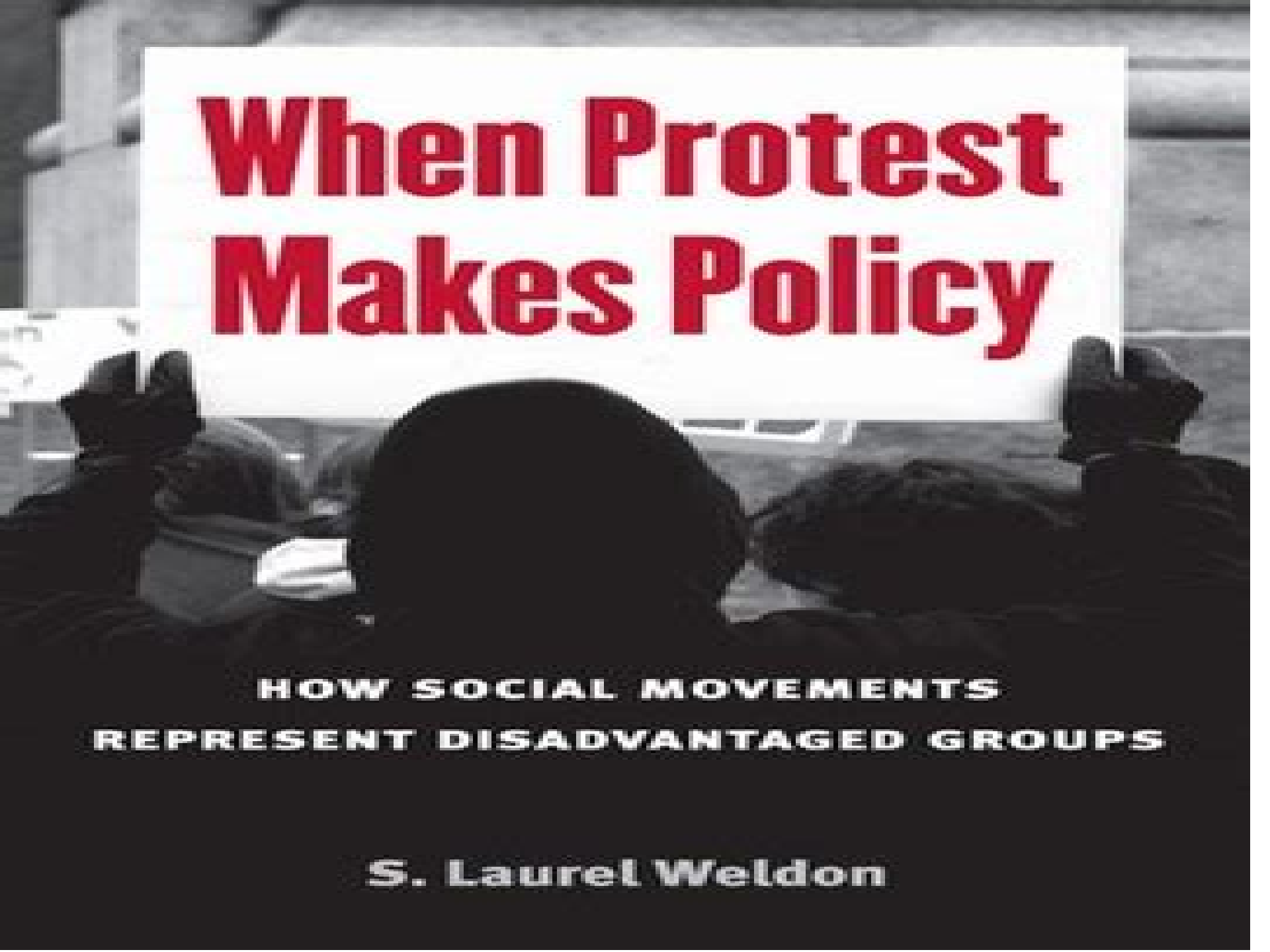

Women and Democracy in Iraq Huda Al-Tamimi, 2019-05-30 As the post invasion reconstruction of Iraq has unfolded the potential for Iraqi women to participate actively and visibly in the country's political structure has been one of its most notable results The 2005 Constitution required that no less than 25% of seats in the Iraqi Parliament be filled by women Yet despite subsequent parliamentary statistics suggesting great strides for female political participation there has been a resounding silence on the wider implications of this quota for women in Iraqi political life This book is the first full length study of women's political representation in Iraq Based on interviews with politicians and substantial media analysis Huda Al Tamimi outlines the political sectarian and cultural constraints facing female Members of Parliament and the ways in which individual women and women's organizations are actively challenging barriers to their political influence The book is a vital contribution to discussions concerning the success and limitations of gender quotas in the Middle East It also offers new and critical perspectives on the evolution of Iraqi politics a subject that remains of high priority for a region and international community interested in the nation's reconstruction

