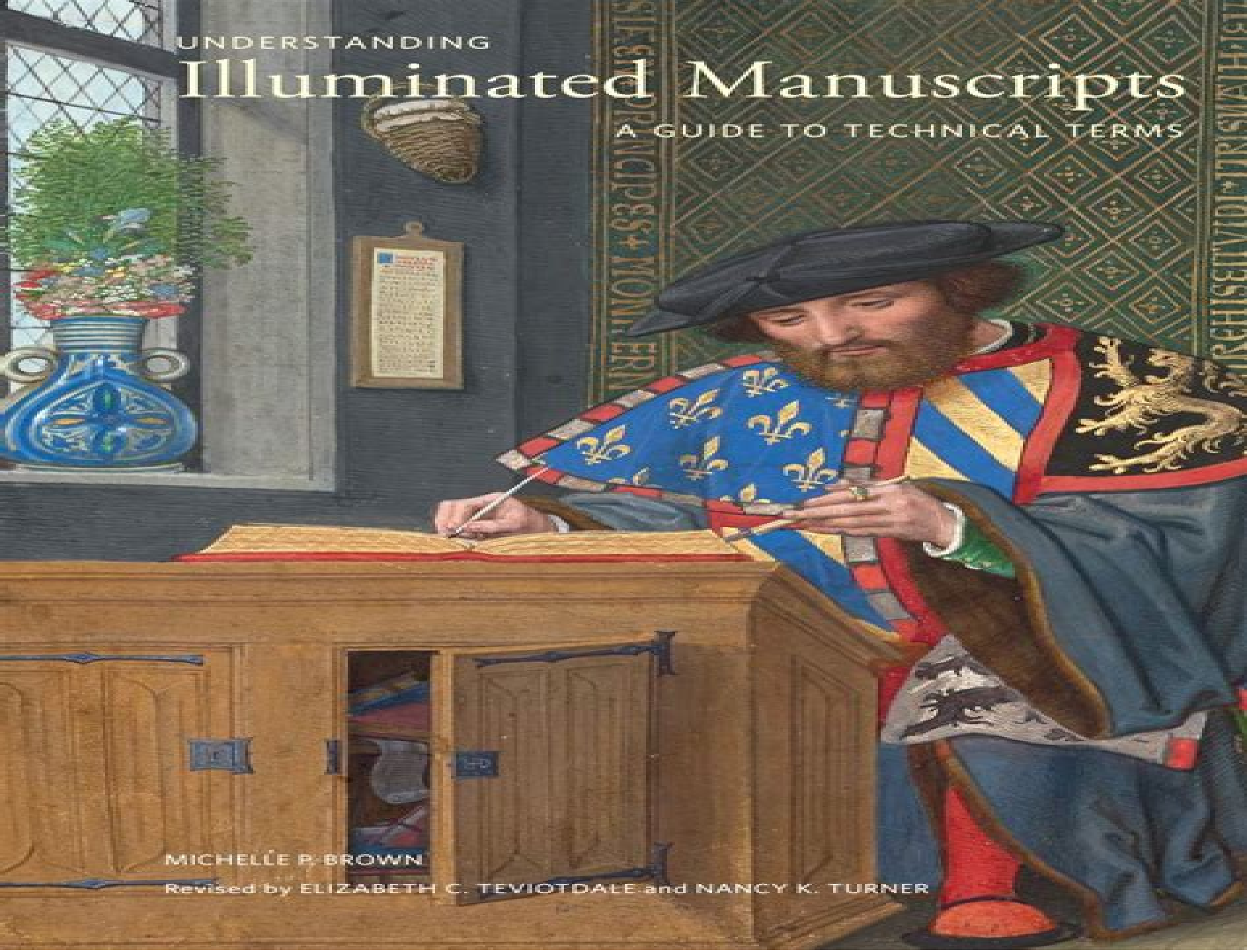

Beyond the Legacy of Genghis Khan Linda Komaroff,2006 This publication offers a wide ranging account of the Mongols in western and eastern Asia in the aftermath of Genghis Khan s disruptive invasions of the early thirteenth century focusing on the significant cultural social religious and political changes that followed in their wake The issues considered concern art governance diplomacy commerce court life and urban culture in the Mongol world empire as originally presented at a 2003 symposium at the Los Angeles County Museum of Art and now distilled in this volume This collection of 23 papers by many of the main authorities in the field demonstrates both the scope and the depth of the current state of Mongol related studies and will undoubtedly inspire and provoke further research The text is profusely illustrated by 27 color and 110 black and white illustrations Early English Art and Architecture Lloyd Robert Laing,Jennifer Laing,1996 surveys the entire

