collaboration and in competition with government Skilful navigators of the modern technocratic state they have brought expertise to expertise and in so doing have changed the nature of grassroots activism As affluent citizens have felt marginalised by the increasingly complex nature of many policy solutions they have made the rational calculation to support NGOs the professionalism and resources of which make them better able to tackle complex problems Yet in doing so support rather than participation becomes the more appropriate way to describe the relationship of the public to NGOs As voter turnout has declined membership and trust in NGOs has increased But NGOs are very different types of organisations from the classic democratic institutions of political parties and the labour movement They maintain different and varied relationships with the publics they seek to represent Attracting mass support has provided them with the resources and the legitimacy to speak to power on a bewildering range of issues yet perhaps the ultimate victors in this new form of politics are the NGOs themselves
