The study identified the over arching driver for self directed professional development as the teacher's need to improve their self efficacy. A two dimensional model of self directed professional development was suggested The systemic element of the model focused on the self correcting impact of ICT use on professional development whilst the personal element focused on self efficacy as the central stratum for self directed
