Narrative of the Life of Frederick Douglass Frederick Douglass, Editorial International, 2015-05-16 Douglass's Narrative is like a highway map showing us the road from slavery to freedom At the beginning of the book Douglass is a slave in both body and mind When the book ends he gets both
