of this new edition has been thoroughly reviewed and revised and substantive changes have been made to specific chapters to ensure that the book represents the most current thinking and research while retaining the strengths of the previous edition The chapter on assessment has been revised to put the fundamental components of effective treatment in a clinical case oriented context and includes an easy to use assessment protocol that allows clinicians to determine where individual patients stand on seven dimensions cognitive rigidity problem solving deficits heightened mental pain emotionally avoidant coping style interpersonal deficits self control deficits and environmental stress and social support deficits. 
