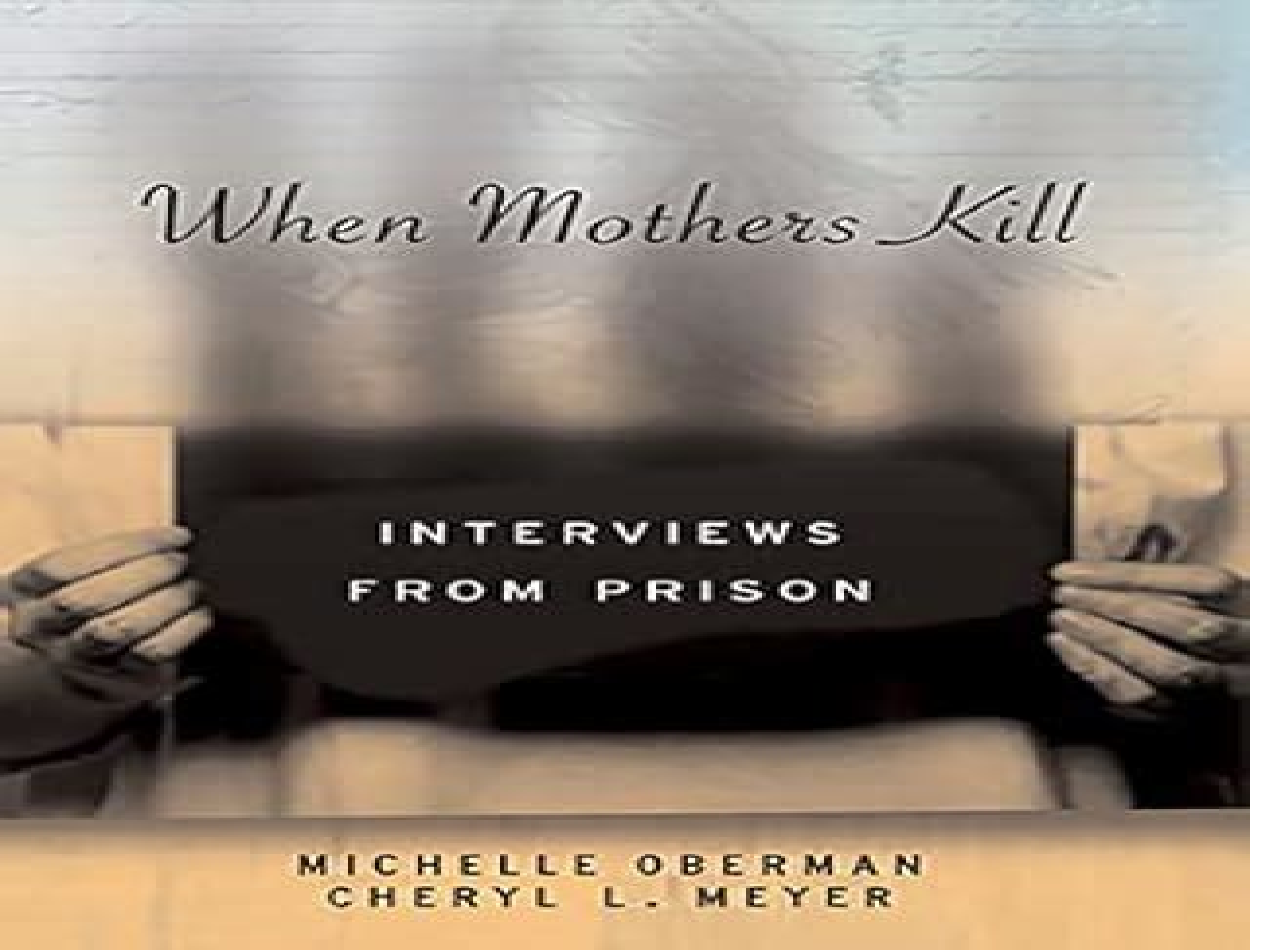

When Mothers Kill Interviews From Prison:

