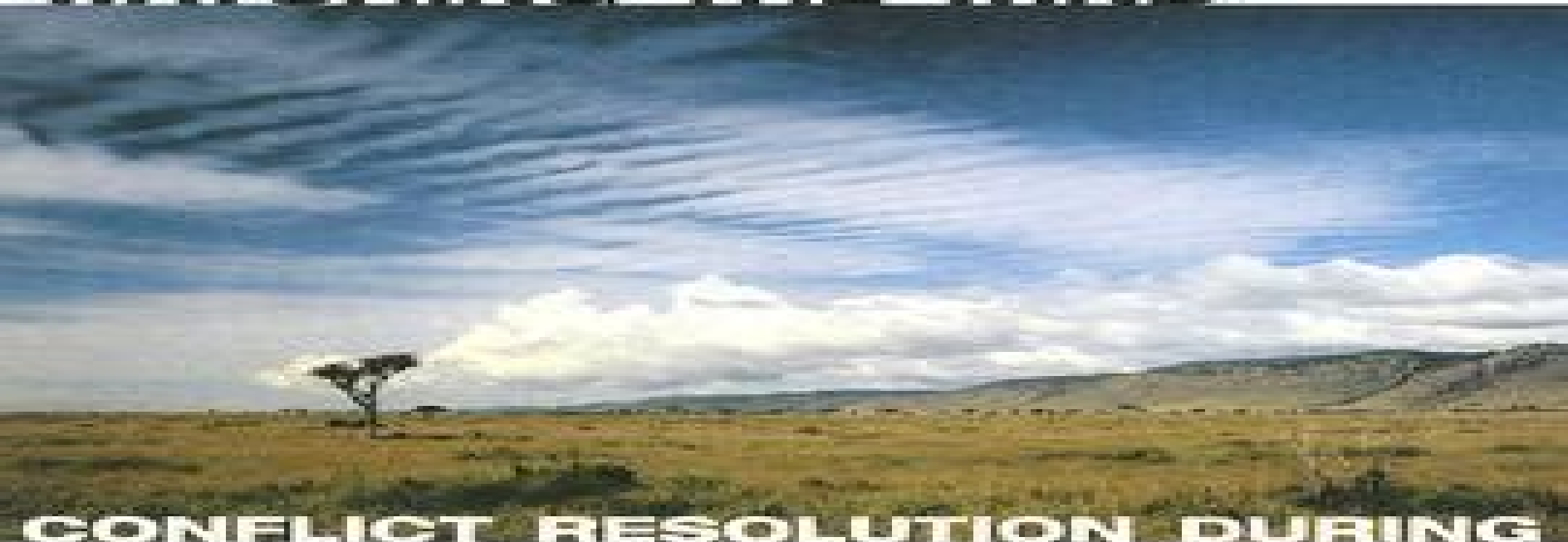

McFaul,2013-04-15 Fifteen case studies by scholars and practitioners demonstrate the synergy between domestic and international influences that can precipitate democratic transitions As demonstrated by current events in Tunisia and Egypt oppressive regimes are rarely immune to their citizens desire for democratic government Of course desire is always tempered by reality therefore how democratic demands are made manifest is a critical source of study for both political scientists and foreign policy makers What issues and consequences surround the fall of a government what type of regime replaces it and to what extent are these efforts successful Kathryn Stoner and Michael McFaul have created an accessible book of fifteen case studies from around the world that will help students understand these complex issues Their model builds upon Guillermo O Donnell Philippe C Schmitter and Laurence Whitehead s classic work Transitions from Authoritarian Rule using a rubric of four identifying factors that can be applied to each case study making comparison relatively easy Transitions to Democracy yields strong comparisons and insights For instance the study reveals that efforts led by the elite and involving the military are generally unsuccessful whereas mass mobilization civic groups and new media have become significant factors in supporting and sustaining democratic actors This collection of writings by scholars and practitioners is organized into three parts successful transitions incremental transitions and failed transitions Extensive primary research and a rubric that can be applied to burgeoning democracies offer readers valuable tools and information Peacemaking and Peacebuilding in South Africa Liz Carmichael,2022 It is now 30 years since the National Peace Accord NPA was signed in South Africa bringing to an end the violent struggle of the Apartheid era and signalling the transition to democracy Signed by the ANC Alliance the Government the Inkatha Freedom Party and a wide range of other political and labour organizations on 14 September 1991 the parties agreed in the NPA on the common goal of a united non racial democratic South Africa and provided practical means for moving towards this end codes of conduct for political organizations and for the police the creation of national regional and local peace structures for conflict resolution the investigation and prevention of violence peace monitoring socio economic reconstruction and peacebuilding This book written by one of those involved in the process that evolved provides for the first time an assessment and in depth account of this key phase of South Africa s history The National Peace Campaign set up under the NPA mobilized the silent majority and gave peace an unprecedented grassroots identity and legitimacy The author describes the formulation of the NPA by political representatives with Church and business facilitators which ended the political impasse constituted South Africa s first experience of multi party negotiations and made it possible for the constitutional talks Codesa to start She examines the work of the Goldstone Commission which prefigured the TRC as well as the role of international observers from the UN EU Commonwealth and OAU Exploring the work of the peace structures set up to implement the Accord the National Peace Committee and Secretariat the 11 Regional Peace Committees and 263 Local Peace Committees and over 18 000 peace monitors Carmichael provides a uniquely detailed assessment of the NPA the on the ground peacebuilding work and the essential involvement of the people at its heart Filling

