Agents of Reform Elisabeth Anderson, 2021-10-12 A groundbreaking account of how the welfare state began with early nineteenth century child labor laws and how middle class and elite reformers made it happen The beginnings of the modern welfare state are often traced to the late nineteenth century labor movement and to policymakers efforts to appeal to working class voters But in *Agents of Reform* Elisabeth Anderson shows that the regulatory welfare state began a half century earlier in the 1830s with the passage of the first child labor laws *Agents of Reform* tells the story of how middle class and elite reformers in Europe and the United States defined child labor as a threat to social order and took the lead in bringing regulatory welfare into being They built alliances to maneuver around powerful political blocks and instituted pathbreaking new employment protections Later in the century now with the help of organized labor they created factory inspectorates to strengthen and
