Some trades, Smith says, require a large population, while others can be conducted even in a small rural town. A village carpenter, for example, will have to do a little bit of everything—cabinetry, wheel-making, house-framing—whereas someone in a big city might be able to specialize in just one of those tasks. Adam Smith argues that the division of labor is limited by the extent of the market. He explains that the more extensive the market, the greater the division of labor can be. This is because a larger market allows for a greater variety of goods to be produced and exchanged, which in turn allows for a greater specialization of workers.

Since it is much cheaper to transport goods by water than by land, he adds, the size of any given market will be limited by its access to navigable rivers, canals, or a seacoast. In Smith's view the differences in such access largely explain the different rates of economic growth and technological progress in various parts of the world. Central Asia and the African interior, for example, remain "barbarous and uncivilized" because they have few navigable rivers and no coast. Eastern China, in contrast, is prosperous because its vast network of rivers allows for ample inland trade.

Smith also explains that the division of labor is constrained by the size of the market in terms of the size of the population and the proximity of the population. A larger population and greater proximity to other markets allows for a greater division of labor. Conversely, a smaller population or greater distance from other markets limits the division of labor.
