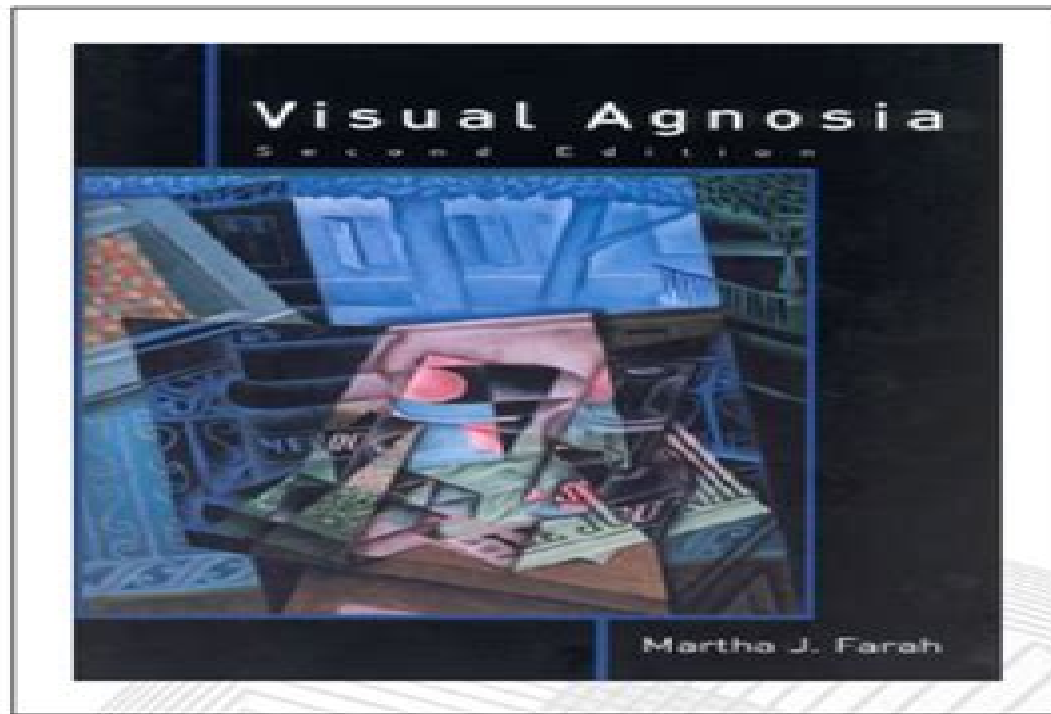

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Visual Agnosia, second edition Martha J. Farah, 2004-04-09 The cognitive neuroscience of human vision draws on two kinds of evidence functional imaging of normal subjects and the study of neurological patients with visual disorders Martha Farah's landmark 1990 book *Visual Agnosia* presented the first comprehensive analysis of disorders of visual recognition within the framework of cognitive neuroscience and remains the authoritative work on the subject This long awaited second edition provides a reorganized and updated review of the visual agnosias incorporating the latest research on patients with insights from the functional neuroimaging literature Visual agnosia refers to a multitude of different disorders and syndromes fascinating in their own right and valuable for what they can tell us about normal human vision Some patients cannot recognize faces but can still recognize other objects while others retain only face recognition Some see only one object at a time others can see multiple objects but recognize only one at a time Some do not consciously perceive the orientation of an object but nevertheless reach for it with perfected oriented grasp others do not consciously recognize a face as familiar but nevertheless respond to it autonomically Each disorder is illustrated with a clinical vignette followed by a thorough review of the case report literature and a discussion of the theoretical implications of the disorder for cognitive neuroscience The second edition extends the range of disorders covered to include disorders of topographic recognition and both general and selective disorders of semantic memory as well as expanded coverage of face recognition impairments Also included are a discussion of the complementary roles of imaging and patient based research in cognitive neuroscience and a final integrative chapter presenting the big picture of object recognition as illuminated by agnosia research *Sight Unseen* Melvyn Goodale, David Milner, 2013-06-27 In this updated and extended edition of their book Goodale and Milner explore one of the most extraordinary neurological cases of recent years one that profoundly changed scientific views on the visual brain Taking us on a journey into the unconscious brain this book is a fascinating illustration of the power of the unconscious mind

The enigma of Bálint's syndrome: complexity of neural substrates and cognitive deficits Magdalena Chechłacz, Glyn Humphreys, 2015-07-10 Bálint's syndrome is named after the Hungarian physician who first reported a remarkable case of a man with complex visuospatial deficits following bilateral

lesions within parietal and occipital cortex Balint 1909 The syndrome has three primary symptoms simultanagnosia impaired spatial awareness of more than one object at time optic ataxia misreaching to visual targets and ocular apraxia described by Balint as psychic paralysis of gaze Balint's patients not only cannot perceive more than one object at time and therefore show poor comprehension of multi object visual scenes i.e. poor detection of all the objects present and difficulty in grasping the relationship between them in addition they typically fail to reach towards location of the single object which they can perceive The deficit of the allocation of spatial attention in Balint's syndrome has been linked to a problem in feature binding which results in illusory conjunctions Patients with Balint's syndrome also show deficits in global processing i.e. when integration of multiple local elements into global compound shapes is required Consequently Balint's syndrome provides a unique opportunity to study the nature and neuroanatomy of human visuospatial processing in particular multi level object representation spatial awareness and the distribution of visual attention The studies collected here cover both the anatomical and the cognitive mechanisms of the different symptoms associated with the syndrome Furthermore the dissociations between the components of Balint's syndrome in particular simultanagnosia and optic ataxia can also co occur with visual neglect and extinction and the different combinations of reported lesions raises a question about the status of the syndrome and whether it should be merely treated as a historical compilation of symptoms which may or may not coexist cohesively This interesting argument is raised here

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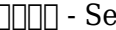
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
