Women and Revolution covers an enormous socio historical space four continents Europe Africa Asia and Latin America and quite a few countries within them This huge field of human experience is looked at from the focal point which runs explicitly and implicitly through all nineteen chapters the active if not revolutionary role women have played individually and collectively in various determining social situations a role regularly suppressed by the coercive power of institutionalized domination The impetus for this endeavor was the commemoration of the bicentennial of the French Revolution an occasion to take an in depth look at its less obvious agendas through a focus on the activity of women and on Olympe de Gouges in particular But as Olympe de Gouges became acquainted with Mr Guillotine the considerable role of women became suppressed not only actually but as a kind of *damnatio memoriae* which the old Romans had already invented As this work shows there have been multiple forms and contents through which women have taken history into their own hands and have participated in emancipatory struggles throughout the world They are at their best in their use of the resources of local village traditions of dense social contexts of mutual aid and in turning such grassroots resources into radical democratic struggles for the future A fascinating and timely book Wolf Dieter Narr Freie Universit t Berlin The vital role played by women in struggles for social transformation has scarcely been appreciated and with the sense of defeat that hangs over the revolutionary project stands to be further forgotten That is why the publication of Women and Revolution is both welcome

The Sacrificed Body Tatjana Aleksic,2013-10-28 Living in one of the world s most volatile regions the people of the Balkans have witnessed unrelenting political economic and social upheaval In response many have looked to building communities both psychologically and materially as a means of survival in the wake of crumbling governments and states The foundational structures of these communities often center on the concept of individual sacrifice for the good of the whole Many communities however are hijacked by restrictive ideologies turning them into a model of intolerance and exclusion In *The Sacrificed Body* Tatjana Aleksic examines the widespread use of the sacrificial metaphor in cultural texts and its importance to sustaining communal ideologies in the Balkan region Aleksic further relates the theme to the sanctioning of ethnic cleansing rape and murder in the name of homogeneity and collective identity Aleksic begins her study with the theme of the immurement of a live female body in the foundation of an important architectural structure a trope she finds in texts from all over the Balkans The male builders performing the sacrificial act have been called by a higher power who will ensure the durability of the structure and hence the patriarchal community as a whole In numerous examples ranging from

literature to film and performance art Aleksic views the theme of sacrifice and its relation to exclusion based on gender race class sexuality religion or politics for the sake of community building According to Aleksic the sacrifice narrative becomes most prevalent during times of crisis brought on by wars weak governments foreign threats or even globalizing tendencies Because crisis justifies the very existence of restrictive communities communalist ideology thrives on its perpetuation They exist in a symbiotic relationship Aleksic also acknowledges the emancipatory potential of a genuine community after it has shaken off its ideological character Aleksic employs cultural theory sociological analysis and human rights studies to expose a historical narrative that is predominant regionally if not globally As she determines in an era of both Western and non Western neoliberalism elitist hegemony will continue to both threaten and bolster communities along with their segregationist tactics

With the onset of a more conservative political climate in the 1980s social and especially labour history saw a decline in the popularity that they had enjoyed throughout the 1960s and 1970s This led to much debate on its future and function within the historical discipline as a whole Some critics declared it dead altogether Others have proposed a change of direction and a more or less exclusive focus on images and texts The most constructive proposals have suggested that labour history in the past concentrated too much on class and that other identities of working people should be taken into account to a larger extent than they had been previously such as gender religion and ethnicity Although class as a social category is still as valid as it has been before the questions now to be asked are to what extent non class identities shape working people s lives and mentalities and how these are linked with the class system In this volume some of the leading European historians of labour and the working classes address these questions Two non European scholars comment on their findings from an Indian resp American point of view The volume is rounded off by a most useful bibliography of recent studies in European labour history class gender religion and ethnicity *Days of Revolution* Mary Elaine Hegland, 2013-10-30 Outside of Shiraz in the Fars Province of southwestern Iran lies Aliabad Mary Hegland arrived in this then small agricultural village of several thousand people in the summer of 1978 unaware of the momentous changes that would sweep this town and this country in the months ahead She became the only American researcher to witness the Islamic Revolution firsthand over her eighteen month stay *Days of Revolution* offers an insider s view of how regular people were drawn into experienced and influenced the 1979 Revolution and its aftermath Conventional wisdom assumes Shi a religious ideology fueled the revolutionary movement But Hegland counters that the Revolution spread through much more pragmatic concerns growing inequality lack of development

and employment opportunities government corruption Local expectations of leaders and the political process expectations developed from their experience with traditional kinship based factions guided local villagers attitudes and decision making and they often adopted the religious justifications for Revolution only after joining the uprising Sharing stories of conflict and revolution alongside in depth interviews the book sheds new light on this critical historical moment Returning to Aliabad decades later Days of Revolution closes with a view of the village and revolution thirty years on Over the course of several visits between 2003 and 2008 Mary Hegland investigates the lasting effects of the Revolution on the local political factions and in individual lives As Iran remains front page news this intimate look at the country s recent history and its people has never been more timely or critical for understanding the critical interplay of local and global politics in Iran

To Have and to Hit Dorothy Ayers Counts, Judith K. Brown, Jacquelyn Campbell, 1999 This vitally important volume places the problem of wife beating in a broad cultural context in a search for strategies to reform societies including our own that are prone to this pernicious form of violence Based on first hand ethnographic data on more than a dozen societies including a number in Oceania this collection explores the social and cultural factors that work either to inhibit or to promote domestic violence against women The volume also includes a study of abuse among nonhuman primates and a cross cultural analysis of the legal aspects of wife beating By presenting counterexamples from other cultures contributors challenge Western assumptions about the factors leading to wife beating Through a close examination of societies where wife beating is infrequent or absent To Have and To Hit identifies the factors economic social political and cultural that must be explored and transformed in order to combat this violence and eventually eliminate it

The End of Love Sabrina Strings, 2024-01-30 From Playboy to Jay Z the racial origins of toxic masculinity and its impact on women especially Black and insufficiently white women More men than ever are refusing loving partnerships and commitment and instead seeking out situationships When these men deign to articulate what they are looking for in a steady partner they ll often rely on superficial norms of attractiveness rooted in whiteness and anti Blackness Connecting the past to the present sociologist Sabrina Strings argues that following the Civil Rights movement and the integration of women during the Second Wave Feminist movement men aimed to hold on to their power by withholding love and commitment a basic tenet of white supremacy and male domination that served to manipulate all women From pornography to hip hop women especially Black and insufficiently white women were presented as gold diggers props for masturbation and side pieces Using historical research personal stories and critical analysis Strings argues that the result is fuccboism the latest incarnation of toxic masculinity This work shows that men are not innately toxic Nor do they hate love commitment or sex Instead men across race have been working a new code to effectively deny loving partnerships to women who are not pliant slim and white as a new mode of male domination
