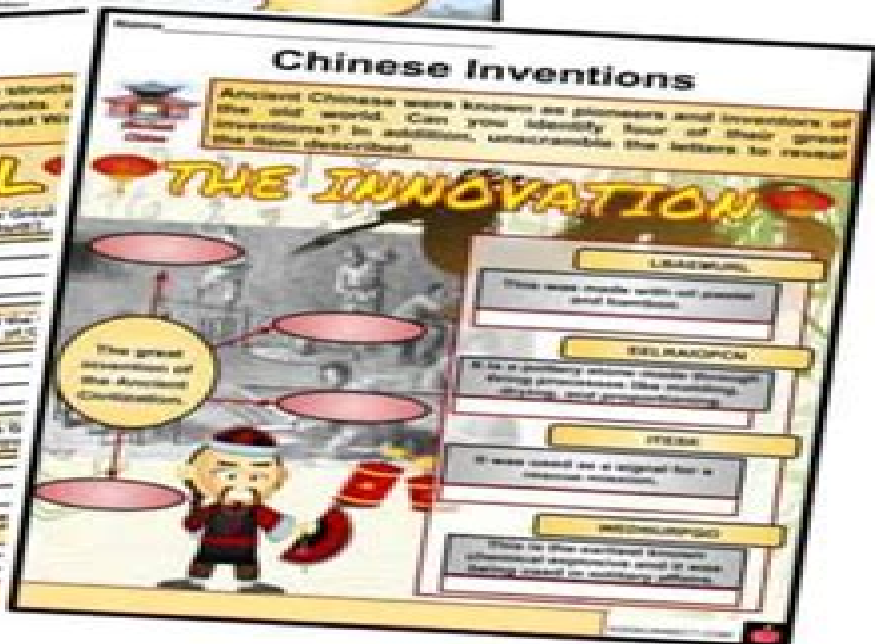

texts a strict correlation between the author and the text results from later conceptions of literary history Before the modern era there existed a conceptual gap between an author and a writer A pre modern Chinese text could have had both an author and a writer or even multiple authors and multiple writers This work is the first study addressing these issues by more systematically emphasizing the connection of the text the author and the religious and sociopolitical settings in which these issues were embedded It is expected to constitute a palpable contribution to Chinese studies and the discipline of philology in general
