It can be modified in various ways to fit the individual's needs and challenges many other cognitive and visual perceptual skills such

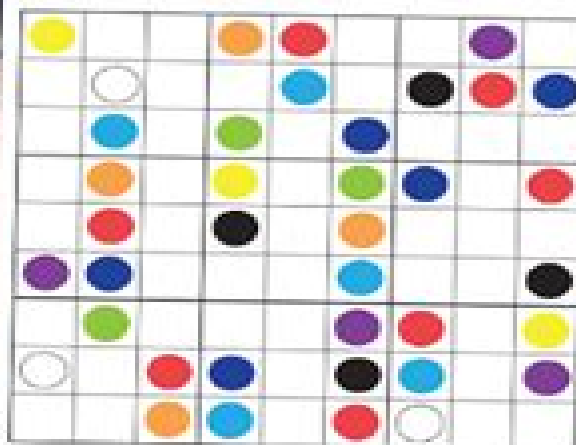
OPTIONS FOR IMPLEMENTING THIS ACTIVITY

- Attach the activity onto a wall to address gross motor coordination, maximize

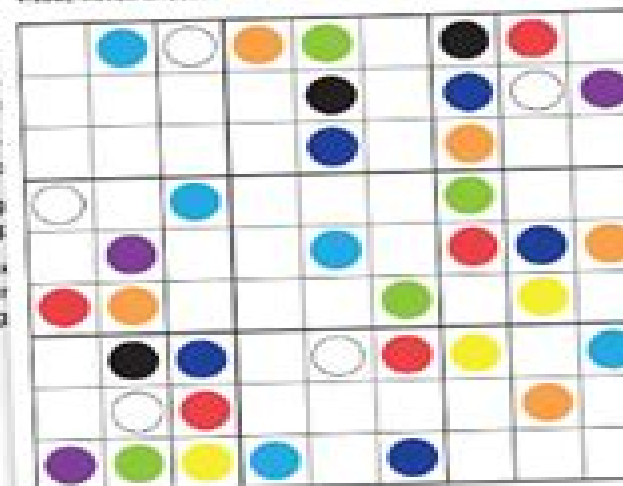