When Mothers Kill Cheryl L. Meyer, Michelle Oberman, 2008-06-01 Winner of the 2008 Outstanding Book Award by the Academy of Criminal Justice Sciences Michelle Oberman and Cheryl L Meyer don't write for news magazines or prime time investigative television shows but the stories they tell hold the same fascination *When Mothers Kill* is compelling In a clear direct fashion the authors recount what they have learned from interviewing women imprisoned for killing their children Readers will be shocked and outraged as much by the violence the women have endured in their own lives as by the violence they engaged in but they will also be informed and even enlightened Oberman and Meyer are leading authorities on their subject Their 2001 book *Mothers Who Kill Their Children* drew from hundreds of newspaper articles as well as from medical and social science journals to propose a comprehensive typology of maternal filicide In that same year driven by a desire to test their typology and to better understand child killing women not just as types but as individuals Oberman and Meyer began interviewing women who had been incarcerated for the crime After conducting lengthy face to face interviews with forty prison inmates they returned and selected eight women to speak with at even greater length This new book begins with these stories recounted in the matter of fact words of the inmates themselves There are collective themes that emerge from these individual accounts including histories of relentless interpersonal violence troubled relationships with parents particularly with mothers twisted notions of romantic love and deep conflicts about motherhood These themes structure the books overall narrative which also includes an insightful examination of the social and institutional systems that have failed these women Neither the mothers nor the authors offer these stories as excuses for these crimes *The Cultural and Economic Context of Maternal Infanticide* Martha Smithey, 2018-11-23 This book examines the social economic and cultural conditions and stressors under which mothers commit infanticide and shows how these conditions affect the ability to meet societal and self perceived expectations of good mothering *Women Criminals* Vickie Jensen, 2011-11-10 A unique two volume study that examines female crime and the women who commit it The two volume *Women Criminals An Encyclopedia of People and Issues* addresses both key topics and key figures in women's crime The first volume provides topical essays about areas critical to the understanding of female criminals such as the definition of women's crime explanations of women's criminality ethnic and age diversity in female criminals and responses of the criminal justice system The second volume comprises biographical entries profiling women who are obviously criminals such as Aileen Wuornos and Myra Hindley and also women who were victims of circumstance unjust laws or narrowly applied definitions of crime such as Rosa Parks Harriet Tubman and Sophie Scholl In addition to highlighting the breadth of women's criminality these portraits provide a holistic multifaceted understanding of the dynamics of women's crime and why it occurs connecting the individual stories to the larger social scientific perspectives Care has been taken to include the women's own voices and perspectives where possible and to address the intentions and reasoning of the system that responded to their criminality *Behavioral Analysis*

of *Maternal Filicide* Joy Lynn E. Shelton, Tia A. Hoffer, Yvonne E. Muirhead, 2014-10-01 Maternal filicide has been discussed in the medical mental health and child abuse fields yet little research exists with a criminal justice law enforcement perspective Nevertheless criminal justice professionals responsible for investigation and prosecution of these offenders often must give attention to unique behavioral social and psychological dynamics not considered in many other types of cases The Federal Bureau of Investigation's FBI Behavioral Analysis Unit BAU III Crimes Against Children identified collected and reviewed law enforcement case files in which a biological mother killed her child ren Collectively the cases involve 213 biological mothers who killed 265 children and are comprised of neonaticide infanticide and filicide cases Data analysis revealed that the offenders ranged in age from 12 46 years and many were unmarried unemployed and had a history of violence Many of the victims were three years of age or younger did not live with their biological fathers at the time of their deaths and had a history of maltreatment most often perpetrated by their mothers In addition traditional weapons such as a firearm or knife were used less often compared to asphyxiants and blunt force instruments The authors explore the tenets of female violence the mother child dynamic and mental disorders and address the complexities associated with investigating and prosecuting maternal filicide offenders

Giving Up Baby Laury Oaks, 2015-06-05 Baby safe haven laws which allow a parent to relinquish a newborn baby legally and anonymously at a specified institutional location such as a hospital or fire station were established in every state between 1999 and 2009 Promoted during a time of heated public debate over policies on abortion sex education teen pregnancy adoption welfare immigrant reproduction and child abuse safe haven laws were passed by the majority of states with little contest These laws were thought to offer a solution to the consequences of unwanted pregnancies mothers would no longer be burdened with children they could not care for and newborn babies would no longer be abandoned in dumpsters Yet while these laws are well meaning they inadequately address the social injustices that compel abandonment for the very small number of girls and women who abandon their newborns Advocates of safe haven laws target teenagers women of color and poor women in particular with safe haven information under the assumption that they cannot offer good homes for their children Laury Oaks argues that the labeling of certain kinds of women as potential bad mothers who should consider anonymously giving up their newborns for adoption into a loving home should best be understood as an issue of reproductive justice Safe haven discourses promote narrow images of who deserves to be a mother and reflect restrictive views on how we should treat women experiencing an unplanned pregnancy

When Caregivers Kill Betty L. Alt, Sandra K. Wells, 2010-04-16 From mothers who kill their children in postpartum fugues to fathers who murder their kids for revenge against an estranged wife the stories in this book are chilling yet real and bring home the message that children are vulnerable to violence even in the care of those who should love and protect them the most Sadly child murder by parents and caregivers happens more frequently than one might guess and while each case is different there are often warning signs that something might be amiss Signs of physical abuse may precede the ultimate act of murder A

mother's mental state after the birth of a child may signal true distress and the potential for extreme actions. No one can predict with certainty when a parent or other caregiver may snap, but here Alt and Wells examine many cases of child murder to find out what they have in common, how we might prevent such violence, and what more we can do to protect children in potentially explosive situations.

Evidence of mothers killing their infants dates back to at least 2000 B.C.E. and the ancient Chaldean civilization. The trial of Andrea Yates in 2001 for drowning her five children, however, captured the public attention in a way few similar cases had before. Initially met with public shock and outrage, the Yates case also spotlighted postpartum psychosis and maternal mental health forensics: the intersection of maternal mental illness and the criminal justice system.