Representation Maria C. Escobar-Lemmon, Michelle M. Taylor-Robinson, 2014-05-14 While there is a vast literature on women's political interests there is hardly any consensus about what constitutes women's interests or how scholars should approach studying them Representation can occur in various venues or by various actors but due to power imbalances across political groups it is not always realized in any substantive way The essays in this book constitute a broad and geographically comparative move toward defining new and unified theoretical orientations to studying representation among women Representation involves not only getting group members into government but also articulating group interests and translating those interests into policy Because competing groups have different policy preferences and act out of self interest representation of historically marginalized groups is a contentious contingent process that is likely to ebb and flow The book begins with a theoretical positioning of the meaning of women's interests issues and preferences It considers the need to add nuance to how we conceive of and study intersectionality and the dangers of stretching the meaning of substantive representation It then looks at descriptive representation in political parties high courts and legislatures as well as how definitions of interest affect who represents women in legislatures and social movements The book concludes by suggesting testable propositions and avenues

for future research to enhance understanding about representation of women and of other historically under represented groups Chapters include cases from the United States Latin America Western Europe and Africa **Unequal America**

the power and moral authority of poor communities and their movements for justice and social change If normative ethicists seek to contribute to proposals for just and durable poverty reduction they will need to look to the insights and aims of pro poor led social movements From rural landless workers in Brazil to urban shack dwellers in South Africa to unemployed workers impoverished by neoliberal economic policies in Argentina poor led organizations and movements advance a more political understanding of poverty and of what is needed to eradicate it Deveaux shows how these groups develop the political consciousness and collective capabilities of poor communities and help to create the basis for solidarity among poor populations Defending the idea of a political responsibility for solidarity she shows how nonpoor outsiders individuals institutions and states can help to advance a transformative anti poverty agenda by supporting the efforts of these movements

American Insecurity Adam Seth Levine, 2017-05-09 Why economic insecurity spurs so little collective political action Americans today face no shortage of threats to their financial well being such as job and retirement insecurity health care costs and spiraling college tuition While one might expect that these concerns would motivate people to become more politically engaged on the issues this often doesn't happen and the resulting inaction carries consequences for political debates and public policy Moving beyond previously studied barriers to political organization American Insecurity sheds light on the public's inaction over economic insecurities by showing that the rhetoric surrounding these issues is actually self undermining By their nature the very arguments intended to mobilize individuals asking them to devote money or time to politics remind citizens of their economic fears and personal constraints leading to undermobilization and nonparticipation Adam Seth Levine explains why the set of people who become politically active on financial insecurity issues is therefore quite narrow When money is needed only those who care about the issues but are not personally affected become involved When time is needed participation is limited to those not personally affected or those who are personally affected but outside of the labor force with time to spare The latter explains why it is relatively easy to mobilize retirees on topics that reflect personal financial concerns such as Social Security and Medicare In general however when political representation requires a large group to make their case economic insecurity threats are uniquely disadvantaged Scrutinizing the foundations of political behavior American Insecurity offers a new perspective on collective participation

Speaking for Others Wendy Salkin, 2024-07-09 In *Speaking for Others* political philosopher Wendy Salkin develops the first systematic conceptual and moral analysis of informal political representation Salkin argues that informal representation can be a political lifeline particularly for oppressed and marginalized groups that are denied representation in formal political institutions Yet informal political representatives exert outsized influence over the ways these groups' interests are understood by the public without the represented having much recourse to hold them accountable And many informal political representatives are selected not by the groups they represent but by outsiders sticking these groups with representatives they would not choose but cannot shake The role of informal political representatives is therefore fraught with moral questions What exactly are their duties
