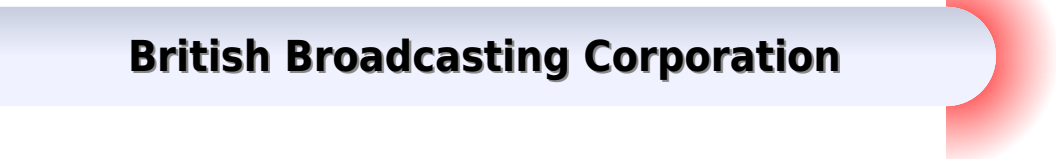

appreciated for its ability to transform leaders instill finer sensibilities and question social ills In its postcolonial incarnations as the traditional subject areas were informed by critical and linguistic theories language arts subject areas were less often used as they were understood to offer opportunities to analyse their functions as apology for leaders coopting the young and pacifying dissent but less often used to teach second language skills Language Arts curricula arising since the 1980s have increasingly embraced authentic voices styles and genres Contemporary Language Arts curricula use literature to teach reading based and communication skills in conjunction with critical and creative thinking The movement of English language education beyond native English shores has placed Language Arts into a World Englishes frame and therefore its curricula have included the teaching ethics civics and intercultural sensitivity The explosion of media and digital communications of the 1990s led to the adoption of media literacy as a crucial Language Arts skill As digital innovations continue to impact the teaching of English Language Arts has adopted multiliteracies These developments are represented in the papers included in this volume

English Drama of the Early Modern Period 1890-1940 Jean Chothia, 2016-07-01 The period 1890 1940 was a particularly rich and influential phase in the development of modern English theatre the age of Wilde and Shaw and a generation of influential actors and managers from Irving and Terry to Guilgud and Olivier Jean Chothia s study is in two parts beginning with a portrait of the period setting the narrative context and considering the dramatic social and cultural changes at work during this time It then focuses on some of the main themes in the theatre from Shaw and comedy to the rise of political and radio drama providing an interpretative framework for the period This volume will be of great benefit to students and academics of English literature and drama as it covers the work of the major dramatists of the period as well as considering the dramatic output of literary figures such as James Eliot and Lawrence

War and Peace II Leo Tolstoy, 2022-05-30 Have you taken a deep breath after the drama and conflict of volume one It's time to dive into War and Peace II and it does not slow down With Russia bruised by Napoleon's victory at the Battle of Austerlitz Tolstoy goes for close ups of the three main male characters Pierre Nikolai and Denisov It is not entirely pretty Amidst the backdrop of Tolstoy's philosophical discussions on life and death and the inevitability of war the characters become embroiled in gambling debt love triangles intrigue and broken promises There are more twists than Chubby Checker and more dramatic moments than in EastEnders Leo Tolstoy's masterpiece in four volumes is a complete semester of Russian and French history using the zoom button to focus on its impact on families from the aristocracy to the peasants It paints a picture of petty jealousy pride and forbidden love in the Russian stately homes If you like costume dramas and the novels of Jane Austen Pride and Prejudice Sense and Sensibility this is the granddaddy of them all The same goes for fans of Bernard Cornwell's Sharpe novels and TV series starring Sean Bean War and Peace was made into a BBC TV series in 2016 written by Andrew Davies and starring Lily James and James Norton Leo Tolstoy 1828-1910 was a Russian author a master of realistic fiction and one of the world's greatest novelists Tolstoy's major works include War and Peace 1865-69 and Anna Karenina 1875-77 two of the greatest novels of all time and pinnacles of realist fiction Beyond novels he wrote many short stories and later in life also essays and plays In the years following the publication of War and Peace Tolstoy who was born to a Russian aristocratic family had a spiritual awakening that made him a committed Christian anarchist and pacifist His philosophy inspired Mahatma Gandhi and Martin Luther King Jr

Theatre with a Purpose Don Watson, 2023-12-28 This study of British amateur theatre in the inter-war period examines five different but interwoven examples of the belief common in theatrical and educational circles at the time that amateur drama had a purpose beyond recreation Amateur theatre was at the height of its popularity as a cultural practice between the wars so that by 1939 more British people had practical experience of putting on plays than at any time before or since Providing an original account of the use of drama in adult education projects in deprived areas and of amateur theatre in government funded centres for the unemployed in the 1930s it discusses repertoires participation by working class people and pioneering techniques of play making Amateur drama festivals and competitions were intended to raise standards and educate audiences This book assesses their effect on play making and the use of innovative one act plays to express contentious material as well as looking at the Left Book Club Theatre Guild as an attempt to align the amateur theatre movement with anti-fascist and anti-war movements A chapter on the Second World War rectifies the neglect of amateur theatre in war time cultural studies arguing that it was present and

important in every aspect of war time life Don Watson builds on current scholarship and makes use of archival sources local newspapers unpublished scripts and the records of organizations not usually associated with the theatre His work explores the range and diversity of amateur drama between the wars and the contributions it made to British theatre

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
