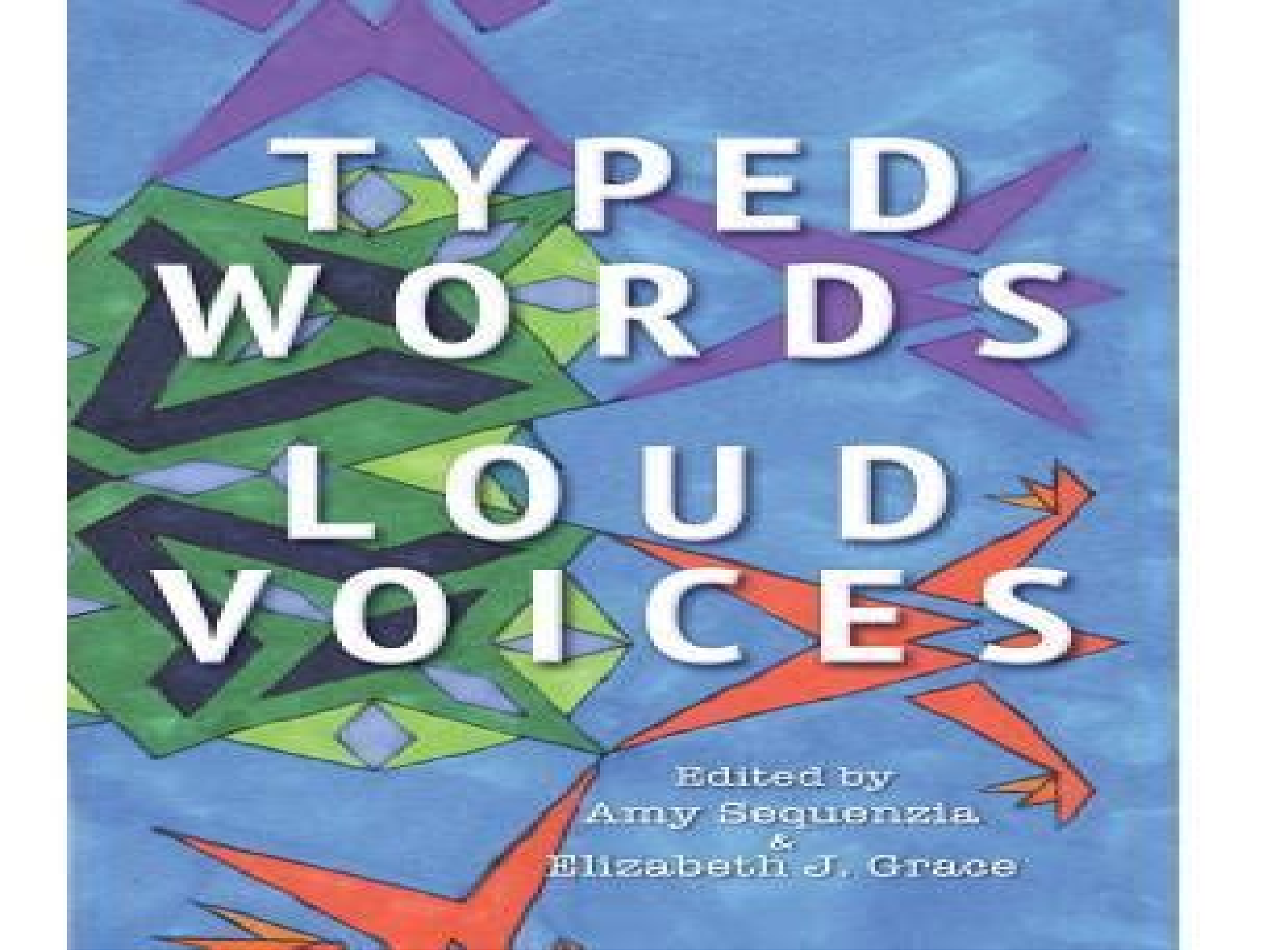

scholarly readers across the fields of disability studies the medical humanities cultural studies critical psychology sociology anthropology and literature
