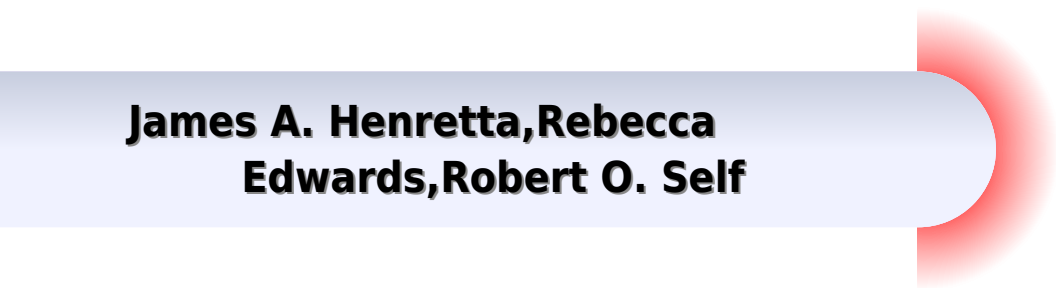

Women and Patriotism in Jim Crow America Francesca Morgan, 2006-05-18 After the Civil War many Americans did not identify strongly with the concept of a united nation Francesca Morgan finds the first stirrings of a sense of national patriotism of these United States in the work of black and white clubwomen in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries Morgan demonstrates that hundreds of thousands of women in groups such as the Woman s Relief Corps the National Association of Colored Women the Universal Negro Improvement Association the United Daughters of the Confederacy and the Daughters of the American Revolution sought to produce patriotism on a massive scale in the absence of any national emergency They created holidays like Confederate Memorial Day placed American flags in classrooms funded monuments and historic markers and preserved old buildings and battlegrounds Morgan argues that while clubwomen asserted women s importance in cultivating national identity and participating in public life white groups and black groups did not have the same nation in mind and circumscribed their efforts within the racial boundaries of their time Presenting a truly national history of these generally understudied groups Morgan proves that before the government began to show signs of leadership in patriotic projects in the 1930s women s organizations were the first articulators of American nationalism

the wake of the Nineteenth Amendment Republican women set out to forge a place for themselves within the Grand Old Party As Catherine Rymph explains their often conflicting efforts over the subsequent decades would leave a mark on both conservative politics and American feminism Part of an emerging body of work on women's participation in partisan politics Republican Women explores the dilemmas confronting progressive conservative and moderate Republican women as they sought to achieve a voice for themselves within the GOP Rymph first examines women's grassroots organizing for the party in the decades following the initiation of women's suffrage She then traces Marion Martin's efforts from 1938 to 1946 to shape the National Federation of Women's Republican Clubs the party's increasing dependence on the work of women at the grassroots in the postwar years and the eventual mobilization of many of these women behind Barry Goldwater in defiance of party leaders From the flux of the party's post Goldwater years emerged two groups of women on a collision course a group

of party insiders calling themselves feminists challenged supporters of independent Republican Phyllis Schlafly's growing movement opposing the Equal Rights Amendment. Their battles over the meanings of gender power and Republicanism continued earlier struggles even as they helped shape the party's fundamental transformation in the Reagan years.

Making Home Work Jane E. Simonsen, 2006-12-08 During the westward expansion of America, white middle class ideals of home and domestic work were used to measure differences between white and Native American women. Yet the vision of America as home was more than a metaphor for women's stake in the process of conquest; it took deliberate work to create and uphold. Treating white and indigenous women's struggles as part of the same history, Jane E. Simonsen argues that as both cultural workers and domestic laborers insisted upon the value of their work to civilization, they exposed the inequalities integral to both the nation and the household. Simonsen illuminates discussions about the value of women's work through analysis of texts and images created by writers, women's rights activists, reformers, anthropologists, photographers, field matrons, and Native American women. She argues that women such as Caroline Soule, Alice Fletcher, E. Jane Gay, Anna Dawson Wilde, and Angel DeCora called upon the rhetoric of sentimental domesticity, ethnographic science, public display, and indigenous knowledge as they sought to make the gendered and racial order of the nation visible through homes and the work performed in them. Focusing on the range of materials through which domesticity was produced in the West, Simonsen integrates new voices into the study of domesticity's imperial manifestations.

Leaders of Their Race Sarah H. Case, 2017-08-30 Secondary level female education played a foundational role in reshaping women's identity in the New South. Sarah H. Case examines the transformative processes involved at two Georgia schools: one in Atlanta for African American girls and young women, the other in Athens attended by young white women with elite backgrounds. Focusing on the period between 1880 and 1925, Case's analysis shows how race, gender, sexuality, and region worked within these institutions to shape education. Her comparative approach shines a particular light on how female education embodied the complex ways racial and gender identity functioned at the time. As she shows, the schools cultivated modesty and self-restraint to protect the students. Indeed, concerns about female sexuality and respectability united the schools despite their different student populations. Case also follows the lives of the women as adult teachers, alumnae, and activists who drew on their education to negotiate the New South's economic and social upheavals.
