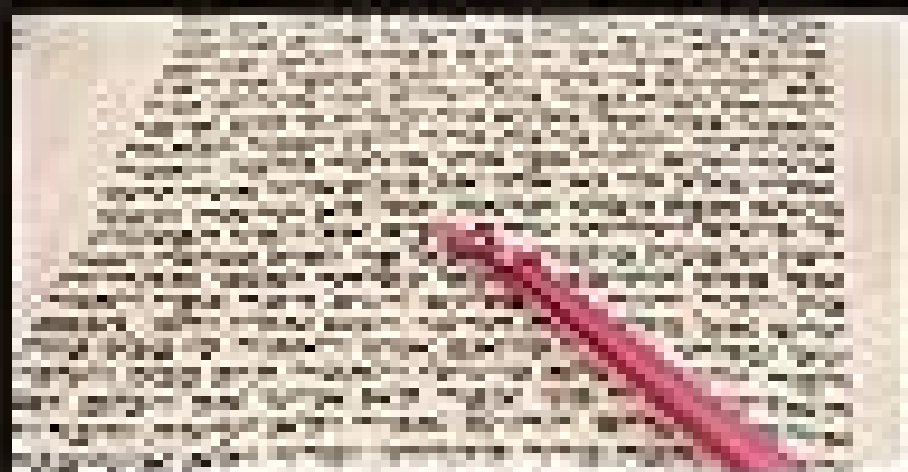

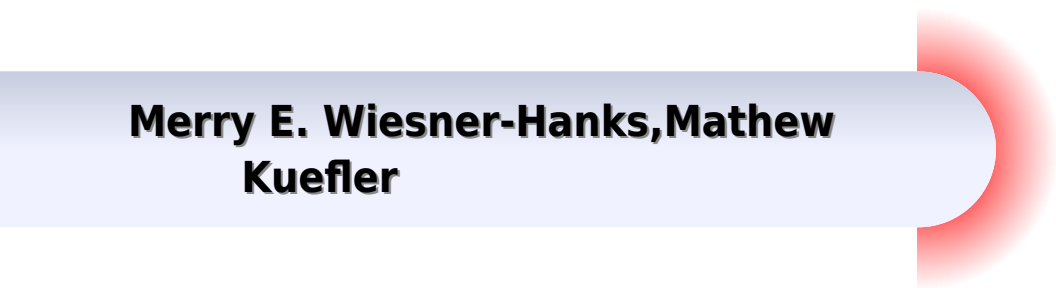

Introducing a Hermeneutics of Suspicion Jo Henderson-Merrygold, 2024-06-13 A hermeneutics of suspicion challenges cisnormative presuppositions that shape and at times occlude the variations in gender and sex exhibited by key characters in the ancestral narrative of Genesis 12-50 It charts the progression from Paul Ricoeur's hermeneutics of suspicion through liberation feminist and queer approaches Focusing on Deryn Guest's queer and trans hermeneutics Henderson Merrygold then offers a new strategy for reading against fixed binary gender assumptions where a character's sex always matches that assigned at birth The initial case study addresses Sarah who is the proto matriarch of the ancestral narratives in Genesis Masculinities contrast with femininities and Sarah's own agency makes the picture of a consistent gender hard to identify By closely reading the text different facets of Sarah's story emerge to emphasise how much the narrative directs the reader towards a cisnormative reading However Henderson Merrygold shows it is not only the images of Sarah as feminine woman and mother that remain visible The subject of the second case study Esau is regularly judged to be a hypermasculine character due to his bodily appearance but repeatedly fails to fulfil the expectations related to that appearance Though often condemned as a poor example of hyper masculinity a suspicious reading identifies a richer and more nuanced figure Attending to Esau's actions his rejection of the gendered expectations appears intentional allowing him to settle more comfortably into his own identity This project advocates for and demonstrates the value of creative interpretations of biblical texts that challenge both malestream and feminist gender assumptions

Troubling Topics, Sacred Texts Roberta Sterman Sabbath, 2021-10-04 Abrahamic scriptures serve as cultural pharmakon prescribing what can act as both poison and remedy This collection shows that their sometimes veiled but eternally powerful polemics can both destroy and build exclude and include and serve as the ultimate justification for cruelty or compassion Here scholars not only excavate these works for their formative and continuing cultural impact on communities identities and belief systems they select some of the most troubling topics that global communities continue to navigate Their analysis of both texts and their reception help explain how these

And the Sages Did Not Know Sarra Lev,2024-01-02 This book explores the question How did the rabbis of the first two centuries CE approach bodies that are born with variant genitals bodies that they could not identify as definitely male or female The rabbis had constructed a system in which every behavior was governed by one s sex gender posing a conundrum both for people who did not fit into that model and for the rabbinic enterprise itself Despite this their texts contain dozens of references to intersex And the Sages Did Not Know examines the rabbis legal texts and concludes that they had multiple approaches to intersex people Sarra Lev analyzes seven different rabbinic responses to this conflict of their own making Through their rulings on how intersex people should conduct themselves in multiple circumstances the early rabbis treat intersex people as unidentifiable males or females as indeterminate as male as non gendered as sui generis as part male part female as a sustainable paradox and finally as a way for them to think about gender having nothing to do with intersex people themselves This is the first such work that concentrates primarily on the potential effects of these rabbinic texts on intersex persons themselves rather than focusing on what the texts offer readers whose interest is rabbinic approaches to sex and gender or gender diversity Although the rabbinic texts do not include the voices of known intersex people these materials do offer us a window into how one small group of people approached intersex bodies and how those approaches were both similar to and different from those we recognize today
