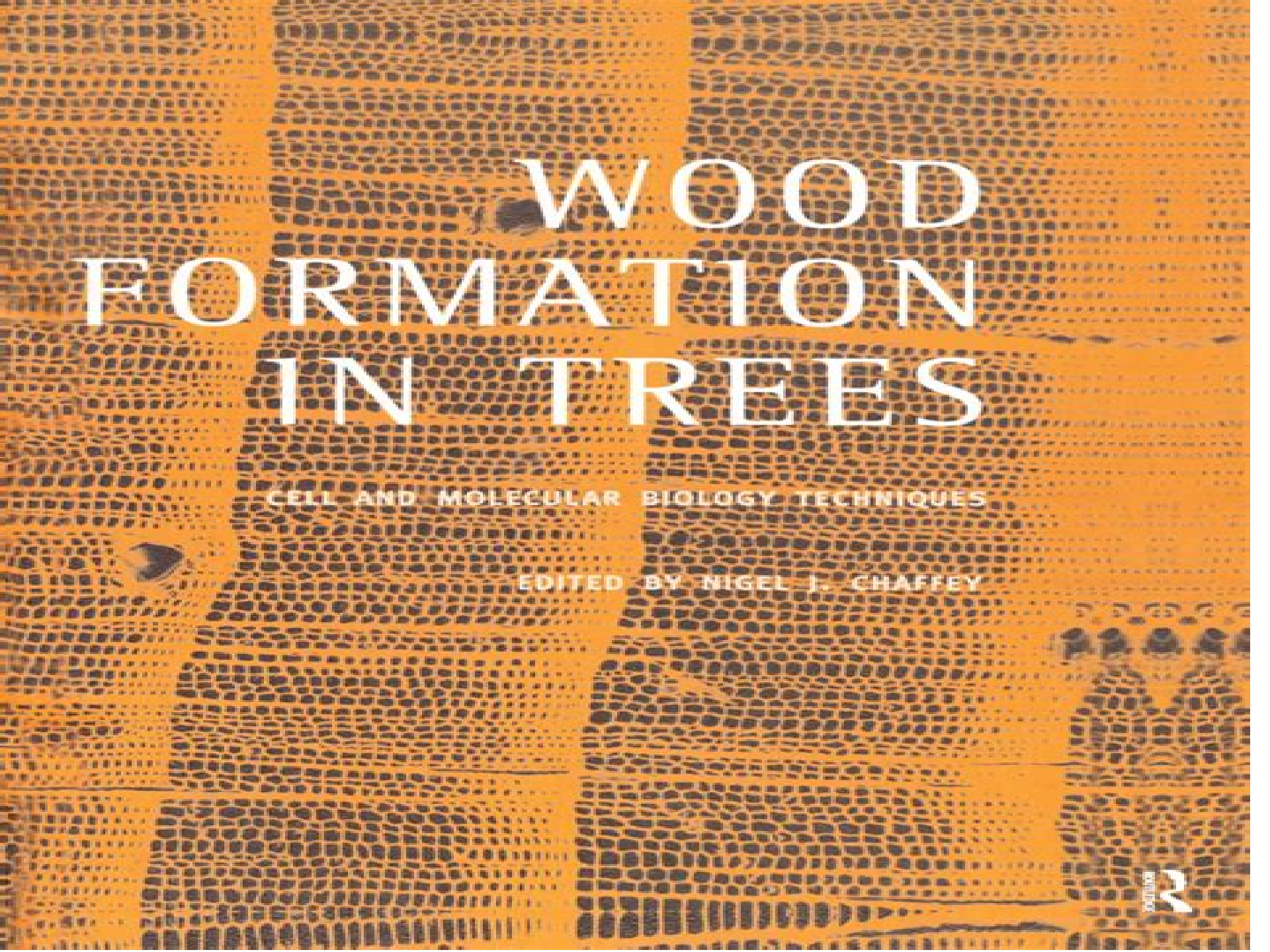

Wood Structure in Plant Biology and Ecology Pieter Baas, 2013-12-09 At present, the study of functional and ecological wood anatomy enjoys a vigorous renaissance and plays a pivotal role in plant and ecosystem biology, plant evolution, and global change research. This book contains a selection of papers presented at the successful meetings of the International Association of Wood Anatomists and the COST Action STReESS: Studying Tree Responses to Extreme Events, a Synthesis held in Naples in April 2013. Four review papers address: 1) the hydraulic architecture of the earliest land plants; 2) the general phenomenon of axial conduit tapering in trees; 3) the hydraulic and biomechanical optimization in one of the most important plantation-grown tree species, Norway Spruce; and 4) cellular and subcellular changes in the cambium in response to environmental factors. industrial feedstock for numerous products Its chemical and anatomical structure and the excellent properties that result allow wood to be processed into the most diverse products from logs to furniture and veneers and from wood chippings to wooden composites and paper The aim of this book is to review advances in research on the cellular aspects of cambial growth and wood formation in trees over recent decades The book is divided into two major parts The first part covers the basic process of wood biosynthesis focusing on five major steps that are involved in this process cell division cell expansion secondary cell wall formation programmed cell death and heartwood formation The second part of the book deals with the regulation of wood formation by endogenous and exogenous factors On the endogenous level the emphasis is placed on two aspects control of wood formation by phytohormones and by molecular mechanisms Apart from endogenous factors various exogenous effects such as climate factors are involved in wood formation Due to modern microscopic as well as molecular techniques the understanding of wood formation has progressed significantly over the last decade Emphasizing the cellular aspects this book first gives an overview of the basic process of wood formation before it focuses on factors involved in the regulation of this process

valuable information of the experimental system In addition the observed structural changes allow investigators to set hypothesis for further studies based on one's own observation Thus proper selection and utilization of microtechniques are a must for the success of a research program At present an up to date collection of protocols are not readily available in the literature The latest work in plant microtechniques was published in 1999 by Ruzin but many others are no longer in print e g Jensen 1964 O'Brien and McCully 1981 Furthermore a majority of published works focus on techniques related to general processing and staining procedures A comprehensive treatment that encompasses broader applications of microtechniques to other disciplines is lacking e g archeology wood science etc There is a need to create a comprehensive volume of botanical methods and protocols which includes traditional and novel techniques that can be used by researchers in plant science and investigators in other disciplines that require plant microtechniques in their research and teaching This book covers a wide variety of applications and brings them up to date to make them understandable and relevant especially to students using the methods for the first time It is our intention to create a useful reference for plant histology and related methods that will serve as a foundation for plant scholars researchers and teachers in the plant sciences