a significant gap in modern history this book will be essential reading for scholars students and others interested in South Africa's post Apartheid history as well as government agencies and NGOs involved in peacemaking globally

Religion, Tradition, and Restorative Justice in Sierra Leone Lyn S. Graybill, 2017-06-15 In this groundbreaking study of post conflict Sierra Leone Lyn Graybill examines the ways in which both religion and local tradition supported restorative justice initiatives such as the national Truth and Reconciliation Commission TRC and village level Fambul Tok ceremonies Through her interviews with Christian and Muslim leaders of the Inter Religious Council Graybill uncovers a rich trove of perspectives about the meaning of reconciliation the role of acknowledgment and the significance of forgiveness Through an abundance of polling data and her review of traditional practices among the various ethnic groups Graybill also shows that these perspectives of religious leaders did not at all conflict with the opinions of the local population whose preferences for restorative justice over retributive justice were compatible with traditional values that prioritized reconciliation over punishment These local sentiments however were at odds with the international community's preference for retributive justice as embodied in the Special Court for Sierra Leone which ran concurrently with the TRC Graybill warns that with the dominance of the International Criminal Court in Africa there are currently eighteen pending cases in eight countries local preferences may continue to be sidelined in favor of prosecutions She argues that the international community is risking the loss of its most valuable assets in post conflict peacebuilding by pushing aside religious and traditional values of reconciliation in favor of Western legal norms

Globalizing International Theory A. Layug, John M. Hobson, 2022-09-30 *Globalizing International Theory* adds to the literature on non Western international relations IR theory by probing the question of what it means to globalize international theory The book starts with the premise that international theory is unfinished incomplete and homogenous because it provides a limited conception of the international which in turn derives from its partiality that reflects its narrow Western centric bias The contributors argue that the IR vision of the world is projected through a polarizing Western filtered lens Rather than utilizing an objective set of explanatory tools for explaining world politics the reality is that orthodox IR theory only tells us why the West is best and why the Rest should become like the West This means that international theory is not truly international In provincializing Western international theory this volume navigates beyond the Eurocentric and imperial frontier of the prevailing limited conception of the international to explore the hidden contributions to international theory which can be found in the non Western world Bringing in excluded non Western conceptions of international theory highlights a broader conception of the international The book provides a framework for theorizing globally exploring the fundamental problems with Western IR theory and how to overcome them This book will be used by advanced undergraduate and postgraduate students scholars researchers and IR theorists worldwide who are interested in non Western IR theory It will help navigate the problem of internationalness in the face of the grand theoretical problem of our time the use and misuse of international theory in making sense of and responding to

The Trouble with the Congo Séverine Autesserre, 2010-06-14 *The Trouble with the Congo* suggests a new explanation for international peacebuilding failures in civil wars Drawing from more than 330 interviews and a year and a half of field research it develops a case study of the international intervention during the Democratic Republic of the Congo's unsuccessful transition from war to peace and democracy 2003 2006 Grassroots rivalries over land resources and political power motivated widespread violence However a dominant peacebuilding culture shaped the intervention strategy in a way that precluded action on local conflicts ultimately dooming the international efforts to end the deadliest conflict since World

War II Most international actors interpreted continued fighting as the consequence of national and regional tensions alone UN staff and diplomats viewed intervention at the macro levels as their only legitimate responsibility The dominant culture constructed local peacebuilding as such an unimportant unfamiliar and unmanageable task that neither shocking events nor resistance from select individuals could convince international actors to reevaluate their understanding of violence and intervention
