Environmental Hazards and Disasters Bimal Kanti Paul, 2011-11-30. Environmental hazards and disasters: contexts, perspectives and management focuses on manifested threats to humans and their welfare as a result of natural disasters. The book uses an integrative approach to address socio-cultural, political and physical components of the disaster process. Human and social vulnerability as well as risk to environmental hazards are explored within the comprehensive context of diverse natural hazards and disasters. In addition to scientific explanations of disastrous occurrences, people and governments of hazard-prone countries often have their own interpretations for why natural disasters occur. In such interpretations, they often either blame others in order to conceal their inability to protect themselves or they blame themselves, attributing the events to either real or imagined misdeeds. The book contains a chapter devoted to the neglected topic of such reactions and explanations. Includes chapters on key topics such as the application of GIS in hazard studies, resiliency, disasters and poverty, climate change and sustainability and development. This book is designed as a primary text for an interdisciplinary course on hazards for upper-level undergraduate and graduate students. Although not targeted for an introductory hazards course, students in such a course may find it very useful as well. Additionally, emergency managers, planners and both public and private organizations involved in disaster response and mitigation could benefit from this book along with hazard researchers. It not only includes traditional and popular hazard topics, e.g. disaster cycles, disaster relief and risk and vulnerability, it also includes neglected topics such as the positive impacts of disasters, disaster myths and different accounts of disasters and disasters and gender.

Community Responses to Disasters in the Pacific Rim Shu-Mei Huang, Elizabeth Maly, 2023-12-07. Community Responses to Disasters in the Pacific Rim presents different aspects of place making in displacement in the Pacific Rim region. It focuses on how people respond and readjust to changes and

captures the long term community development outcomes and the critical moments that facilitate this development. Interdisciplinary and using diverse research approaches the book includes contributions by authors from a variety of disciplines across disaster research sociology urban planning architecture anthropology earth science and education. Mixed methods are adopted to carry out the research projects that ground this volume including qualitative research for social scientific research ethnographic methods and more importantly Participatory Action Research. At Risk Piers Blaikie, Terry Cannon, Ian Davis, Ben Wisner, 2014-01-21. The term natural disaster is often used to refer to natural events such as earthquakes hurricanes or floods. However the phrase natural disaster suggests an uncritical acceptance of a deeply engrained ideological and cultural myth. At Risk questions this myth and argues that extreme natural events are not disasters until a vulnerable group of people is exposed. The updated new edition confronts a further ten years of ever more expensive and deadly disasters and discusses disaster not as an aberration but as a signal failure of mainstream development. Two analytical models are provided as tools for understanding vulnerability. One links remote and distant root causes to unsafe conditions in a progression of vulnerability. The other uses the concepts of access and livelihood to understand why some households are more vulnerable than others. Examining key natural events and incorporating strategies to create a safer world this revised edition is an important resource for those involved in the fields of environment and development studies.

Natural Disaster and Development in a Globalizing World Mark Pelling, 2003-08-29. The number of humanitarian disasters triggered by a natural hazard has doubled every decade since the 1960s. At the same time the global economic growth rate per capita is twice its 1960s value. Does this mean economic growth is independent of the impacts of natural disaster? *Natural Disaster and Development in a Globalizing World* is the first book to acknowledge the full implications of globalization for disaster and development. The contributors to this book fully examine global processes and how they might affect disaster risk at the global scale links between international issues such as diplomatic relations the growth of non governmental organizations and the health of the international insurance industry and disaster risk the interaction of these large scale forces with local conditions through case study analysis of individual disaster events. In his revealing work author Pelling makes clear the links between global scale processes and local experiences of disaster and underlies the difficulty of attributing blame for individual disasters on specific global pressures. He argues that action to reduce disaster must be coordinated at the local

national and global scales and that there is a need for greater integration across the physical and social sciences In this context the human rights agenda is seen as a way of moving disaster reduction efforts forward

Vulnerability in Technological Cultures Anique Hommels, Jessica Mesman, Wiebe E.
