**The Cities of the Plain** Robin Rönnlund, 2023-09-30 This book explores urbanism in Antiquity from an archaeological perspective focusing on the area of western Thessaly in central Greece Presenting all the available evidence for ancient urban sites in the region the study outlines and discusses the origins development and decline of urbanism in the area The archaeological evidence shows that urban sites in western Thessaly developed from the mid 4th century BCE with at least 25 identified contemporaneous cities spread over the area These cities appear to have been planned and organised from the onset with regular street grids fortification systems and water supply works but were generally short lived typically existing for only five six generations Most of the sites were completely or nearly completely abandoned as settlements in the early 2nd century BCE often with evidence of violent destruction and only a handful survived as smaller regional centres under the Roman administration Restorations of the former urban sites and especially their fortifications occur towards the end of Antiquity especially the first half of the 6th century CE but re occupation appears again to have been short lived as only three cities survived into the Middle Ages From a regional perspective the study shows that the rise and fall of urbanism itself did not necessarily cause complete socio political disruption but rather reflect changes in regional and supra regional political organisation On a global scale the study exemplifies the political nature of the pre Industrial city its synthetic rather than organic role in agrarian societies and the cyclic nature of urbanity in history The book contains an extensive catalogue presenting each site with photographs topographical sketches and complete bibliography

features influence users responses and tolerance to environmental stressors because of age health gender habits and behaviour thus impacting the users vulnerability Exposure can then amplify these issues since it defines the number of users that can be effectively affected by the SLOD Starting from this perspective the book first traces literature based correlations between individual features use behaviour and individual response to the SLOD altered open spaces Then a novel methodology to quantify the variations of users vulnerability and exposure is offered to support designers in quickly defining input scenarios for risk assessment and mitigation Lastly it demonstrates through a case study the SLOD risk assessment framework proposed and the evaluation of the efficacy of risk mitigation strategies

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web to find a profile in a file that uses the aws credentials file format either the shared aws credentials file in its default location or a custom credentials file use the sharedcredentialsfile class files in this format are sometimes simply called credentials files in this text for brevity to find a profile in the sdk store use the

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web the aws sdk for php has a series of places that it checks in order to find values for global settings and credential providers the following is the order of precedence any explicit setting set in the code or on a service client itself takes precedence over anything else use credentials from environment variables

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web when you interact with aws you specify your aws security credentials to verify who you are and whether you have permission to access the resources that you are requesting aws uses the security credentials to authenticate and authorize your requests for example if you want to download a protected file from an amazon simple storage service amazon

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web frominiinit awscredentialidentityprovider creates a credential provider function that reads from a shared credentials file at aws credentials and a shared configuration file at aws config both files are expected to be ini formatted with section names corresponding to profiles sections in the credentials file are treated as profile

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
