major reason why lifespans in the United States fall short of those in many other high income nations Evidence suggests that current obesity levels play a substantial part as well The book reports that lack of universal access to health care in the U S also has increased mortality and reduced life expectancy though this is a less significant factor for those over age 65 because of Medicare access For the main causes of death at older ages cancer and cardiovascular disease available indicators do not suggest that the U S health care system is failing to prevent deaths that would be averted elsewhere In fact cancer detection and survival appear to be better in the U S than in most other high income nations and survival rates following a heart attack also are favorable Explaining Divergent Levels of Longevity in High Income Countries identifies many gaps in research For instance while lung cancer deaths are a reliable marker of the damage from smoking no clear cut marker exists for obesity physical inactivity social integration or other risks considered in this book Moreover evaluation of these risk factors is based on observational studies which unlike randomized controlled trials are subject to many biases
