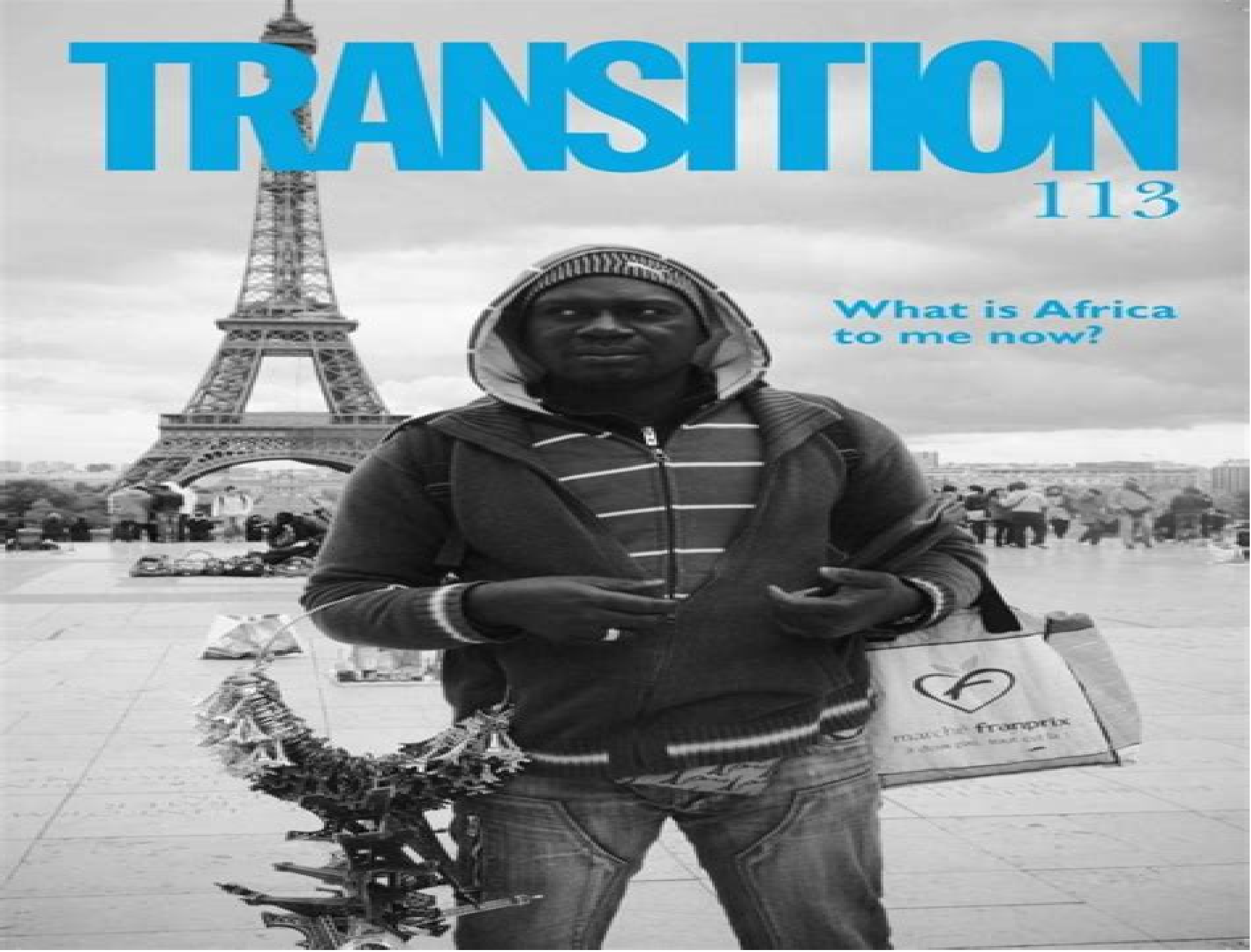

Creating New Languages of Resistance Omid Tofighian, 2025-04-30 Omid Tofighian has been engaged in collaborative philosophical artistic and political work with displaced exiled and incarcerated peoples for 25 years These interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary collaborations include co authoring different genres of writing in English co creation and translation into English and shared intellectual and artistic projects The most notable example is his translation and collaboration in Behrouz Boochani's award winning book No Friend but the Mountains Writing from Manus Prison 2018 *Creating New Languages of Resistance* is an intellectual and personal reflection on creative resistance it addresses critical issues pertaining to epistemic injustice kyriarchy and border violence Incorporating scholarship different literary genres exclusive interviews media articles and notes on translation this rigorous and accessible study examines the shared philosophical activity Tofighian participates in with different collaborators It suggests experimental and collaborative ways for producing and analysing similar texts and cultural productions creates new spaces and frameworks for thinking about displacement and exile and raises compelling questions and issues for people interested in researching and working to end border violence bordering and intersectional discrimination Presenting a special rationale and philosophical vision about collaboration and co creation in extreme situations this is key reading for students scholars and general readers interested in critical and cultural border studies translation studies public philosophy literatures of resistance coloniality and decoloniality identity and positionality

Runaway Genres Yogita Goyal, 2019-10-29 Winner 2021 Ren Wellek Prize given by the American Comparative Literature Association Winner 2021 Barbara Perkins and George Perkins Award given by the International Society for the Study of Narrative Honorable Mention 2020 James Russell Lowell Prize given by the Modern Language Association Argues that the slave narrative is a new world literary genre In Runaway Genres Yogita Goyal tracks the emergence of slavery as the defining template through which current forms of human rights abuses are understood The post black satire of Paul Beatty and Mat Johnson modern slave narratives from Sudan to Sierra Leone and the new Afropolitan diaspora of writers like Teju Cole and Chimamanda Ngozi Adichie all are woven into Goyal s argument for the slave narrative as a new world literary genre exploring the full complexity of this new ethical globalism From the humanitarian spectacles of Kony 2012 and BringBackOurGirls through gothic literature Runaway Genres unravels for instance how and why the African child soldier has now appeared as the afterlife of the Atlantic slave Goyal argues that in order to fathom forms of freedom and bondage today from unlawful detention to sex trafficking to the refugee crisis to genocide we must turn to contemporary literature which reveals how the literary forms used to tell these stories derive from the antebellum genre of the slave narrative Exploring the ethics and aesthetics of globalism the book presents alternative conceptions of human rights showing that the revival and proliferation of slave narratives offers not just an occasion to revisit the Atlantic past but also for re narrating the global present In reassessing these legacies and their ongoing relation to race and the human Runaway Genres creates a new map with which to navigate contemporary black diaspora literature

