- Sudden onset of bradycardia and hypotension, can be life-threatening when trigeminal sensory branches stimulated.
- Caused by parasympathetic dysrhythmias and associated with other potential symptoms including gastric hypermotility and apnea.
- Possible cause of sudden adult death syndrome and other serious lifethreatening cardiac conditions.

Reflex arc: sensory stimulation of trigeminal nerve through the gasserian ganglion to the sensory nucleus of the trigeminal nerve (fourth ventricle) these then connect to the nucleus ambiguous and dorsal motor nucleus of vagus which then activates the cardioinhibitory parasympathetic vagal neurons which leads to the clinical symptoms.
