identity They also engage in creative and transformative practices regarding ethnic identity and belonging that have contributed to their abilities to adapt to their life circumstances in positive constructive ways and have expanded what it means to be Maya Indigenous Guatemalans today Child survivors experiences offer inspiration justify expanded research with child survivors as their own distinct survivor group and warrant reconsideration of in country residential care when other forms of loving nurturing in country care are unavailable

A Cultural History of Genocide in the Early Modern World Igor Pérez Tostado, 2023-05-04 Historical studies of genocide in the 20th century trace the roots back to the sociopolitical economic and cultural developments of the early modern period From globalization to urbanization to imperialism state formation and homogenization from religious warfare to enlightenment to racism many factors connected with genocide first emerged or vastly developed between the 15th and 18th centuries While the early modern period did not have a crime of genocide it possessed its own legal system which contemplated the rightful destruction of whole peoples and a political culture that sanctioned the use of mass violence As a result early modern genocide has been denied or blurred as a regrettable side effect of the global circulation of ideas goods and peoples and the creation of new societies cultures and languages arising from it This collection looks at the different genocides which unfolded around the globe emphasizing its gendered dimension and its disproportionate and enduring impact on indigenous populations Although European imperialism and homogenization play a central role it aims more widely to cover the principal agents victims and rationale for genocide in the early modern world As a whole this volume aims at fostering the debate on the early modern history of genocide not as an insulated or secondary subject but as a central issue of the era with profound implications for our own

Namibia Godfrey Mwakikagile, 2015 The author looks at how Namibia was founded as a German colony known as Deutsch S dwestafrika German South West Africa and how it evolved into a nation He explains how it was founded on brutal suppression of the indigenous people including extermination of large numbers of some groups and how on becoming a colony of South Africa its people continued to be subjected to brutal treatment by the white minority rulers who denied them racial equality The author also focuses on the liberation struggle against apartheid and how the country won independence from apartheid South Africa He also looks at how the leaders of the new nation are trying to build the country and construct a national identity on the basis of unity in diversity It is an analysis of identity formation at the national level and consolidation of the state whose relevance is continental in scope studies of other African countries in their quest for unity and construction or reconstruction of their national identities during the post colonial era can benefit from this work It is also a work of comparative analysis in terms of nationhood in the African context and how Namibia and Tanzania two case studies have sought to construct their national identities the obstacles they have faced and continue to face in the quest for national unity especially in the case of Namibia and why Tanzania has been more successful than most countries on the continent in building a cohesive society where tribalism is virtually non existent enabling it to consolidate its unity and national identity

The author also looks at the concept of national character and its relevance to national identity formation and why the national identities of different African countries are weak and what can be done to address the problem. It is also an introductory text which may be helpful to some people who are going to Namibia for the first time although it is essentially a scholarly work intended for members of the academic community and specialists in some fields dealing with this southwest African country and its people. But members of the general public who want to learn more about Namibia may also find the book to be useful.
