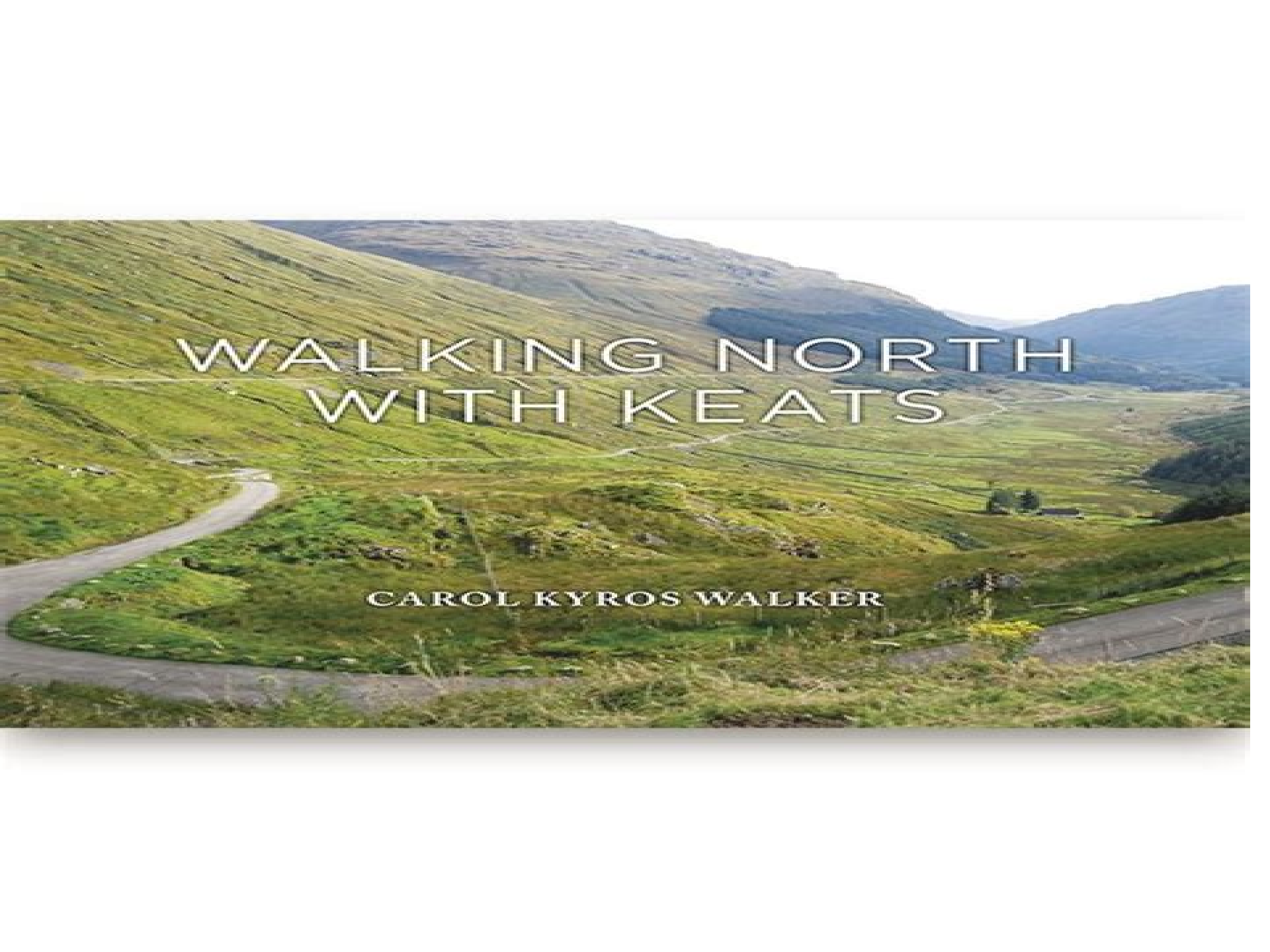

Walker, 1992-01-01 *Walking North with Keats* Ramboro Books, 1997-06-01 The Living Church , 1995-07 Romanticism and Time Sophie Laniel-Musitelli, Céline Sabiron, 2021-03-10 Eternity is in love with the productions of time This original edited volume takes William Blake s aphorism as a basis to explore how British Romantic literature creates its own sense of time It considers Romantic poetry as embedded in and reflecting on the march of time regarding it not merely as a reaction to the course of events between the late eighteenth and mid nineteenth centuries but also as a form of creative engagement with history in the making The authors offer a comprehensive overview of the question of time from a literary perspective applying a diverse range of critical approaches to Romantic authors from William Blake and Percy Shelley to John Clare and Samuel Rogers Close readings uncover fresh insights into these authors and their works including *Frankenstein* the most familiar of Romantic texts Revising current thinking about periodisation the authors explore how the Romantic poetics of time bears witness to the ruptures and dislocations at work within chronological time They consider an array of topics such as ecological time futurity operatic time or the temporality of Venice As well as surveying the Romantic canon s evolution over time these essays approach it as a phenomenon unfolding across national borders Romantic authors are compared with American or European counterparts including Beethoven Irving Nietzsche and Beckett *Romanticism and Time* will be of great value to literary scholars and students working in Romantic Studies It will be of further interest to philosophers and historians working on the connections between philosophy history and literature during the nineteenth century *Mountaineering and British Romanticism* Simon Bainbridge, 2020-04-16 This book examines the relationship between Romantic period writing and the activity that Samuel Taylor Coleridge christened mountaineering in 1802 It argues that mountaineering developed as a pursuit in Britain during the Romantic era earlier than is generally recognised and shows how writers including William and Dorothy Wordsworth Ann Radcliffe Samuel Taylor Coleridge John Keats and Walter Scott were central to the activity s evolution It explores how the desire for physical ascent shaped Romantic period literary culture and investigates how the figure of the mountaineer became crucial to creative identities and literary outputs Illustrated with 25 images from the period the book shows how mountaineering in Britain had its origins in scientific research antiquarian travel and the search for the picturesque and the sublime It considers how writers engaged with mountaineering s power dynamics and investigates issues including the politics of the summit view what Wordsworth terms visual sovereignty the relationships between different types of mountaineers and the role of women in the developing cultures of ascent Placing the work of canonical writers alongside a wide range of other types of mountaineering literature this book reassesses key Romantic

