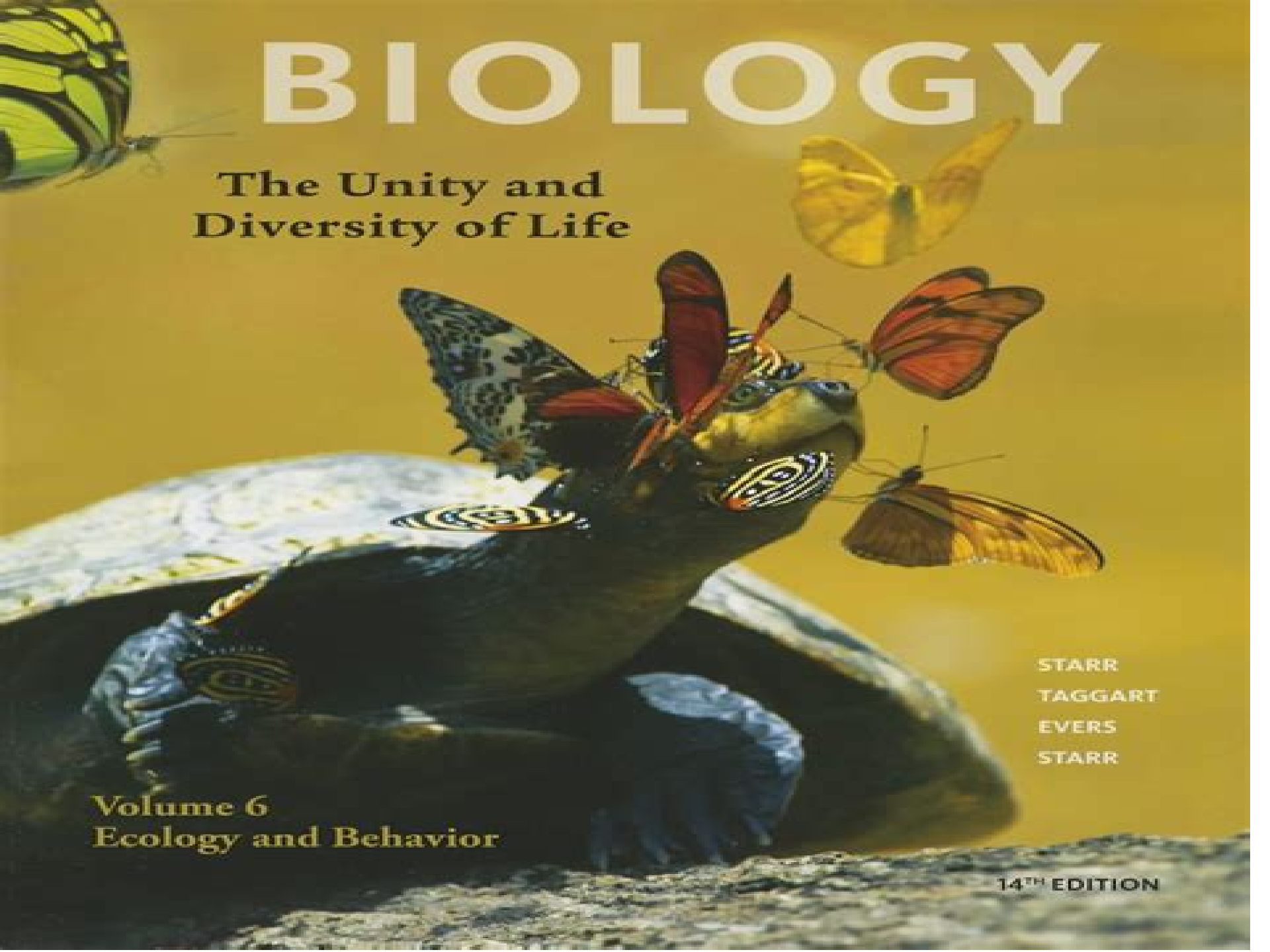

Power, 2013-06-29 In this volume I include chapters on continental population trends ornithology s contribution to the habitat concept social organization outside the breeding season the role of predation in limiting numbers and the evolution of prolonged incubation periods Authors are based in Belgium the United Kingdom and the United States Is there evidence for wholesale population declines in North American birds Robert Askins says yes with qualifications Fragmentation of forest causes the population of many forest interior species to decline and loss of winter forest habitat in Mexico Central America and the Greater Antilles is potentially serious Trends over the past 25 years are however difficult to discern Grassland and shrubland specialists have likewise diminished over the past quarter century Askins calls for management of regional landscapes to maintain habitat diversity As for habitats William Block and Leonard Brennan review the role of ornithology in developing the concept of habitat Their intention is to stimulate ornithologists to consider habitat as a unifying concept in contemporary ecology They describe uses of the habitat concept in basic and experimental ecology Recent advances in sociobiology stimulated deeper interest in social organization Erik Matthysen has gathered a diversity of information on social organization outside the breeding season both in migratory and in nonbreeding resident birds He discusses populations that continue individual associations outside the breeding season and site related aggression territoriality and reviews a number of long term benefits of these behaviors *Early Hominid Activities at Olduvai* Richard Potts, 2017-07-28 The earliest sites at Olduvai Gorge in Tanzania are among the best documented and most

important for studies of human evolution This book investigates the behavior of hominids at Olduvai using data of stone tools and animal bones as well as the results of work in taphonomy how animals become fossils the behavior of mammals and a wide range of ecological theory and data By illustrating the ways in which modern and prehistoric evidence is used in making interpretations the author guides the reader through the geological ecological and archeological areas involved in the study of humans Based on his study of the Olduvai excavations animal life and stone tools the author carefully examines conventional views and proposals about the early Olduvai sites First the evidence of site geology tool cut marks and other clues to the formation of the Olduvai sites are explored On this basis the large mammal communities in which early hominids lived are investigated