Reichertz and Jack Wong **Women in the Arts** Barbara Harbach, Diane Touliatos-Miles, 2015-02-27 Is there a need for books about women in the arts exhibitions of women painters readings of women's poetry concerts of music by women composers and conferences highlighting women in the arts One might believe that today the playing field is level but categories still place the word woman before the discipline woman composer woman poet woman artist and so on The ultimate goal is to move the debate away from gender categories which reinforce the notion that men's creativity is not only the norm but better There are many women challenging the status quo and succeeding Change comes slowly since many men and some women in positions of power do not see gender stereotyping as a problem It's been nearly a millennium since Hildegard von Bingen composed music and illuminated manuscripts Shouldn't the time when it was unusual to be a woman composer have past As the great 20th century pedagogue and composer Nadia Boulanger said I've been a woman for a little over 50 years and have gotten over my initial astonishment As for conducting an orchestra that's a job where I don't think sex plays much part Indeed books like *Women in the Arts Eccentric Essays II* serve to bring society just a little closer to equality by keeping the accomplishments of women at the forefront of consciousness Technology today is a great asset in documenting the productivity of women and all artistic creations can be codified and archived in contrast to earlier times when creative women's birth and death dates are unknown not even taking into account all their lost creations The essays contained in *Women in the Arts Eccentric Essays II* reflect the lives of creative artists whether they are teachers scholars and researchers recovering previous generations of women artists or practicing artists creating new masterpieces The promotion of the roles of women in the arts is integral so that they may serve as a resource for future generations of students scholars and researchers and to enhance generations to come enriching culture through the arts *Modeling Life* Sarah R. Phillips, 2012-02-01 This is a book about life modeling Unlike the painter whose name appears beside his finished portrait the life model posing nude perhaps for months goes unacknowledged Standing at a unique juncture between nude and naked between high and low culture between art and pornography the life model is admired in a finished sculpture but scorned for her or his posing Making use of extensive interviews with both male and female models and quoting them frequently Sarah R. Phillips gives a voice to life models She explores the meaning that life models give to themselves and to their work and seeks to understand the lived experience of life models as they practice their profession Throughout history people have romanticized life models in an aura of bohemian eroticism or condemned them as strippers or sex workers *Modeling Life* reveals how life models get into the business managing sexuality in the studio what it means to be a muse and why their work is important *Drawn to Design* Eric Jenkins, 2022-04-19 The book is a guide for students and teachers to understand the need for the role of and the methods and techniques of freehand analytical sketching in architecture The presentation focuses on drawing as an approach to and phase of architectural design The conceptual goal of this approach is to use drawing not as illustration or depiction but as exploration The first part of the book discusses underlying concepts of

freehand sketching in design education and practice as a complement to digital technologies The main component is a series of chapters that constitute a typology of fundamental issues in architecture and urban design for instance issues of facade are illustrated with sketch diagrams that show how facades can be explored and sketched through a series of specific questions and step by step procedures In the expanded and updated edition a new part explores the questions and experiences of large architectural offices in applying freehand drawing in the practice of architectural design This book is especially timely in an age in which the false conflict between traditional vs digital gives way to multiple design tools including sketching It fosters understanding of the essential human ability to investigate the designed and the natural world through freehand drawing

Unflattening Nick Sousanis, 2015-04-20 The primacy of words over images has deep roots in Western culture But what if the two are inextricably linked equal partners in meaning making Written and drawn entirely as comics Unflattening is an experiment in visual thinking Nick Sousanis defies conventional forms of scholarly discourse to offer readers both a stunning work of graphic art and a serious inquiry into the ways humans construct knowledge Unflattening is an insurrection against the fixed viewpoint Weaving together diverse ways of seeing drawn from science philosophy art literature and mythology it uses the collage like capacity of comics to show that perception is always an active process of incorporating and reevaluating different vantage points While its vibrant constantly morphing images occasionally serve as illustrations of text they more often connect in nonlinear fashion to other visual references throughout the book They become allusions allegories and motifs pitting realism against abstraction and making us aware that more meets the eye than is presented on the page In its graphic innovations and restless shape shifting Unflattening is meant to counteract the type of narrow rigid thinking that Sousanis calls flatness Just as the two dimensional inhabitants of Edwin A Abbott's novella Flatland could not fathom the concept of upwards Sousanis says we are often unable to see past the boundaries of our current frame of mind Fusing words and images to produce new forms of knowledge Unflattening teaches us how to access modes of understanding beyond what we normally apprehend
