detail including the most extensive coverage of the Battle of K nigg tz yet published in English The author has made full use of an extensive number of German language sources His detailed text is accompanied by a number of black and white illustrations and battle maps Orders of battle are also provided This is the latest title in Helion's groundbreaking series of 19th Century studies and will again appear in hardback as a strictly limited edition printing of 750 copies each individually numbered and signed by the author on a decorative title page The Viaz'ma Catastrophe, 1941 Lev Lopukhovsky, Stuart Britton, 2013-08-01 This book describes one of the most terrible tragedies of the Second World War and the events preceding it The horrible miscalculations made by the Stavka of the Soviet Supreme High Command and the Front commands led in October 1941 to the deaths and imprisonment of hundreds of thousands of their own people Until recently the magnitude of the defeats suffered by the Red Army at Viaz ma and Briansk were simply kept hushed up For the first time in this book a full picture of the combat operations that led to this tragedy are laid out in detail using previously unknown or little used documents The author was driven to write this book after his long years of fruitless search to learn what happened to his father Colonel N I Lopukhovsky the commander of the 120th Howitzer Artillery Regiment who disappeared together with his unit in the maelstrom of Operation Typhoon He became determined to break the official silence surrounding the military disaster on the approaches to Moscow in the autumn of 1941 In the present edition the author additionally introduces documents from German military archives which will doubtlessly interest not only scholars but also students of the Eastern Front of the Second World War Lopukhovsky substantiates his position on the matter of the true extent of the losses of the Red Army in men and equipment which greatly exceeded the official data In the Epilogue he briefly discusses the searches he has conducted with the aim of revealing the circumstances surrounding the deaths of Soviet soldiers who to this point have been listed among the missing in action including his own father The narrative is enhanced by numerous photographs color maps and tables Lev Nikolaevich Lopukhovsky graduated from the prestigious Frunze Military Academy in 1962 and spent the next ten years serving in the Soviet Union's Strategic Rocket forces rising to the rank of colonel and a regiment commander before transferring to a teaching position in the Frunze Military Academy in 1972 due to health reasons Lopukhovsky is a professor with the Russian Federation's Academy of Military Sciences 2008 and has been a member of Russia's Union of Journalists since 2004 Since 1989 he has been engaged in the search for those defenders of the Fatherland who went missing in action in the Second World War including his own father Colonel N I Lopukhovsky who is now known to have been killed while breaking out of encirclement in October 1941 Motivated by his father's disappearance he had previously taken up the intense study of the Viaz ma defensive operation and wrote the initial manuscript of the present book In 1980 this manuscript was rejected by military censors because it contradicted official views Lopukhovsky is the author of several other books about the war including Prokhorovka bez grifa sekretnosti Prokhorovka without the seal of secrecy 2005 Pervye dni voiny First days of the war 2007 and is the co author of Iiun 1941 Zaprogrammirovannoe porazhenie June 1941 A

**Muddling Through** Peter Howson, 2014-01-19 As with many other aspects of the British army the outbreak of World War One started a process of change that was to result in a radically different provision of chaplaincy care once the war was over Nothing was ever simple with army chaplaincy The war saw an increase in the number of churches becoming involved with the army The structure had already been under pressure in the first decade of the century with the Catholic Church insisting on new rules for its chaplains The creation of the Territorial Force added a new dimension after 1907 bringing new players into the mix including the Jewish community These chaplains challenged the traditional Garrison Church based ministry of the regulars The book examines the muddled state of chaplaincy in August 1914 and looks at how chaplains were mobilized It then reviews how organizational changes were often the result of pressure from the different churches The unilateral decision of the Church of England in July 1915 to leave the unified administration in France that had existed since August 1914 is examined in the light of the availability of the relevant volume of the diaries of Bishop Gwynne a key participant in the change Chapters also look at the experience of other Imperial forces and of the casualties suffered by chaplains These all provide evidence of the expectations that various groups had of army chaplains It is often forgotten that two chaplains were captured during the retreat from Mons in 1914 They were never far from the fighting throughout the war The experiences of the war meant that the pre war structure needed reform The final chapter looks at the structure that was created in 1920 and then survived virtually unchanged until 2004 Army chaplaincy has always been a mix of Church Army and State Such a coming together inevitably lead to confusion Not surprisingly one of the themes was the muddle that

resulted Even so army chaplaincy ended the war with a much higher profile than the one it had in 1914 This was recognised by the addition of Royal creating the RAChD Anglicans Catholics Presbyterians Methodists and other faith groups as well as military historians will find this book of interest as it overturns a number of myths and puts chaplaincy in its wider context

From boyhood in Antrim to Hell on the Somme David and British people Truesdale, 2012-08-19 For almost 43 years three school notebooks lay in obscurity in the County Armagh home of sixty two year old James McRoberts The closely filled pages recorded just over two years in his life in uniform as he played his part in what was then known as the Great War During the Home Rule crisis of 1914 one of several in Ireland's history James McRoberts like many other men joined the Young Citizen Volunteers an organization that eventually became the 14th Royal Irish Rifles a battalion of the 36th Ulster Division These notebooks written at the time and with footnotes added some forty years later record his Army service between 8 January 1915 and 3 April 1917 They tell with remarkable immediacy of his time at Randalstown County Antrim and the move to Seaford in East Sussex From here after further training James moved with his Battalion to the trenches of the Western Front Written with a degree of humor and some detail his story covers the mundane routine of camp life recreation behind the lines the horrors of enemy shelling the deaths of good friends and the momentous events of 1 July 1916 on the Somme when his unit was in the thick of the action On 1 November 1917 while acting as a scout for a night patrol at Messines Ridge James was seriously wounded and evacuated to hospital for him the War was over Nevertheless he continued to record what was happening around him both with humour and in detail Classed as 80% disabled he was eventually discharged and returned home to enjoy a postwar career as a surveyor in County Armagh This is a remarkable memoir that is by turns lively candid humorous poignant and above all a window into the world of an Ulsterman who found himself both witness and participant to a series of remarkable events His descriptions of army life both daily routine and the inferno on the Somme in July 1916 add greatly to our knowledge of this most climactic period of history David Truesdale opted for early retirement in 1998 and since then has written for films and television and produced two