using methods which compare sites produced mainly by hominids with others made by carnivores Questions about hominid hunting scavenging and the importance of eating meat are then scrutinized The leading alternative positions on each issue are discussed providing a basis for understanding some of the most contentious debates in paleo anthropology today The dominant interpretive model for the artifact and bone accumulations at Olduvai and other Plio Pleistocene sites has been that they represent home bases social foci similar to the campsites of hunter gatherers Based on paleo ecological evidence and ecological models the author critically analyzes the home base interpretation and proposes alternative views A new view of the Olduvai sites that they represent stone caches where hominids processed carcasses for food is shown to have important implications for our understanding of hominid social behavior and evolution **The North**

American Grouse: Their Biology and Behavior Paul Johnsgard, 2016 The ten currently recognized species of grouse in North America have played an important role in America's history from the famous but ill fated heath hen a primary source of meat for the earliest New England immigrants to the ruffed grouse currently one of the most abundant and sought after upland game birds in more than 40 states and provinces This book summarizes the ecology reproductive biology and social behavior of all ten of the extant North American grouse species It also describes the current status of grouse populations some of which are perilously close to extinction The social behavior of grouse is of special biological interest because among these ten species there is a complete mating system spectrum from seasonally monogamous pair bonding to highly promiscuous mating patterns The latter group illustrates the strong structural and behavioral effects of sexual selection resulting from nonmonogamous mating These influences reach a peak in the development by some grouse species of engaging in mating leks arena like competitions performed by males while attempting to attract fertile females and also provide opportunities for females to select optimum mating partners These sexual competitions also promote strong differences evolving in sexual signaling behaviors displays among closely related species Nevertheless a relatively high incidence of mating errors and resulting hybridization often occurs in spite of these marked behavioral differences In addition to a text of 101 000 words the book includes 16 range maps 37 line drawings and 38 photographs by the author as well as nearly 1 400 literature citations **The Human Biome and Human Behaviour** Jorge A.