While currently identitarian ideologies and essentialist notions of identity that tend to simplify and reduce life experience to simple factors are globally regaining massive attention, it becomes inevitable to recollect the thorough discussions of identity concepts of the past three decades. It also calls for an ever keener awareness of and capacity to deal with the complexity and diversity of the world we live in. Artists play a major role in the potential reflection and transformation of perceptions and conceptions of the world: musicians, dancers, choreographers, spoken word artists, performance artists, actors, also fine art installation media artists or photographers alike. Performing critical identity points to performative practices of artists that bring to the fore a critical self-awareness and self-positioning concerning identification and belonging. Social identities such as gender, sexuality, race, class, disability, age, or non-religiosity are closely linked to the historical, social, regional, and political dimensions of their formation. From this perspective, identities are hardly one-dimensional but complex and intersectional and are rather to be thought of as a process of identification and belonging than as a consistent essence. World is Africa Eddie Chambers, 2020-12-10 *World is Africa* brings together more than 30 important texts by Eddie Chambers who for several decades has been an original and a critical voice within the field of African diaspora art history The texts range from book chapters and catalogue essays to shorter texts Chambers focuses on contemporary artists and their practices from a range of international locations who for the most part are identified with the African diaspora None of the texts are available online and none have been available outside of the original publication in which they first appeared The volume contains several new pieces of writing including a consideration of the art world fetishization of the 1980s as the manifestation of a reluctance to accept the majority of Black British artists as valid individual practitioners choosing instead to shackle them to exhibitions that took place three decades ago Another new text re examines the map paintings of Frank Bowling the Guyana born artist who was the subject of a major retrospective at Tate Britain in 2019 The third introduces the little known record sleeve illustrations of Charles White the American artist who was the subject of a major retrospective in 2018 at major galleries across the US Among the other new texts is a critical reflection on the patronage the Greater London Council extended to Black artists in 1980s London *World is Africa* makes a valuable contribution to the emerging discipline of black British art history the field of African diaspora studies and African diaspora art history
