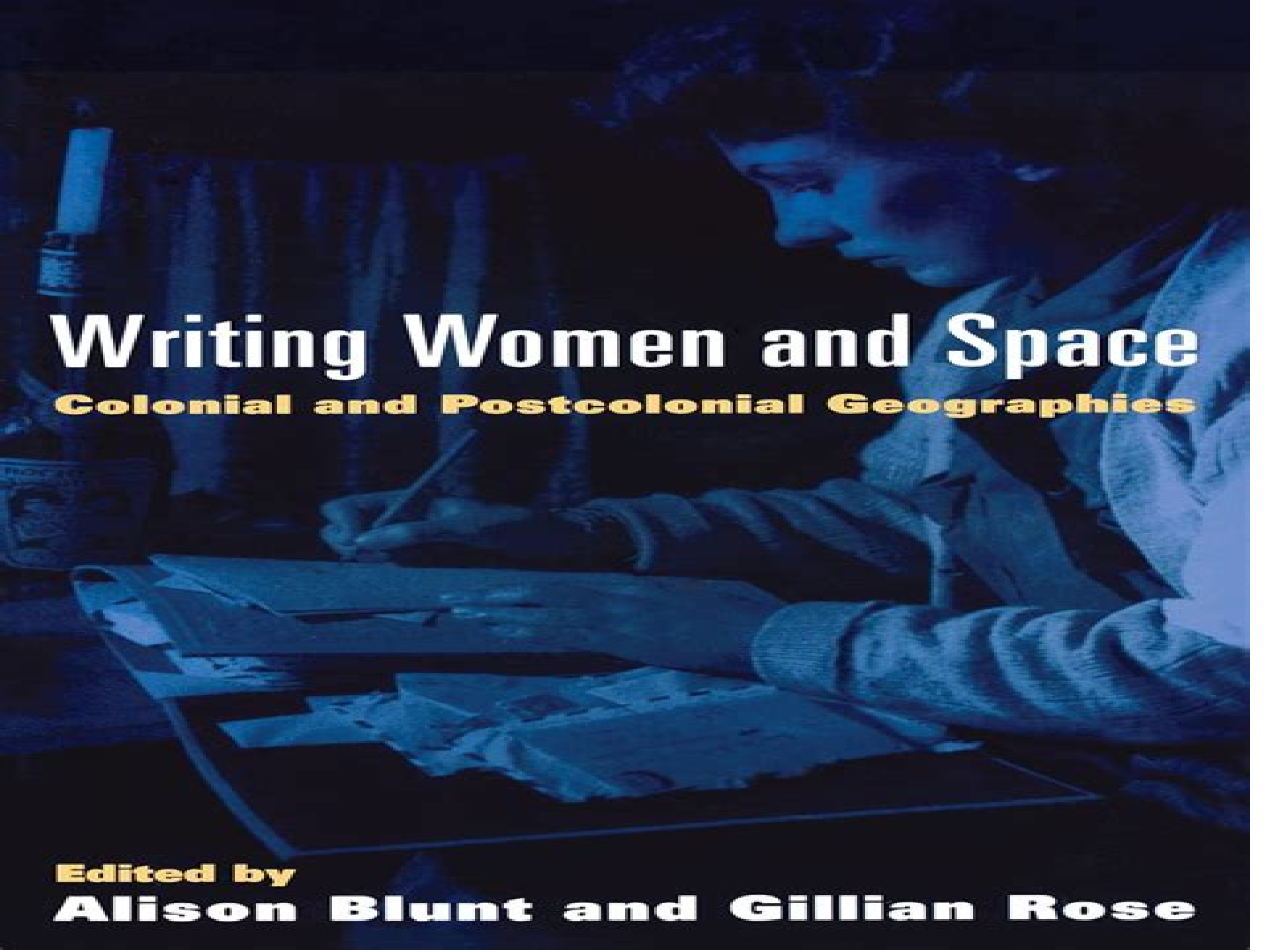

Love and Space in Contemporary African Diasporic Women's Writing Jennifer Leetsch, 2021-07-16 This book sets out to investigate how contemporary African diasporic women writers respond to the imbalances pressures and crises of twenty first century globalization by querying the boundaries between two separate conceptual domains love and space The study breaks new ground by systematically bringing together critical love studies with research into the cultures of migration diaspora and refuge Examining a notable tendency among current black feminist writers poets and performers to insist on the affective dimension of world making the book ponders strategies of reconfiguring postcolonial discourses Indeed the analyses of literary works and intermedia performances by Chimamanda Adichie Zadie Smith Helen Oyeyemi Shailja Patel and Warsan Shire reveal an urge of moving beyond a familiar insistence on processes of alienation or rupture and towards a new reparative emphasis on connection and intimacy to imagine possible inhabitable worlds

Artist and Attic Hsin Ying Chi, 1999 Artists and Attic sees the relationship between architecture and literature as a concrete reflection of nineteenth century ideology creating an iconic picture of women's position in society and literature during that period In the Victorian house the attic is hidden and neglected yet to a woman artist it is a space of her own to produce a text of her own The author presents the neglected attic as related to the neglected woman and the limited space symbolizes the confinement of woman and the woman writer yet obtaining this space of her own becomes the central concern to women and women writers This book explores the function of the attic in nineteenth century British and American women's writing as it is given meaning and life by the writers To many of the women the attic created a paradoxical image of their seclusion but also of their own poetic space for freedom in creation Many of the writers see the attic as a retreat to escape from patriarchal oppression and a place to seek social identity

