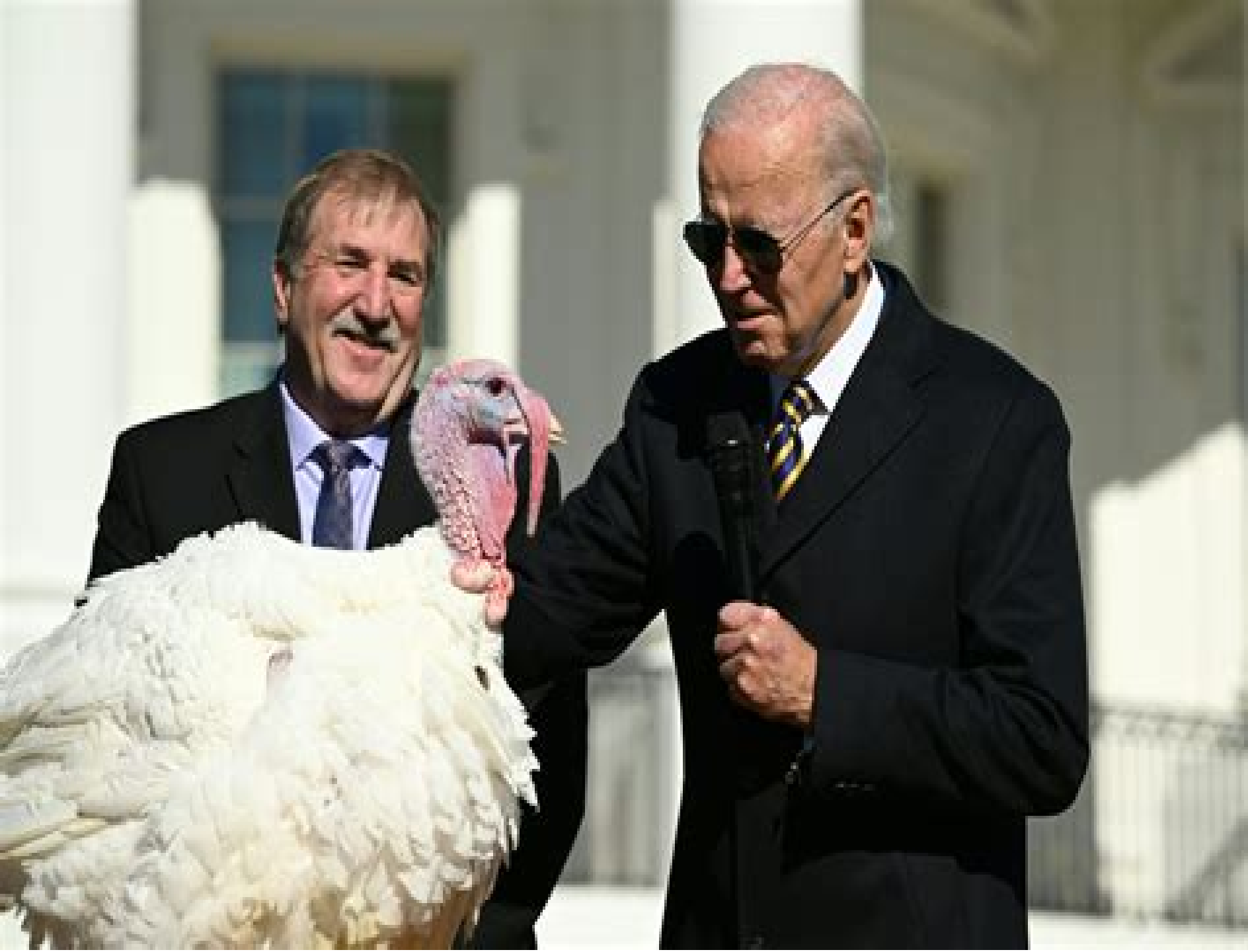

fundamentalism in Turkey Islamic movements are often described as anti modernist thought to be supported by fundamentalist groups living in a bygone age isolated from the rest of the modern world In recent years particularly since the events of 9 11 such movements have also been seen as a threat to the Western way of life But Delibas argues that these movements and particularly those in Turkey did not arise out of religious fervour or hatred of Western civilisation as is often claimed Rather they were founded and have thrived as a response to socio economic and political conditions that have been aggravated by neoliberal economic policies rapid urbanisation and the globalization of culture By exploring the structural conditions in which an Islamic movement emerged and become popular in a seemingly secular state *The Rise of Political Islam in Turkey* offers vital analysis for all those researching modern Turkey and the growth of Islamist politics throughout the Middle East and North Africa