spectrum of English art from the beginning of the fifth century to the end of the twelfth century Jacket flap *Sensual Encounters* Erika Lauren Lindgren, 2009 Specifically she focuses on the Dominican nuns and lay sisters of southern Germany in the thirteenth and early fourteenth centuries Particularly the way in which these women controlled and interpreted their surroundings and incorporated them into their spiritual and devotional practices Book Jacket *Holy Image, Hallowed Ground* Robert S. Nelson, Kristen M. Collins, 2006 Isolated in the remote Egyptian desert at the base of Mount Sinai sits the oldest continuously inhabited monastery in the Christian world The Holy Monastery of Saint Catherine at Sinai holds the most important collection of Byzantine icons remaining today This catalogue published in conjunction with the exhibition Holy Image Hallowed Ground Icons from Sinai on view at the J Paul Getty Museum from November 14 2006 to March 4 2007 features forty three of the monastery's extremely rare and rarely exhibited icons and six manuscripts still little known to the world at large The exhibition and catalogue bring to life the central role of the icon in Byzantine religious practices Themes include the icon's status as holy object the ways in which the icon sanctified the place of worship and the monks' quest for the holy The Greek Orthodox monastery at Mount Sinai not only functioned as a major pilgrimage site for centuries but was also a cultural crossroads at the center of the shifting sands of ecclesiastical and secular politics The accompanying essays explore how the monastery's contact with the outside world through pilgrimage resulted in aesthetic exchanges between the monastery and Coptic Crusader and Islamic art and between the Greek Orthodox and Roman Catholic communities in Europe

The Bible as Book Paul Henry Saenger, Kimberly Van Kampen, 1999 This second volume in the series deals with the effects of early printing on the text format and use of the Bible and investigates the unique features of various editions of 15th century printed Bible as well as the social political and technological circumstances under which they were produced

Spenser Studies, 2002 A Renaissance poetry annual *Migrations* Stephanie Hollis, Alexandra Barratt, 2007 Over two hundred items are catalogued in Medieval and Renaissance Manuscripts in New Zealand Collections 1989 Most are in institutional collections and were donated by late nineteenth and early twentieth century book collectors notably Sir George Grey 1812-98 Governor and later Premier of New Zealand Having been transported across the globe the manuscripts have remained for the most part beyond the purview of northern hemisphere scholars The contributors to this interdisciplinary collection of essays include international experts such as Christopher de Hamel Richard Gameson Margaret Manion and Michael Orr curators of New Zealand manuscript collections New Zealand academics and a PhD student Migrations has two main aims to lodge the Early European manuscripts in New Zealand within the international discourse of postcolonial heritage and to place them within the mainstream of manuscript studies by drawing attention to their intrinsic significance and their relationship with manuscripts held in overseas collections Part One focuses on the motives and historical circumstances underlying the formation of the principal collections and the subsequent changes in the ways that this heritage has been regarded Three of the essays centre upon the bibliophiles who donated their manuscripts to public

libraries Others consider specific manuscripts as indices of changing attitudes to European particularly British cultural heritage National identity pedagogy and curatorial practices are among the issues canvassed Part Two consists of new scholarly studies of particular manuscripts which examine them in relation to the cultural and documentary context in which they were produced or transmitted Manuscripts studied include a twelfth century copy of music treatises by Boethius and Guido of Arezzo probably from Christ Church Canterbury a Perugian breviary owned by an Augustinian friar Antonio da Macerata a book of hours adapted for Scottish use the Rossdhu Hours and a fragment of an early fifteenth century book of hours produced by a London workshop and added to the Hours of Margery Fitzherbert oeMigrations is an imaginative and ambitious contribution to twenty first century manuscript studies Most notably the editors have invited manuscript scholars to address the issues raised by the manuscripts location New Zealand itself and its colonial history become tools for thinking with about dispersal about cultural memory about access about the meanings ascribed to artefacts The editors have assembled a distinguished group of scholars in order to produce a collection of essays that is a coherent whole and at the same time individually driven by the intellectual curiosity that is the true sign of distinction The book is a triumph Professor Felicity Riddy Deputy Vice Chancellor and Professor of English University of York oeThis excellent book makes a major contribution to the study of medieval manuscript collections in New Zealand and will open up a little known area of extremely important material to an international audience The quality of the scholarship throughout the book is very high and the essays on the individual manuscripts present the material in the context of recent new approaches in the study of medieval and Early Modern manuscripts Nigel Morgan Hon Professor of Art History University of Cambridge Head of Research Parker Library MSS Project Corpus Christi College **The Processional Cross in Late Medieval England** Colum Hourihane, 2005 Processional crosses were destroyed in such great numbers at the Reformation that we perhaps forget what a role they once played in community and liturgical life Brittany Spain Portugal and many other parts of Catholic Europe This book traces the form of the processional cross back to specific ceremonies in the sixth century Byzantine world