Writing Women's Literary History Margaret J. M. Ezell, 1996-11-08 Ezell critically examines these successful women's literary histories and applies to them the same self

Women, Space and Utopia 1600-1800 Nicole Pohl, 2017-05-15 The first full length study of women's utopian spatial imagination in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries this book explores the sophisticated correlation between identity and social space The investigation is mainly driven by conceptual questions and thus seeks to link theoretical debates about space gender and utopianism to historiographic debates about the gendered social production of space As Pohl's primary aim is to demonstrate how women writers explore the complex gender politics of space specific attention is given to spaces that feature widely in contemporary utopian imagination Arcadia the palace the convent the harem and the country house The early modern writers Lady Mary Wroth and Margaret Cavendish seek to recreate Paradise in their versions of Eden and Jerusalem the one yearns for Arcadia the other for Solomon's Temple Margaret Cavendish and Mary Astell redefine the convent as an emancipatory space dismissing its symbolic meaning as a confining and surveilled architecture The utopia of the country house in the work of Delarivier Manley Sarah Scott and Mary Hamilton will reveal how women writers resignify the traditional metonym of the country estate The study will finish with an investigation of Oriental tales and travel writing by Ellis Cornelia Knight Lady Mary Montagu Elizabeth Craven and Lady Hester Stanhope who unveil the seraglio as a location for a Western specifically masculine discourse on Orientalism despotism and female sexuality and offers their own utopian judgment *Genre and Women's Life Writing in Early Modern England* Michelle M. Dowd, Julie A.

Eckerle, 2016-04-15 By taking account of the ways in which early modern women made use of formal and generic structures to constitute themselves in writing the essays collected here interrogate the discursive contours of gendered identity in sixteenth and seventeenth century England The contributors explore how generic choice mixture and revision influence narrative constructions of the female self in early modern England Collectively they situate women's life writings within the broader textual culture of early modern England while maintaining a focus on the particular rhetorical devices and narrative structures that comprise individual texts Reconsidering women's life writing in light of recent critical trends most notably historical formalism this volume produces both new readings of early modern texts such as Margaret Cavendish's

autobiography and the diary of Anne Clifford and a new understanding of the complex relationships between literary forms and early modern women's selves This volume engages with new critical methods to make innovative connections between canonical and non canonical writing in so doing it helps to shape the future of scholarship on early modern women

Radical Feminism, Writing, and Critical Agency Jacqueline Rhodes, 2012-02-01 This book traces the intersection of radical feminism composition and print culture in order to address a curious gap in feminist composition studies the manifesto writing collaborative action taking radical feminists of the 1960s and 1970s Long before contemporary debates over essentialism radical feminist groups questioned both what it was to be a woman and to perform womanhood and a key part of that questioning took the form of very public very contentious texts by such writers and groups as Shulamith Firestone the Redstockings and WITCH the Women's International Terrorist Conspiracy from Hell Rhodes explores how these radical women's texts have been silenced in contemporary rhetoric and composition and compares their work to that of contemporary online activists finding that both point to a network literacy that blends ever shifting identities with ever changing technologies in order to take action Ultimately Rhodes argues the articulation of radical feminist textuality can benefit both scholarship and classroom as it situates writers as rhetorical agents who can write resist and finally act within a network of discourses and identifications

Politics, Poetics, and Gender in Late Qing China Nanxiu Qian, 2015-05-06 In 1898 Qing dynasty emperor Guangxu ordered a series of reforms to correct the political economic cultural and educational weaknesses exposed by China's defeat by Japan in the First Sino Japanese War The Hundred Day's Reform has received a great deal of attention from historians who have focused on the well known male historical actors but until now the Qing women reformers have received almost no consideration In this book historian Nanxiu Qian reveals the contributions of the active optimistic and self sufficient women reformers of the late Qing Dynasty Qian examines the late Qing reforms from the perspective of Xue Shaohui a leading woman writer who openly argued against male reformers approach that subordinated women's issues to larger national concerns instead prioritizing women's self improvement over national empowerment Drawing upon intellectual and spiritual resources from the freewheeling xianyuan worthy ladies model of the Wei Jin period of Chinese history 220-420 and the culture of women writers of late imperial China and open to Western ideas and knowledge Xue and the reform minded members of her social and intellectual networks went beyond the inherited Confucian pattern in their quest for an ideal womanhood and an ideal social order Demanding equal political and educational rights with men women reformers challenged leading male reformers purpose of achieving national wealth and power intending instead to unite women of all nations in an effort to create a just and harmonious new world

Women's Space Virginia Chieffo Raguin, Sarah Stanbury, 2006-01-01 This interdisciplinary collection addresses the location of women and their bequests within the single most important public and social space in pre Reformation Europe the Roman Catholic Church This innovative focus brings attention to gender and space as experienced in the medieval parish as well as in monastic and
