Translation and Culture Katherine M. Faull, 2004 How we view the foreign presented either in the interrelated forms of culture language or text determines to a large degree the way in which we translate This volume of essays examines the cultural politics of translation that have determined the production and dissemination of the foreign in domestic cultures as varied as contemporary North America Europe and Israel The essays address from a variety of theoretical perspectives the question posed almost two hundred years ago by the German philosopher Friedrich Schleiermacher of whether the translator should foreignize the domestic or domesticate the foreign

Translation and Culture Katherine Faull, 2004-02 Translation and Culture examines the cultural politics of translation that determine the production and dissemination of the foreign in domestic cultures as varied as contemporary North America Europe and Israel *Literary Digital Stylistics in Translation Studies* Anna Maria Cipriani, 2023-11-20 This book presents a systematic literary comparison of the retranslations by adopting a mixed method and bottom up inductive approach by developing an empirical corpus approach This corpus is specifically tailored to identify and study linguistic and non linguistic modernist features throughout the texts such as stream of consciousness indirect interior monologue and free indirect speech All occurrences are analysed quantitatively in the computations of inferential and comparative statistics such as tests of time trends lexical variety and lexical frequency The target texts are digitised and the resulting text files are then analysed using a bespoke novel computer program capable of the functions not provided by commercially available software such as WordSmith Tools and WMatrix This methodology enables in depth explorations of micro and macro textual features and allows a mixed method approach combining close reading qualitative analysis with systematic quantitative comparisons The empirical study of the digital corpus of eleven Italian re translations of Virginia Woolf's *To the Lighthouse* identifies a progressive source text orientation only in a relatively few aspects of a few target texts The translators presence affects all the examined target texts in terms of register and style under the influence of the Italian translation norms usually attributed to the translation of literary classics Its intended readership comprises students of the mentioned fields and the general public of readers editors and publishers

Translation Changes Everything Lawrence Venuti, 2013 In *Translation Changes Everything* leading theorist Lawrence Venuti gathers fourteen of his incisive essays since 2000 The selection sketches the trajectory of his thinking about translation while engaging with the main trends in research and commentary The issues covered include basic concepts like equivalence retranslation and reader reception sociological topics like the impact of translations in the academy and the global cultural economy and philosophical problems such as the translator's unconscious and translation ethics Every essay presents case studies that include Venuti's own translation projects illuminating the connections between theoretical concepts and verbal choices The texts drawn from a broad variety of languages are both humanistic and pragmatic encompassing such forms as poems and novels religious and philosophical works travel guidebooks and advertisements The

discussions all explore practical applications whether writing publishing reviewing teaching or studying translations Venuti's aim is to conceive of translation as an interpretive act with far reaching social effects at once enabled and constrained by specific cultural situations This latest chapter in his developing work is essential reading for translators and students of translation alike *Retranslating Joyce for the 21st Century*, 2020-04-28 The essays in *Retranslating Joyce for the 21st Century* straddle the disciplines of Joyce studies translation studies and translation theory The newest scholarly developments in these fields are well reflected in recent retranslations of Joyce's works into Italian Portuguese French Hungarian Dutch Turkish German South Slavic and many other languages Joyce critics and Joyce translators offer multi-angled critical attention to the issues of translation and retranslation enhanced by their diverse linguistic and cultural backgrounds and innovative methodologies Because retranslations of Joyce have also exerted significant influence on target language cultures students and readers of Joyce and more broadly of modernist and world literature will find this book highly relevant to their appreciation of literature in translation

Multimodal Experiences Across Cultures, Spaces and Identities Ayelet Kohn, Rachel Weissbrod, 2023-03-31 This book explores the interplay between various semiotic modes in multimodal texts and the ways in which they are employed to express cultural translation seeking to expand prevailing views of translation and adaptation in light of everchanging social realities Drawing on work from multimodal discourse studies translation studies and adaptation studies Kohn and Weissbrod shed a light on the increasing prominence of the visual in multimodal texts in the act of translation in a broad sense and specifically in conveying cultural translation broadly understood as the processes and experiences which communities and individuals undergo in the face of social and cultural upheavals which require them to become acquainted with new signs uniquely encoded across different contexts Each example showcases individual sociocultural domains while also engaging in the active role of the audience and the respective spaces these works inhabit The book brings together work from translation and adaptation studies and multimodality and opens up avenues for new research making it of interest to scholars in these disciplines as well as fields such as media studies migration studies and cultural studies

Elizabethan Translation and Literary Culture Gabriela Schmidt, 2013-04-30 Reversing F O Matthiessen's famous description of translation as an Elizabethan art Elizabethan literature may well be considered an art of translation Amidst a climate of intense intercultural and intertextual exchange the cultural figure of *translatio studii* had become a formative concept in most European vernacular writing of the period However due to the comparatively marginal status of English in European literary culture it was above all translation in the literal sense that became the dominant mode of applying this concept in late 16th century England Translations into English were not only produced on an unprecedented scale they also became a key site for critical debate where contemporary discussions about authorship style and the development of a specifically English literary identity converged The essays in this volume set out to explore Elizabethan translation as a literary practice and as a crucial influence on English literature They analyse the

competitive balancing of voices and authorities found in these texts and examine the ways in which both translated models and English literary culture were creatively transformed in the process of appropriation **Identity and Theatre**
