This is what Bentham and Mill call the principle of utility or the greatest happiness principle Both Bentham and Mill thus endorse classical or hedonistic forms of utilitarianism More recent utilitarians often deny that happiness is the sole intrinsic good arguing that a variety of values and consequences should be considered in ethical decision making Although Mill agreed with Bentham about many of the foundational principles of ethics he also had some major disagreements In particular Mill tried to develop a more refined form of utilitarianism that would harmonize better with ordinary morality and highlight the importance in the ethical life of intellectual pleasures self development high ideals of character and conventional moral rules In Chapter 1 titled General Remarks Mill notes that there has been little progress in ethics Since the beginning of philosophy the same issues have been debated over and over again and philosophers continue to disagree sharply over the basic starting points of ethics Mill argues that these philosophical disputes have not seriously damaged popular morality largely because conventional morality is substantially though implicitly utilitarian He concludes the chapter by noting that he will not attempt to give a strict proof of the greatest happiness principle Like Bentham Mill believed that ultimate ends and first principles cannot be demonstrated since they lie at the foundation of everything else that we know and believe Nevertheless he claims considerations may be presented capable of determining the intellect which amount to something close to a proof of the principle of utility An Analysis of John Stuart Mills's Utilitarianism Tom Patrick, Sander Werkhoven, 2017-07-05 John Stuart Mill's 1861 Utilitarianism remains one of the most widely known and influential works of moral philosophy ever written It is also a model of critical thinking one in which Mill's reasoning and interpretation skills are used to create a well structured watertight persuasive argument for his position on core questions in ethics.