period terms and ideas such as vision insight elevation revelation transcendence and the sublime It opens up new ways of understanding the relationship between Romantic period writers and the world that they experienced through their feet and hands as well as their eyes as they moved through the challenging landscapes of the British mountains **Keats's Places** Richard Marggraf Turley, 2018-09-03 As the essays in this volume reveal Keats's places could be comforting familiar grounding sites but they were also shifting uncanny paradoxical spaces where the geographical comes into tension with the familial the touristic with the medical the metropolitan with the archipelagic Collectively the chapters in Keats's Places range from the claustrophobic stands of Guy's Hospital operating theatre to the boneshaking interior of the Southampton mail coach from Highland crags to Hampstead Heath from crowded city interiors to leafy suburban lanes Offering new insights into the complex registrations of place and the poetic imagination the contributors to this book explore how the significant places in John Keats's life helped to shape an authorial identity Collected Poems of Stanley Plumly Stanley Plumly, 2025-08-12 The definitive collection of one of the most celebrated poets of his generation and a master of the lyric poem in its richest most flexible registers Stanley Plumly is one of the most emotionally complex sustaining and influential American poets of the last fifty years Born in 1939 Plumly wrote poems that explored the deep interiors of the human heart and mind against a wide backdrop of cultural and historical events Profoundly personal yet socially astute his work is both descriptively exact and allusive engaging nature and art as well as family and friendship For the two years before his death in 2019 Plumly worked with David Baker and Michael Collier this book's two editors to make preparations for the present volume This Collected Poems contains nearly three hundred of his poems including nine new previously unpublished ones and stands as a permanent archive of Plumly's achievement in verse As Plumly wished Collected Poems does not categorize the poems by individual volume but presents a continuum of his lyric accomplishments This book bears his gifts and his specific blessing embodying his wish to offer his poems in reverse chronology tracing back from the present to the very origins of his aesthetic In every way it is the book Stanley Plumly wanted to be remembered by Collected Poems gathers the full range of Plumly's talent as it charts the development of his unique and enduring contribution to the American lyric The volume stands as a tribute to Plumly's artistic vision and will be welcomed by his many readers now and in the generations to come **Stepping Westward** Nigel Leask, 2020 Stepping Westward is the first book dedicated to the literature of the Scottish Highland tour of 1720-1830 a major cultural phenomenon that attracted writers and artists like Pennant Johnson and Boswell William and Dorothy Wordsworth Coleridge Scott Hogg Keats Daniell and Turner as well as numerous less celebrated travellers and tourists Addressing more than a century's worth of literary and visual representations of the Highlands the book casts new light on how the tour developed a modern literature of place acting as a catalyst for thinking about improvement landscape and the shaping of British Scottish and Gaelic identities It pays attention to the relationship between travellers and the native Gaels whose world was plunged into crisis by rapid and forced social change At the book's

core lie the best selling tours of Pennant and Dr Johnson associated with attempts to improve the intractable Gaidhealtachd in the wake of Culloden. Alongside the Ossian craze and Gilpin's picturesque their books stimulated a wave of home tours from the 1770s through the romantic period including writing by women like Sarah Murray and Dorothy Wordsworth. The incidence of published Highland Tours many lavishly illustrated peaked around 1800 but as the genre reached exhaustion the romantic Highlands were reinvented in Scott's poems and novels coinciding with steam boats and mass tourism but also rack renting sheep clearance and emigration.

Shelley's Eye Benjamin Colbert, 2017-03-02 Percy Bysshe Shelley joined the deluge of sightseers that poured onto the Continent after Napoleon's defeat in 1814 and over the next eight years Shelley followed major travelling trends visiting Switzerland in 1816 and Italy from 1818. Shelley's Eye is the first study to address Shelley's participation in the travel culture of Post Napoleonic Europe and the first to consider Shelley as an important travel writer in his own right. This book is informed by original research on a wide range of period travel writings including Mary Shelley and Shelley's neglected collaboration History of a Six Weeks Tour 1817 in which Mont Blanc first appeared. Fully responsive to the culture of travel Shelley's travel prose and poetry form fascinating conversations with major Romantic travellers like Byron, Wollstonecraft and Wordsworth as well as lesser known but widely read travel writers of the day including Morris Birkbeck, Charlotte Eaton and John Chetwode Eustace. In this provocative study Benjamin Colbert demonstrates how the Grand Tour remains a vital cultural metaphor for Shelley and his contemporaries under pressure from mass travel and popular culture. Shelley's travel prose and visionary poetry explore motives of perception underlying travel discourse and posit an authentic aesthetic vision that reconfigures social, historical and political meanings of sights from the perspective of an ideal tourist observer. Shelley's Eye offers a new perspective on Shelley's intellectual history. It is also a timely and important contribution to recent interdisciplinary scholarship that aims to re-evaluate Romantic idealism in the context of physical, experiential or material cultural practices.
